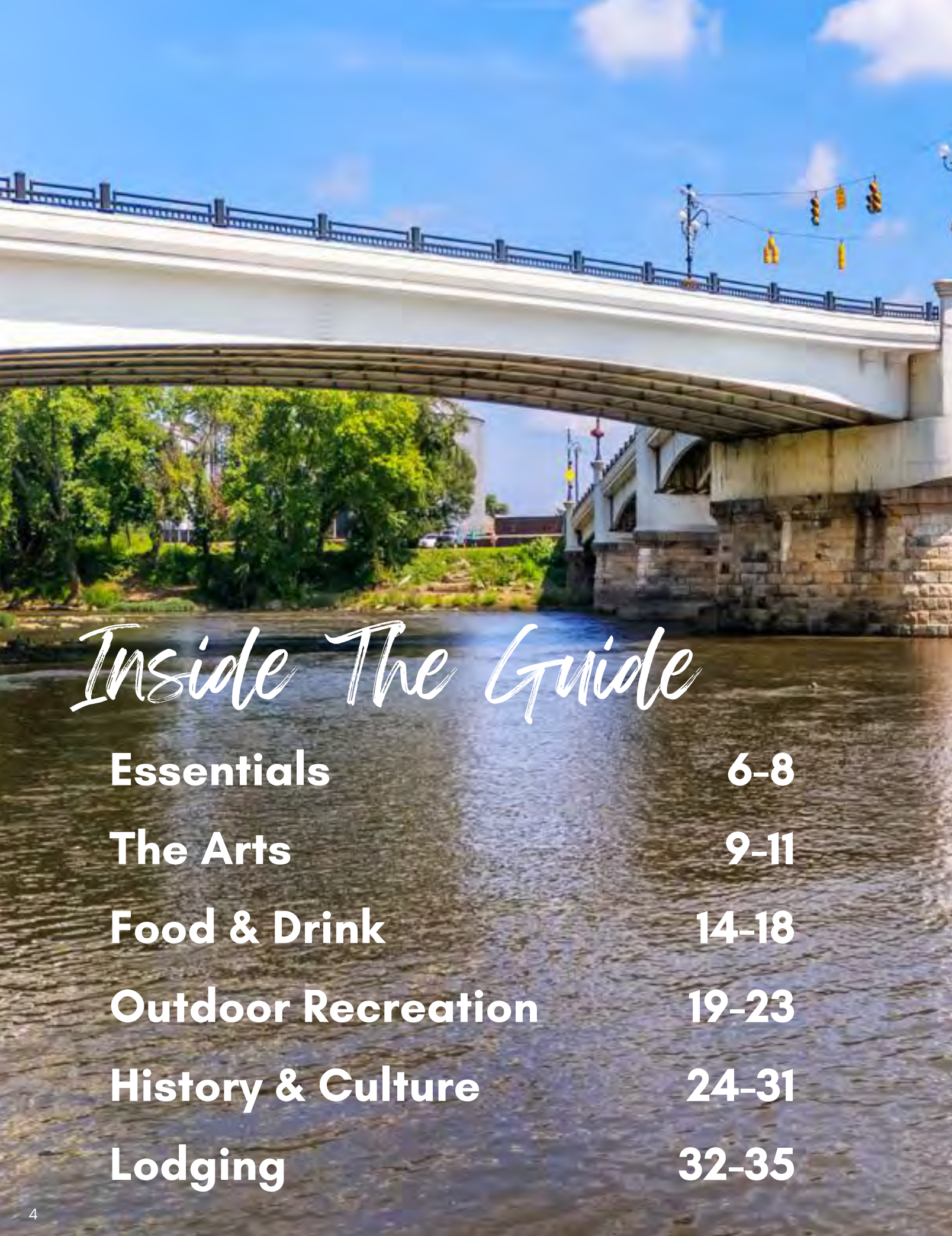

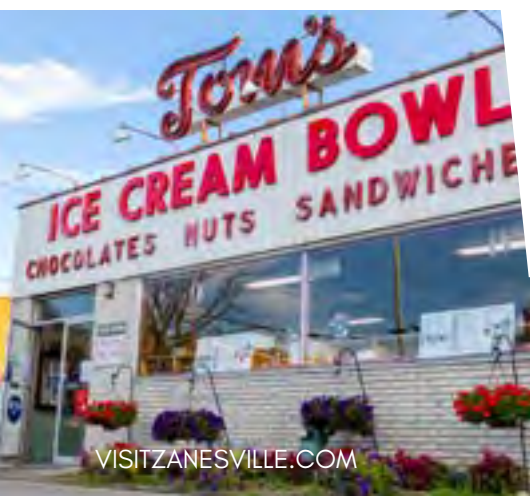

Stretching 159 miles through the hills of Southeastern Ohio, the Triple Nickel offers a ride that stays with you long after the engine cools. The moment you drop onto 555, you feel the rhythm of the road take over. Curves fold into sweeping views, tight dips lead to open ridgelines, and every mile brings something new.

Starting south of Zanesville, this route lets you settle into the freedom of the ride. Whether you are carving through the tight bends or taking in the quiet beauty of the countryside, the Triple Nickel gives you the perfect blend of adrenaline and scenery. This is a ride that stays honest, keeps you focused, and rewards you at every turn.

Why Riders Love the 555

You won't find long straightaways here. The Triple Nickel winds through rolling hills, farmland, and wooded stretches that keep you fully engaged from start to finish. The natural flow of the road makes every turn feel intentional, offering a ride that is both challenging and incredibly scenic. If you love a route that feels alive, this one delivers.

How the Ride Feels

You'll hit stretches of smooth sweepers, tight low-speed curves, and quick elevation changes that make the 555 a rider favorite. The views open unexpectedly around hilltops, and the quiet stretches give you room to settle into the moment. Some riders say it feels like stepping back into a simpler time, where the road takes center stage and the scenery keeps unfolding around you.

Ride Out & Back

With easy access to lodging, food, and local attractions, Zanesville is a perfect starting and ending point for your Triple Nickel adventure. You can gear up in town, enjoy the full ride, then come back for a great meal, a scenic stop, or another route from your map.

A Route to Remember

The 555 is the kind of ride people talk about for years. You feel every curve, every rise and drop, every quiet mile that lets you breathe. It's the perfect way to reconnect with the joy of riding, clear your head, and take in the beauty of Muskingum County and beyond. Whether it's your first time or your fiftieth, the Triple Nickel always delivers something new.

Grab a free rider's map featuring the full 555 route and four additional scenic Ohio rides to start planning your next Triple Nickel adventure.

Amish Country Tour

Ride through the heart of **Ohio's Amish Country**, where rolling farmland, quiet roads, and handcrafted traditions surround you at every turn. You can stop for homemade meals, fresh cheeses, small-batch chocolates, or one-of-a-kind goods made by talented artisans. It is a calm route that lets you take in the countryside, and enjoy a new side of Ohio.

AMA Tour

A smooth ride through rolling farmland just west of Zanesville. The route leads you toward the outskirts of **Columbus**, passing peaceful lakes and long, sweeping curves that are perfect for clearing your mind. Midway through, you can stop at the **AMA Motorcycle Hall of Fame Museum**, a favorite for riders who appreciate the history and heritage of motorcycles.

THE HISTORIC Y-BRIDGE

Where the Muskingum and Licking Rivers meet, Zanesville rises around a structure found nowhere else in the United States: the legendary **Y-Bridge**. More than a roadway, this remarkable design has shaped transportation, commerce, neighborhood identity, and the story of Zanesville for more than 200 years. Travelers from around the country stop to glimpse this rare three-way bridge, while locals simply call it part of daily life. Yet beneath its steel and concrete lies a dramatic history of engineering ingenuity, devastating floods, community pride, and five generations of bridges built on the same unforgettable footprint.

1814: A New Kind of Crossing

The first Y-Bridge rose in 1814 after the Ohio General Assembly approved a charter to connect Zanesville with the neighboring towns of Putnam, Natchez, and West Zanesville. These communities would eventually unify into the city we know today. Built with a limestone center pier and wooden outer supports, the bridge was uncovered and operated as a toll bridge.

Churchgoers, funeral processions, and military groups crossed for free, but most travelers paid to experience this unusual new route that split mid-river.

The structure was fragile from the beginning. Only four years later, a heavy flood swept it away.

1819: The Second Attempt

Determined to restore the crucial crossing, construction on a second wooden, uncovered toll bridge began immediately. It opened in 1819, but with new roads bringing heavier traffic into Zanesville, the bridge quickly showed its limitations. After just 12 years, the structure was declared unsafe. Zanesville needed something stronger and more visionary.

The Y-Bridge stands as the nation's only functioning three-way bridge. Its rare design is a must-see landmark for visitors. Check out the best view from Putnam Hill Park.



1832: Tragedy and Triumph

The third Y-Bridge became the city's first covered design, engineered by Catherinus Buckingham under the supervision of his father, Ebenezer. Their work took a dramatic turn during a flood, when rising waters threatened the temporary supports. Ebenezer ordered the wedges removed, hoping the waters would wash away the supports without taking the bridge. Instead, the span collapsed, and Ebenezer Buckingham was killed.

Catherinus completed the project in his honor. This third bridge would stand for 68 years, becoming woven into Zanesville's identity.

1868: Free to Cross

When the county purchased the bridge in 1868 and removed the toll, the Y-Bridge became an important force in the unification of Zanesville with its surrounding communities. With free passage, commerce expanded and daily travel between the communities grew easier than ever.

1902: A New Century & Bridge

Concerns about safety resurfaced, and in 1900 the community voted to replace the aging wooden structure. The fourth Y-Bridge, completed in 1902, was a massive, uncovered reinforced-concrete bridge, one of the earliest of its kind in Ohio. Strong, modern, and bold, it carried the region into a new era of expansion and would last for 81 years.

1984: The Fifth Y-Bridge

Though early warnings appeared as far back as the 1940s, significant deterioration wasn't fully confronted until 1983, when the main span of the concrete bridge was demolished. Construction began immediately on the fifth and current Y-Bridge. Completed in 1984, it was built of steel and concrete and intentionally designed to resemble the beloved 1902 structure.

Today, it remains an essential part of everyday transportation, linking neighborhoods, supporting commerce, and standing proudly as one of the most distinctive bridges in the nation.

J. W. Longaberger learned to weave in Dresden and kept the tradition alive for decades. His son, Dave, carried that passion forward by opening the first shop in the 1970s. Every basket was handmade, signed by its maker, and created with a focus on quality that people could feel.

A National Favorite

By the 1980s and 1990s, Longaberger baskets were beloved across the country. Home shows, consultants, and collectors helped turn a local craft into a nationwide favorite. The famous Basket Building became a symbol of the brand's creativity and remains one of Ohio's most memorable landmarks.

Communities Shaped by Craft

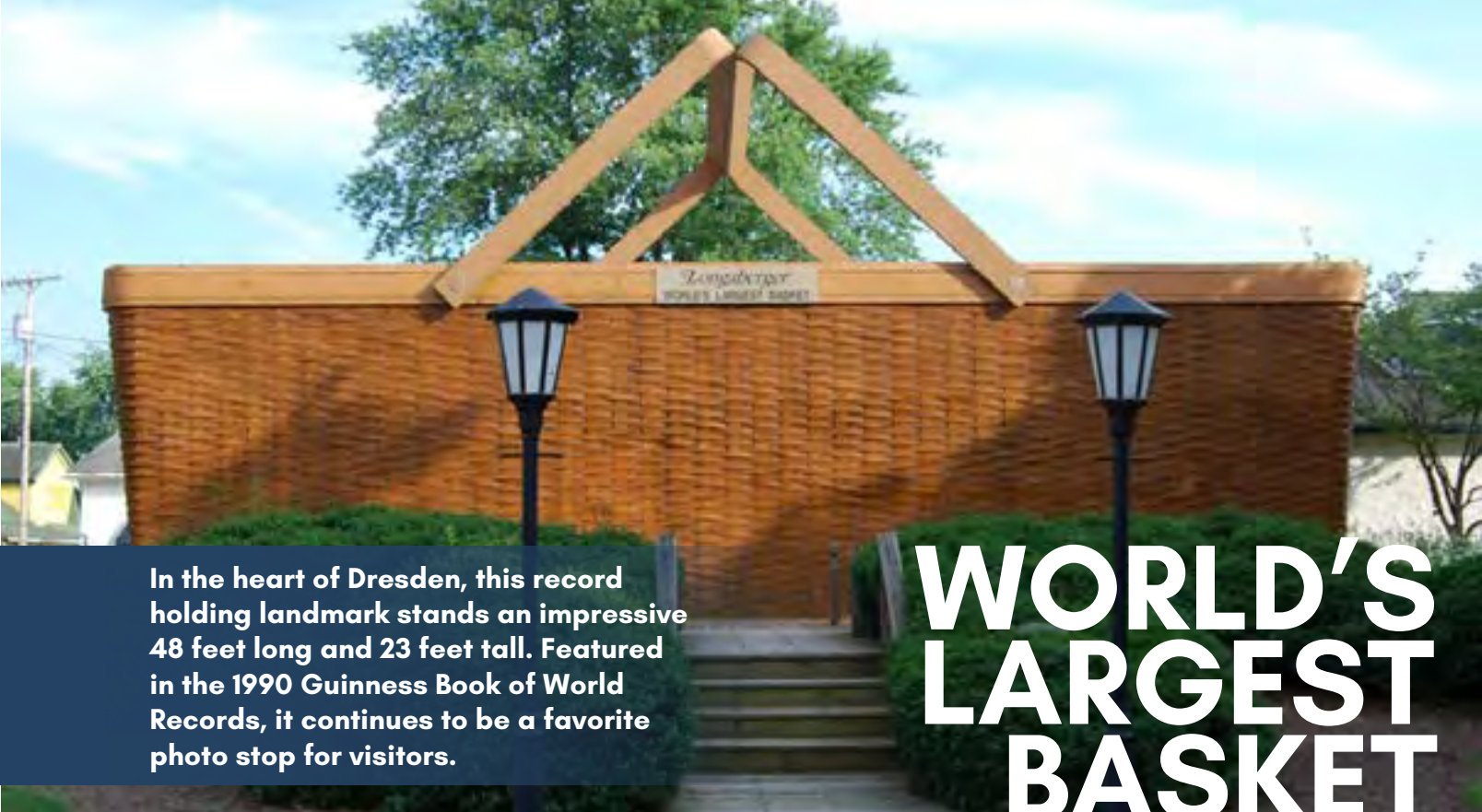
The villages of Dresden and Frazeytsburg grew alongside the company. Factories buzzed with artisans, families found opportunity in skilled work, and entire communities felt connected to the tradition of weaving. Longaberger became part of daily life and local pride.

A Legacy That Lives On

While the company has changed, the love for Longaberger remains strong. Collectors still treasure their baskets, and new generations travel here to learn about the craft. Dresden continues the tradition through modern makers who are keeping basket weaving alive.

John Glenn's Journey Begins in New Concord, Ohio

Long before John Glenn became a Marine pilot, record-setting test pilot, astronaut, and United States Senator, he was a boy growing up in New Concord, only 15 minutes outside of Zanesville. His childhood was shaped by curious afternoons, hardworking parents, and a community that encouraged his early interest in flight. As you explore his story, you will step into the world that shaped one of America's most enduring heroes and discover how deeply his legacy lives on here.

Early Roots and Rising Dreams

John Glenn's journey began in a close-knit town filled with Muskingum College students, a hands-on father, and a mother who inspired learning. Growing up surrounded by older students and the rhythm of small-town life sparked his fascination with science and aviation. These early years planted the seeds of curiosity and determination that carried him into service, exploration, and history.

A Life of Service and Firsts

Glenn flew 149 combat missions during World War II and Korea, later becoming a renowned test pilot. His skill earned him a place among NASA's original seven astronauts. In 1962, he piloted Friendship 7 and became the first American to orbit the Earth, a moment that lifted the nation's spirit. Glenn went on to serve Ohio in the United States Senate and returned to space aboard the Space Shuttle Discovery.

Annie Glenn's Advocacy

Annie Glenn built her own legacy of perseverance and advocacy. After overcoming a severe stutter through intensive therapy, she became a national voice for people with communication disorders. Her work on advisory boards and the awards she received reflect a lifetime of service, strength, and leadership.

Legacies of the Underground Railroad

The story of the Underground Railroad runs through Muskingum County, carried by people whose courage shaped the course of American history. This region stood at a pivotal crossroads, creating a landscape where bravery, conviction, and quiet resistance unfolded every day. Visitors can walk into spaces where freedom seekers once hid, where abolitionists risked their lives to protect them, and where voices for justice rose long before the Civil War. Each site preserves history and invites you to reflect, learn, and connect with the people whose choices changed countless lives. When you visit, you are stepping into stories that continue to inspire hope, resilience, and a deeper understanding of the past.

The **Stone Academy** stands as one of the county's earliest buildings and an important abolitionist landmark. State anti-slavery conventions met here, often facing violent opposition. Visitors can see the hidden trapdoor used to shelter freedom seekers, along with exhibits that share the building's political and cultural history.

The **Dr. Increase Mathews House**, built in 1805, offers a look into early life in Muskingum County. Restored rooms and curated exhibits highlight local medical, military, and domestic history, giving guests a clear sense of how families lived and worked in the early frontier community.

The **Nelson T. Gant Homestead** shares the remarkable story of Nelson Gant, born enslaved and later freed, who built a successful life in Zanesville with his wife, Anna. Recognized by the National Underground Railroad Network to Freedom, the property shares his journey, community contributions, and enduring legacy.

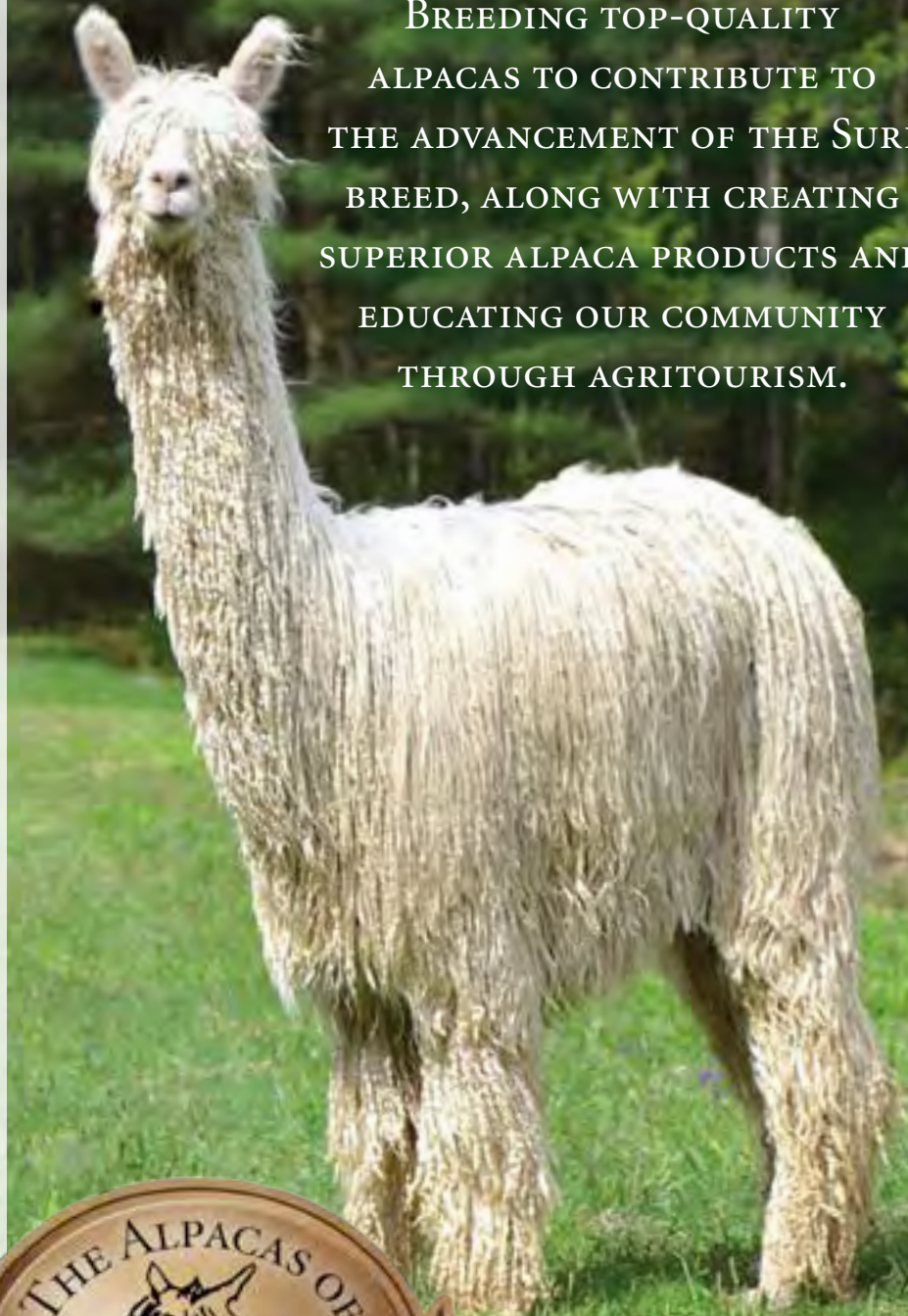
