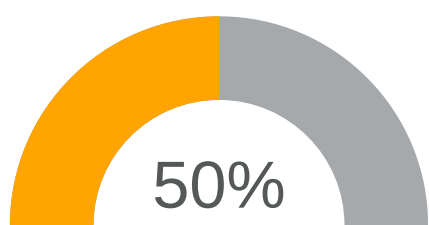


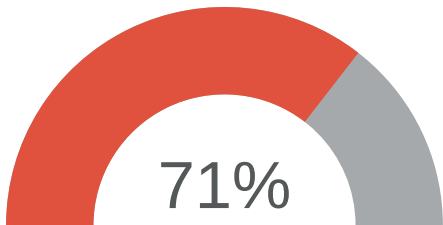


KTJ IGCSE Results: 2026

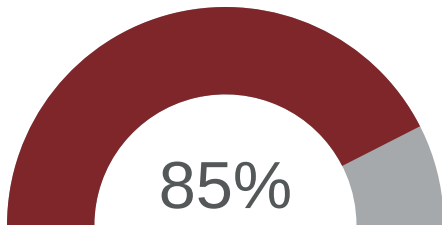
In 2026, KTJ demonstrated its commitment to holistic education by offering a comprehensive IGCSE curriculum encompassing 25 subjects to a cohort of 109 students. Half of all entries achieved an A* or A grade, while 85% attained an A*- C grade, reflecting both academic excellence and the breadth of opportunity provided.

of entries received an A*-C grade

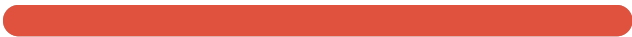

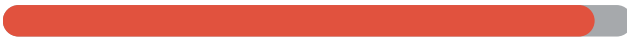
