- ***Volunteer Board of Directors - with family ties to the working mill***

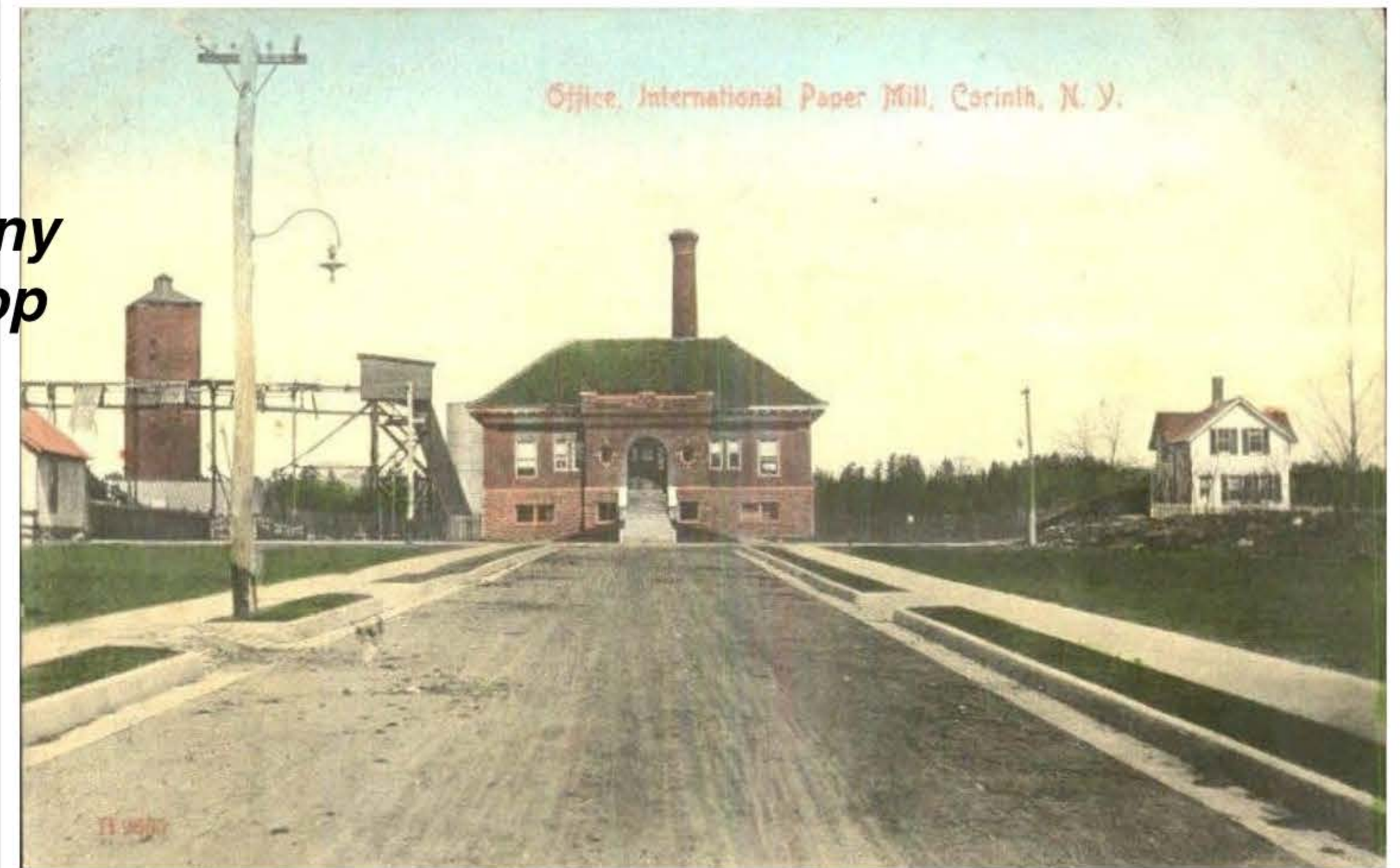
Our Mission Statement

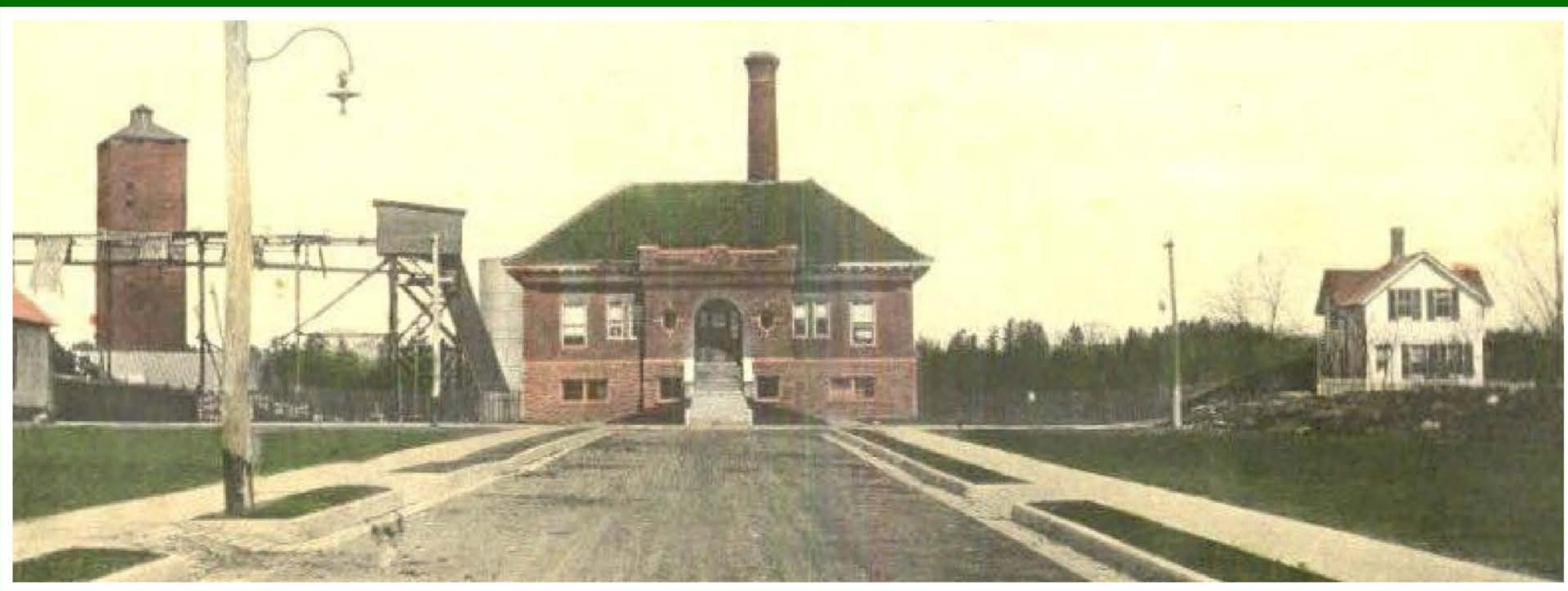


- ***The mission of the Paper Museum of New York is to inspire Corinth, New York, area residents and seasonal visitors to explore the history of pulp and paper manufacturing in northern New York State; the pulp and paper industry's impact on the development of organized labor in the industry, and paper making's environmental impact on the Hudson River and the Adirondack region.***

A Glimpse of the Past

- ***Pagenstecher Family - 1869***
First wood based newspaper paper mill in
- ***New York***
The Hudson River Pulp and Paper Company
at Palmer Falls - 1880 - highest natural drop
- ***on the entire river***
From 17 Mills to IPCO - 1898
From Newsprint to Coated Paper - after
WWII







- ***International Paper Administration Building and Time Office (IP Time Office) - is the sole surviving structure on the grounds that once employed a work force of 1,700 during the 1960's. It was at one time considered to be the largest pulp & paper mill of its kind in the US.***
- ***Closure of the Mill - 2002 - after 133 years of continuous operation. IP discontinued the production of speciality paper which the smaller machines at Corinth could only handle. At this point there were 290 employees.***



- ***Demolition - 2012 - NorthStar was hired for the abatement, deconstruction and asset recovery on the Mill Project. They dealt with approximately 50 structures ranging from 1,000,000 gallon oil tanks, 50 foot concrete/steel silos to large concrete/steel buildings.***
- ***Avoiding disruption to the critical services provided by the three adjoining facilities - 2 active power generating plants and a waste water treatment plant.***
