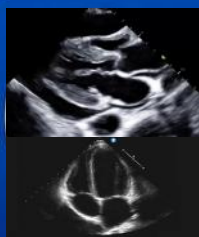

- Awake fiberoptic intubation
- Ultrasound in airway management
- First pass video laryngoscope technique

- Front of neck access to the airway

UPPER LIMB BLOCKS

- Interscalene and supraclavicular
- Costoclavicular, Infraclavicular, Axillary, Median and Ulnar
- Supra-inguinal fascia illicia and PENG

LOWER LIMB BLOCKS

- Femoral, Popliteal and Ankle

TRUNK BLOCKS

- Spinal, Epidural, Subcostal, Rectus sheath and TAP
- Serratus Anterior, Erector Spine and Paravertebral

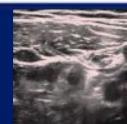

Submission Guidelines

Word limit: 300 words (excluding title and authors)
Structured format required: Background, Methods, Results, Conclusion
Maximum 6 authors
No tables or images in abstract

Presentation format

Oral Presentation: 8 minutes PP presentation + 2 minutes discussion Q&A
Poster: A0 Portrait with moderated discussion
