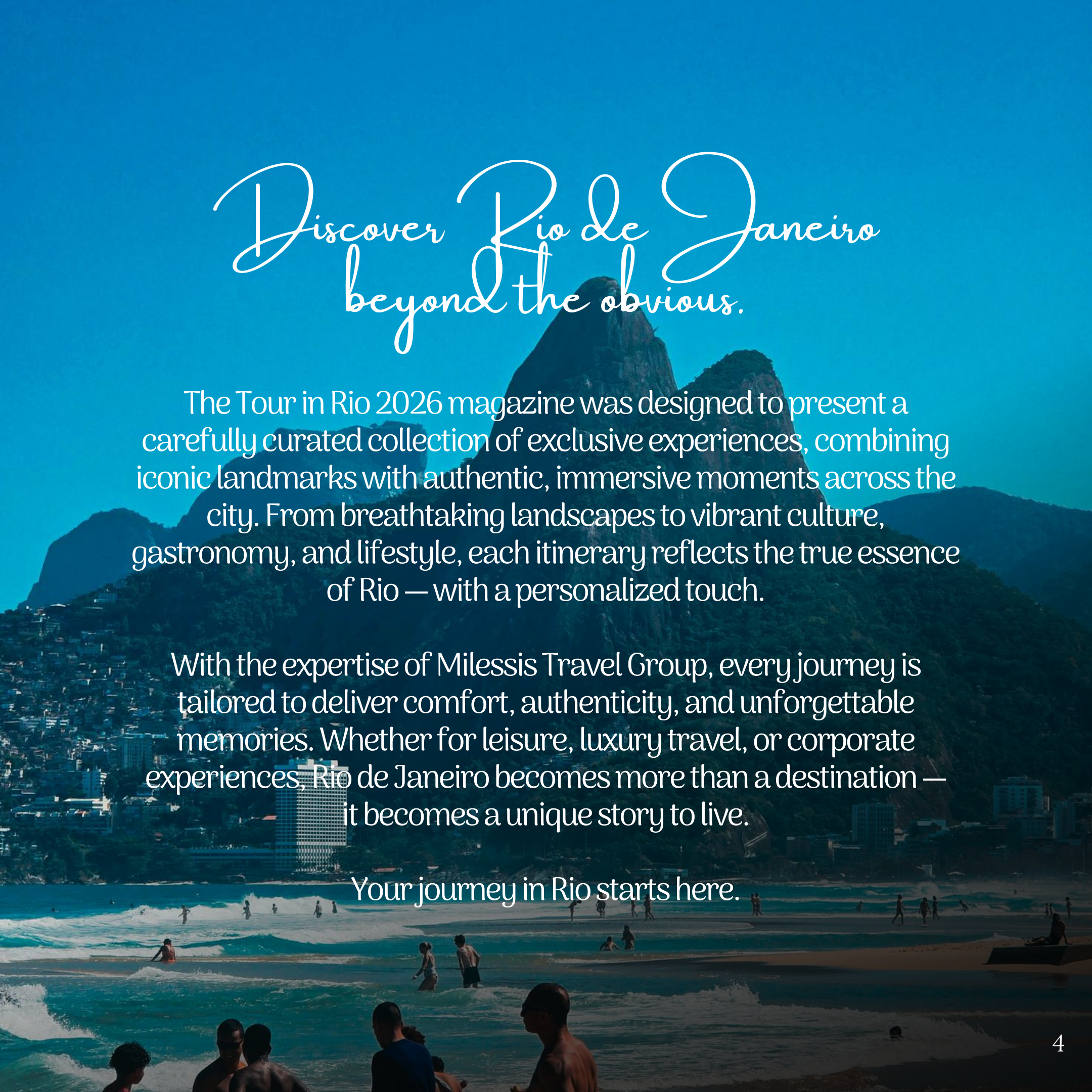

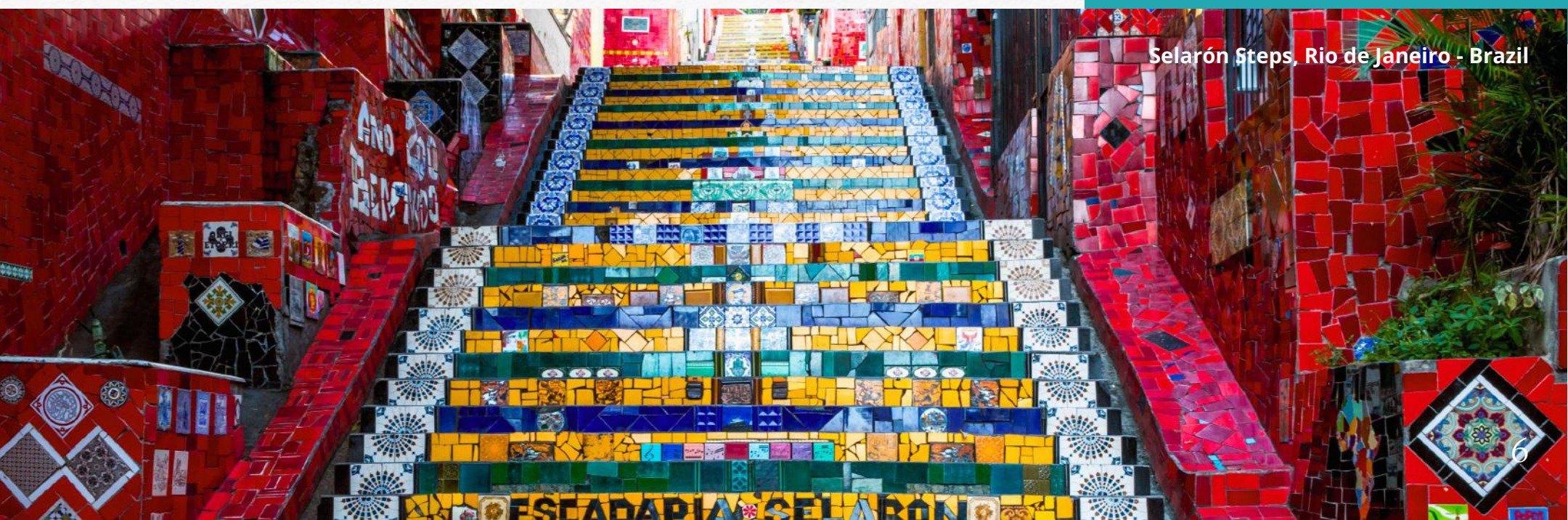

The Ethnicities Mural is a panel located in the Central Zone of the city of Rio de Janeiro. With 15 meters in height and 170 meters in length, it was painted by the artist Eduardo Kobra on the facade of an old warehouse due to the 2016 Summer Olympics. It holds the Guinness World Record as the largest urban graffiti in the world.

Bohemia Brewery (Cervejaria Bohemia): Visit the oldest brewery in Brazil, founded in 1853, to learn about the beer-making process and enjoy some local brews.

The House of Santos Dumont (Casa de Santos Dumont): The former residence of aviation pioneer Alberto Santos Dumont, known for its unique architecture.
