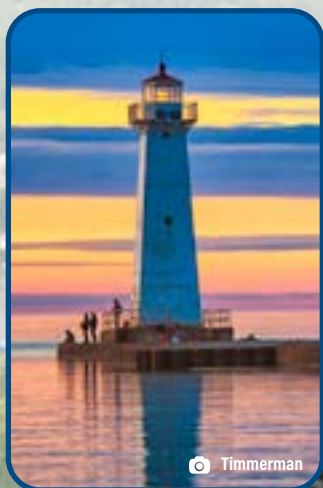

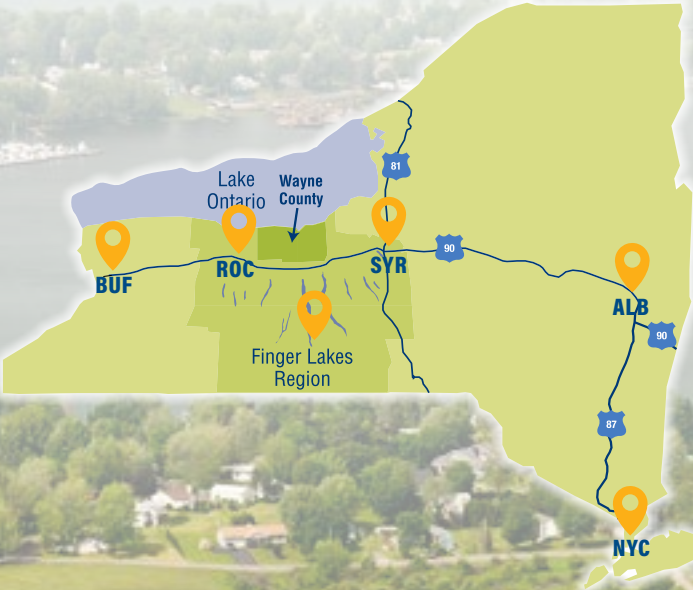

By facilitating affordable and efficient transportation of goods, the canal has supported the growth of agriculture and industry, while also remaining a popular spot for tourists. Wayne County is rich with remnants of the original canal, including aqueducts and locks. Offering wonderful opportunities for sightseeing and photography.

The Erie Canal is a year-round destination for family recreation, where visitors receive a warm welcome. It plays a pivotal role in various community events throughout the year and features a range of tourist attractions available daily.

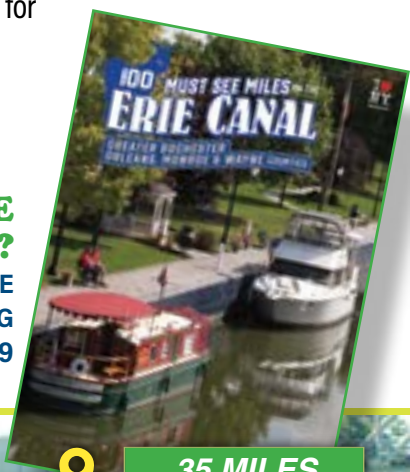

CHIMNEY BLUFFS STATE PARK

7700 Garner Road, Huron

Towering 150 feet above Lake Ontario in Wayne County's Town of Huron, Chimney Bluffs was formed by a glacier between six and ten thousand years ago and then eroded over many years by waves and weather. Acquired by New York State in 1967, the ever-changing formations are a part of 597-acre Chimney Bluffs State Park. Hike the trails or walk the shoreline; the bluffs will leave you spellbound! Pack a picnic lunch and enjoy the beauty that nature provided.



CAMP BEECHWOOD

Camp Beechwood is located on the shore of Lake Ontario with 3500 feet of shoreline, the 288-acre property housed a former Girl Scout Camp that operated from 1929 to the early 1990's. It is a unique opportunity to explore the former camp structures combined with awesome shoreline views of Lake Ontario and Maxwell Creek. Parking areas are at the east and west entrances of the park.

Located in the Hamlet of Pultneyville, this 77-acre nature preserve owned by Genesee Land Trust offers walking trails, spectacular views of Lake Ontario and plenty of wildlife viewing opportunities. Highlights of the property include frontage along Lake Ontario, mature woodlands and a wildflower meadow. Visit other Genesee Land Trust conservation lands in Wayne County including Macyville Woods Nature Preserve, Ganargua Creek Meadow Preserve, Kraai Preserve and the Maguire Family Wildlife Sanctuary. MONTEZUMA WETLANDS COMPLEX

The Complex includes federally-owned Montezuma National Wildlife Refuge, state-owned Northern Wildlife Management Area, land owned by private conservation organizations and private property. The MWC is an important wetland complex in the Atlantic Flyway, which provides habitat for 386 species of fish and wildlife.

A gateway for adults and school-aged children to get involved in local conservation efforts and experience the wonder of the outdoors. The center houses a large exhibit area, nature store and meeting rooms. On its 198 acres, there are five types of habitat, two restored marshes, two-miles of trails, and an all-access observation platform. Canoes, kayaks and snowshoes are available to access the heart of Montezuma's wetlands, forests and grasslands. Other recreational opportunities include nature photography, cross-country skiing, fishing, picnicking, wildlife viewing and hiking.

HIKING & BIKING

When traveling folks plan on visiting the rural beauty of Wayne County, outdoor recreation is usually at the top of the “to-do” list. We border Lake Ontario on the north and the historic Erie Canal on the south. Between those geographical icons you’ll find a variety of trails.

The biking and hiking trails in the southern region of the county follow the historic Erie Canal where the terrain is relatively flat.

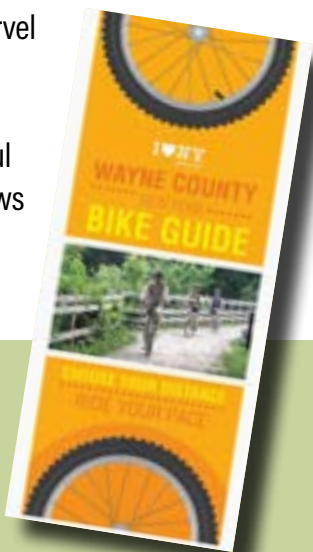

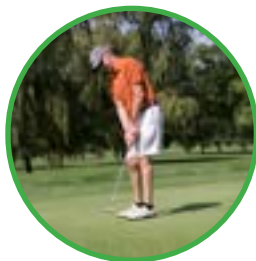

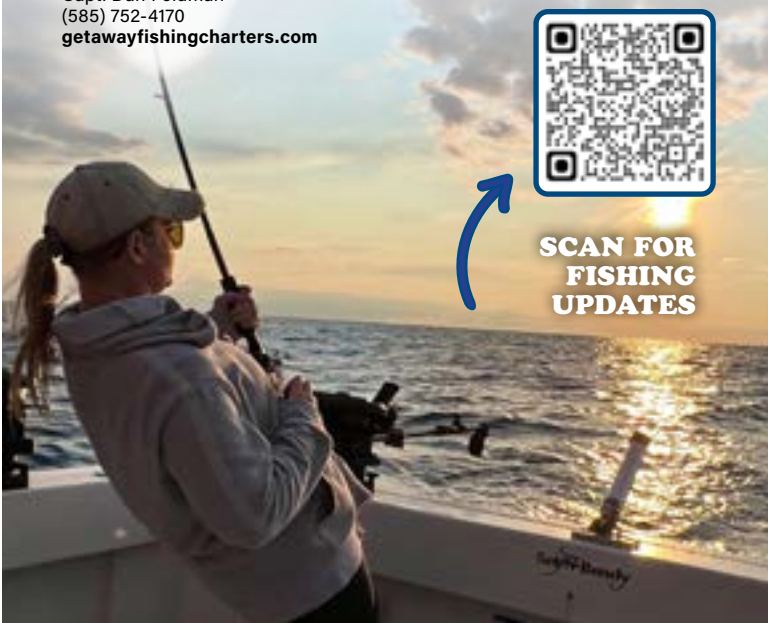

Anglers can reel in Chinook Salmon, Lake Trout, Steelhead and Coho Salmon in the **Great Lake**, or test their skills in the **warmer bays** for Pike, Bass, Perch, Walleye and Panfish. **Stream fishing** thrives year-round, particularly in the renowned **Maxwell and Salmon Creeks**, where the autumn brings exciting trout and salmon runs, while winter and early spring promise thrilling steelhead action.

Experience a serene day on the historic **Erie Canal**, where you can fish for Channel Catfish and Carp that will put your rod to the test like a prized Salmon. From the shore you can reel in Perch, Crappies, Bluegills and Sunfish, or you can launch your boat from one of the numerous public access points along the scenic waterway.

Sodus Bay has long been celebrated as the **ice fishing capital of western New York**. Spanning 3,000 acres, this inviting embayment offers a diverse range of fish species, drawing in dedicated winter anglers. With Pike, Perch, Bluegills and Walleye as the primary targets, you're sure to reel in a satisfying catch no matter where you cast your lines. For the **competitive fisherman**, we host a number of **fishing derbies**.

MUSEUMS & HISTORIC SITES

Wayne County
welcomes you
to experience our
rich heritage.



Over 250 historic markers, plaques

and other signage about historic events, sites and people inform the public about Wayne County's local history. National Register of Historic Places markers designate historic sites and districts.

The **blue and yellow markers** with the

outline of New York State on them are based on documented facts with sources from the time the event happened. **Legends and Lore markers** highlight stories that cannot be documented with facts, as well as stories passed from one generation to another. Other markers include **soldiers of the American Revolution, historic sites along the Erie Canal** and **Women's Suffrage**. Local kiosk type signs may be found in communities telling in more detail the stories of Wayne County's past. These markers and plaques, many sponsored by the William G. Pomeroy Foundation, reflect and preserve the diverse and significant contributions of Wayne County people.
