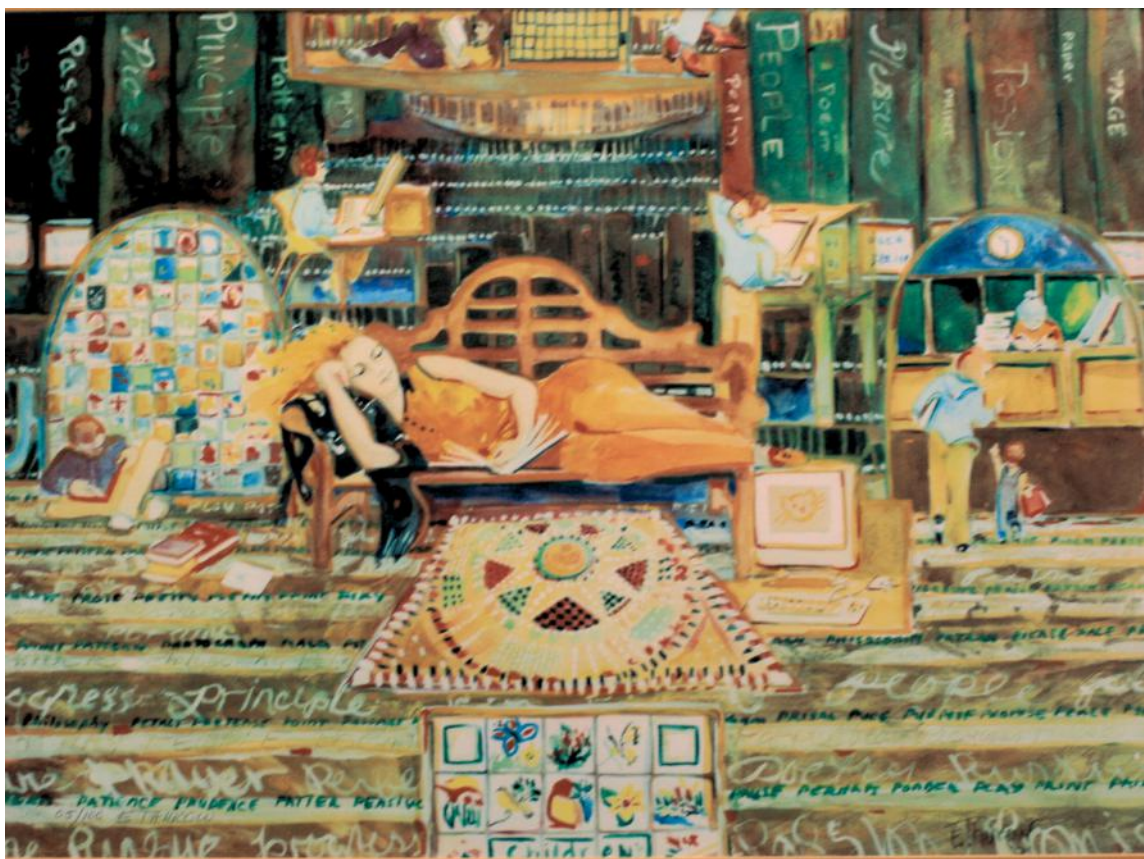

Budget Update

Our budget process is wrapping up this summer, and I am so grateful for the continued, generous support from the Board of County Commissioners, the Friends of the Library, and the Library Foundation. Together, your tax dollars and donations are what make it possible for us to keep our staff, programs, and events running strong — and I don't take that for granted.

That support is already at work! Clearmont Branch is expanding its hours right away, so that the Clearmont community can spend even more time in their library and by August, we should be doubling their open hours. Looking ahead, we're planning to bring back expanded hours at the Wyoming Room next year, so that they will be open to the full Fulmer Branch Hours in 2027 that way more of you can dig into our local history and genealogy collections.

I'm so grateful for this support, and honestly, I'm just excited about what it means for all of us — now and down the road.

And speaking of support — mark your calendars for WyoGives on July 20th! It's one of my favorite days of the year, because it's such a simple, meaningful way for our community to show up for the library. Every gift, no matter the size, helps us keep saying yes to more hours, books, creativity, fun, and spaces for you to enjoy.

RENOVATION UPDATES

Every month brings new progress, and I'm proud of how these changes are helping us honor the traditions of our libraries while building something ready to serve our communities for years to come. Thank you for your support and patience throughout this process — it's been a genuine pleasure serving you this summer. - Amy Long

Furniture for the Story, Clearmont, and Tongue River branches has been ordered and is on its way — we're hoping to see it arrive in early fall.

The **Story Branch Library** is unfortunately not open yet. We've had to delay while we troubleshoot an issue we want to get right, and our team is working to expedite that so we can reopen as soon as possible. In the meantime, the Story Library team has reopened the Kids' Library for storytimes and programs whenever they can, which has helped free up some space in the meeting room.

Interlibrary loan will be back up and running at the **Clearmont and Tongue River Branch Libraries** beginning in August.

At the **Fulmer Branch**, we're reopening the **Children's Library** next week! The new Children's activity space will open later this summer, so until then, Summer Reading Programs and Storytime will be held within the Children's Library until notified otherwise.

This also means we're transitioning into **Zone 2** of our renovation — the current Non-Fiction area between the Reference Desk and the first-floor public restrooms. Around July 21st, we'll install a temporary wall to divide the space and begin work on carpet, drywall, paint, and lighting. Shelving layouts will shift slightly, and this is also where the new Reference Desk will eventually be located. Once complete, this area will house the Fiction, Large Type, Teen, and Audiobook collections, along with a brand-new reading patio for patrons to enjoy. This will be unavailable to patrons until it reopens to the public. This includes the restrooms and the Inner Circle. The patio area will also be under construction at some point, which may also have restricted access at that time.

Additionally, please note: if carpet or paint fumes impact other areas of the building, we may have unexpected close down for a day or two on short notice. We will put information on the door and on our website.

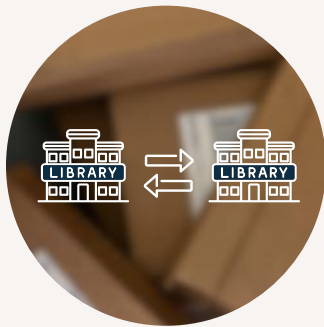

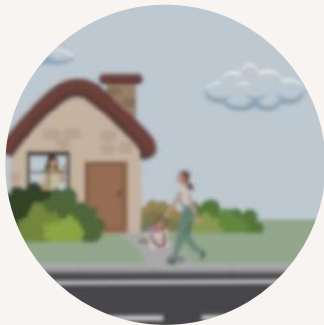

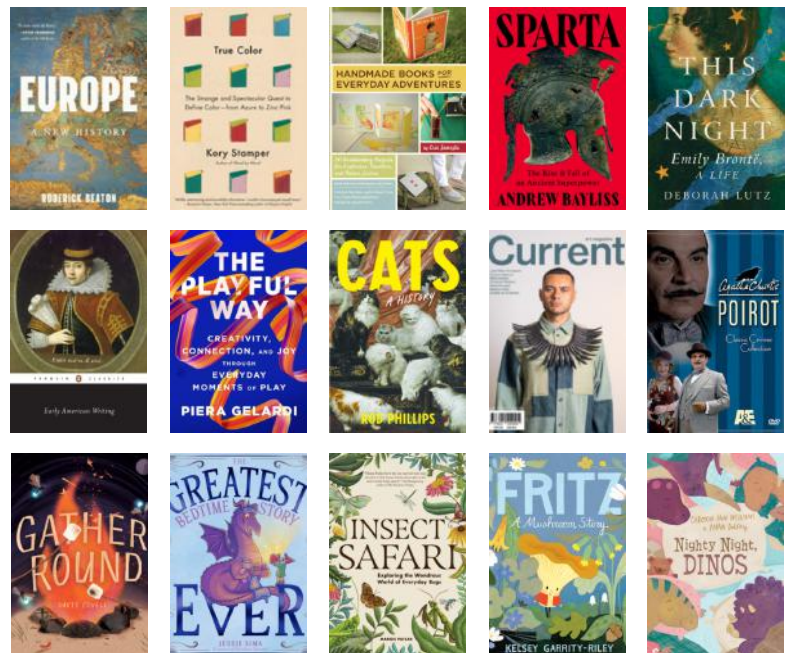


HOMEBOUND SERVICES

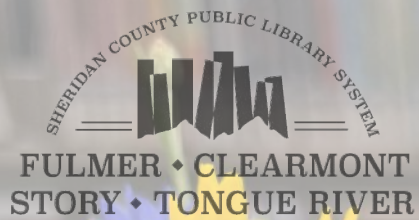
