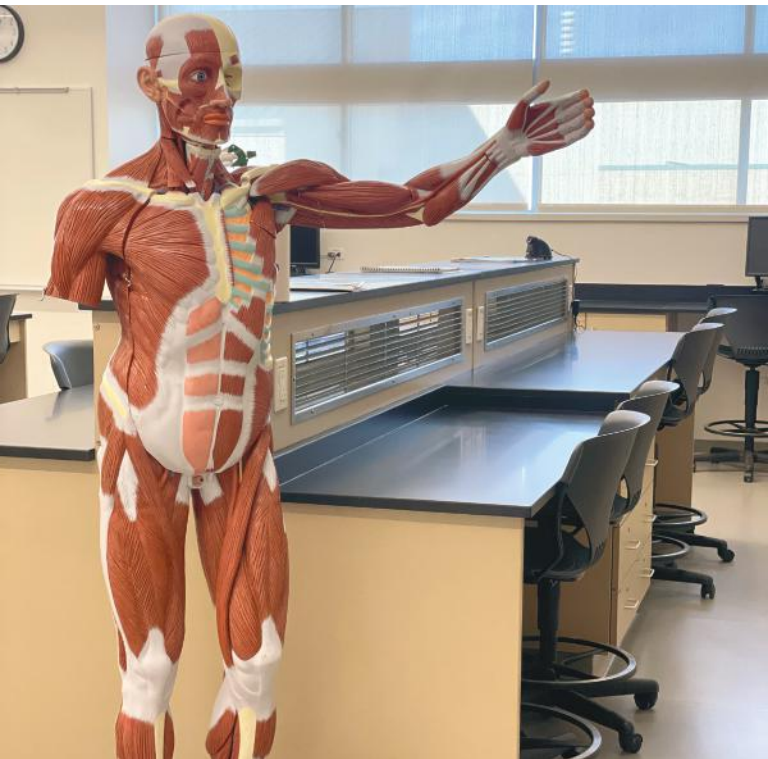
Science
