Facebook Is Changing.

Your Advertising Plan Should Have Options.

You write the post, add the image and include a link so customers can find the details. Then a message appears: You have used your allotted posts with links for the month. Want to share more? There is a paid subscription for that.

That is what we encountered while preparing posts for Oklahoma's Choice Weekly in late September.

The notice in our Meta Business Suite account limited us to two posts with links per month and offered Meta One as a way to post more. For a business sharing auctions, events and advertiser information, two links do not go very far.

This does not mean every Facebook Page faces the same restriction. Meta has been testing link limits on certain accounts, and experiences can differ. It does mean businesses need to pay attention to what their own accounts allow, rather than assume yesterday's posting routine will work tomorrow.

A website link serves a purpose. It takes someone from noticing an auction to reviewing the catalog, from seeing an event to finding the details, or from discovering a business to exploring what it offers. When that step becomes harder, the advertiser has to find another way to help the customer follow through.

Facebook can still be useful. Businesses can show their work, answer questions, introduce employees and stay involved in their communities. We continue to use it ourselves.

But a Facebook Page should be one part of a business's advertising plan. When your entire customer connection depends on a platform you do not control, a change in that platform becomes a change in how you do business.

The practical response is to give customers several ways to find you.

Keep your website current. Make your phone number, location and hours easy to find. Build an email list with permission from the people joining it. Use print and digital advertising to reach people beyond your followers. When you post on social media, include enough useful information that someone can understand the offer even without clicking a link.

Then pay attention to what produces results. Ask customers where they heard about you. Notice which efforts bring calls, visits, inquiries and sales. Those answers can help you decide where your advertising dollars belong.

Before purchasing a subscription, consider what it actually provides and whether that feature is worth the cost to your business. Being able to publish more links is one benefit; getting customers to act on them is a separate challenge.

At Oklahoma's Choice Weekly, our approach includes print, digital editions

and social promotion because customers discover businesses in different places. A shopper may keep a printed ad, browse a digital edition or notice a social post. Each gives that business another opportunity to be found.

Small businesses already have enough to manage without rebuilding their advertising plans every time a platform changes a feature. Keep using the channels that work. Keep watching the results. And give your customers more than one road to your door.

Awareness is a beginning. Action matters all year.

A pink ribbon can start a conversation. Let it lead to a screening appointment, a question about a change, or a practical offer of help. Breast cancer affects real people in our communities, and support should last beyond October.

01 / MAKE A SCREENING PLAN

Know when to go.

For women at average risk, the U.S. Preventive Services Task Force recommends a mammogram every two years from ages 40 through 74. Screening looks for cancer before symptoms appear. [1]

Your personal history, family history and other risk factors may call for a different plan. Ask your clinician when to begin, how often to screen and whether additional tests are appropriate. Discuss the benefits and possible downsides of screening. [1, 2]

Already noticed a change? Tell your clinician promptly. Do not wait for your next routine mammogram. [3]

02 / PAY ATTENTION TO CHANGES

Know your normal.

Contact a healthcare professional about a new or unusual breast change, including: [3]

- A lump in the breast or underarm; thickening or swelling.
- Skin dimpling, redness, irritation or flaking.
- A nipple that pulls inward, or discharge other than breast milk.
- A change in breast size or shape, or breast pain.

These changes can have causes other than cancer. Getting them checked is how you find out. Some breast cancers cause no symptoms. [3]

You do not have to do this alone.

Information. A ride. A meal. A listening ear. Support can take many forms.

03 / SHOW UP FOR SOMEONE

Make the offer specific.

Try “Can I bring dinner Tuesday?” or “Would a ride to your appointment help?” Listen without trying to fix every feeling. Follow their lead about visitors, updates and privacy. Keep checking in after the first rush of concern.

04 / TAKE THE NEXT STEP

Bring your questions.

Ask: When is my next mammogram due? Does my family history change my screening plan? What happens if a result needs follow-up? Write down your questions and make sure you know how and when you will receive results.

Jack-o'-Lantern Stuffed Peppers

These grinning orange peppers are filled with seasoned beef, rice, tomato and melted cheese. They're festive enough for Halloween and substantial enough to count as dinner.

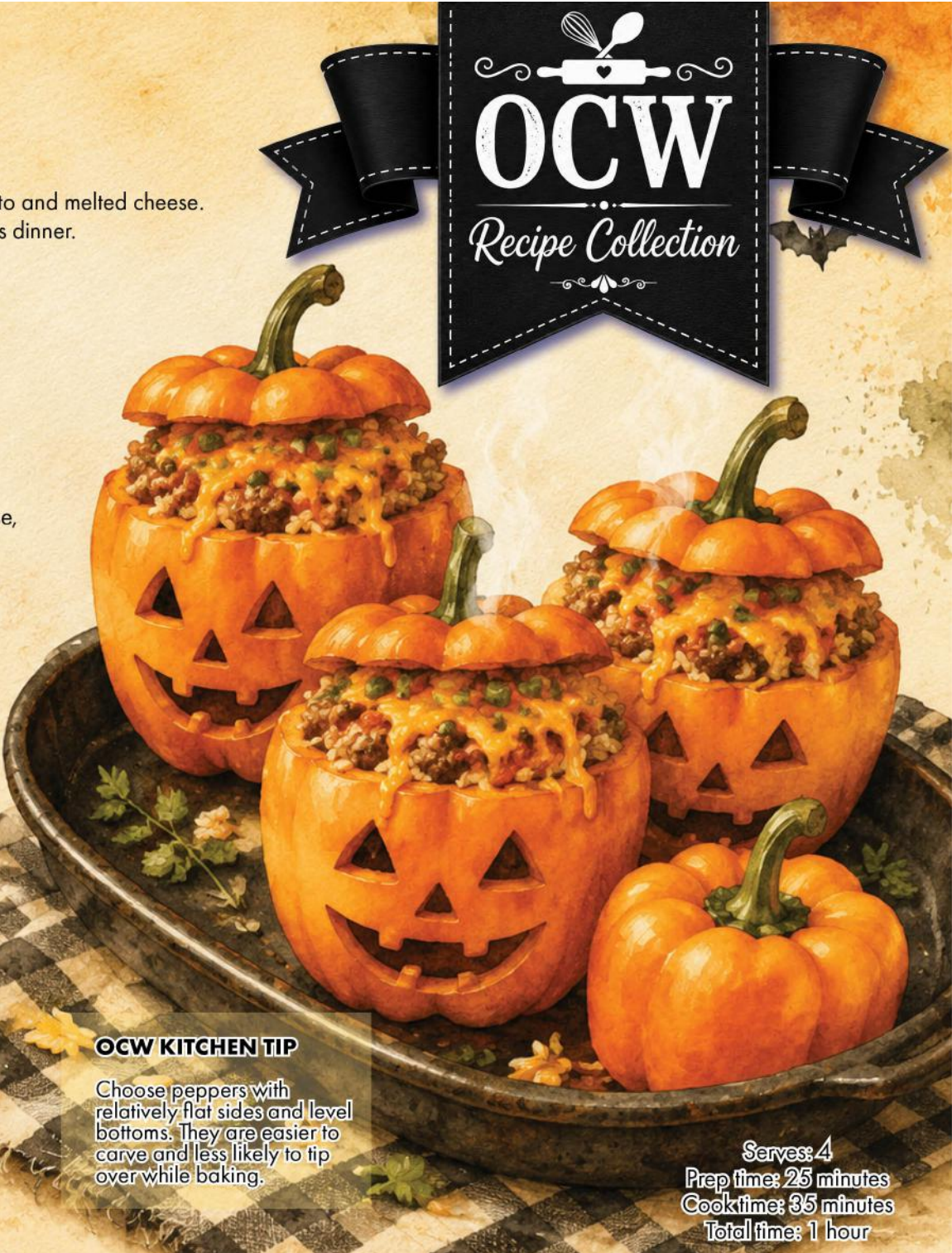
Jack-o'-Lantern Stuffed Peppers

Ingredients	
4 large orange bell peppers	½ teaspoon smoked paprika
1 tablespoon olive oil	½ teaspoon salt
1 pound lean ground beef	¼ teaspoon black pepper
½ cup diced onion	1 cup cooked rice
2 cloves garlic, minced	1 cup tomato sauce
1 teaspoon chili powder	1 cup shredded cheddar cheese, divided
1 teaspoon ground cumin	¼ cup sliced green onions

Directions

1. Preheat the oven to 350°F. Lightly grease a baking dish.
2. Cut the tops from the peppers and remove the seeds and membranes. Using a small paring knife, carefully cut jack-o'-lantern faces into one side of each pepper.
3. Heat the olive oil in a large skillet over medium heat. Add the ground beef and onion. Cook until the beef is browned and the onion is tender. Drain excess grease.
4. Add the garlic, chili powder, cumin, paprika, salt and pepper. Cook for 30 seconds.
5. Stir in the rice, tomato sauce, ¾ cup of the cheese and the green onions.
6. Spoon the filling into the peppers and place them upright in the baking dish. Sprinkle with the remaining cheese and replace the pepper tops.
7. Cover loosely with foil and bake for 25 minutes. Remove the foil and bake for another 10 minutes, or until the peppers are tender.
