A note from Charlene SanJenks

I've spent the past 25 years working at the intersection of transformation, storytelling, leadership, and human potential. From investment services and local government to founding national women's leadership initiatives and now building regenerative media infrastructure, one thread has remained consistent throughout my work: I've always been deeply interested in what helps people expand into a fuller version of themselves, and what systems, stories, spaces, conditions, tools, and supports either empower or suppress this process.

I believe we are living through one of the most consequential narrative shifts in human history. The messages we consume daily shape our mood, mindset, identity, relationships, and ultimately the future we build together. Yet the digital systems surrounding us have largely been optimized for speed, stimulation, and attention extraction rather than coherence, discernment, or human wellbeing.

At reGEN, we are building what comes next, with care.

Designed with care at the core. Human-centered. Intuition-guided. Tech-enabled. Because narrative change precedes systems change. And orientation precedes optimization.

For reGEN, human flourishing is the purpose. Transformation, by design.

Earlier this year, we gathered in Melbourne, Australia for our inaugural Table of Twenty gathering. More recently, we also gathered in Toronto, Ontario.

A Table of Twenty is a highly curated, facilitated conversation for leaders ready to bring head and heart into deeper alignment, reimagining new narratives for what comes next.

What becomes possible when we set an intention, ignite our imagination, invite intuition, and create space around a guided practice of integration and implementation? Let's find out!

In Toronto we gathered with a remarkable group of founders, funders, innovators, creatives, and changemakers for our second Table of Twenty around the powerful question...

What would become possible if we designed technology, media, and story to help humanity hold belief long enough to build what comes next, regeneratively?

What emerged wasn't simply an inspiring conversation. It was confirmation. Confirmation that many of us are sensing the same shift.

Old ways of leading, creating, and building are no longer enough. Something more integrated, more regenerative, and more deeply human is beginning to emerge.

What's next? Our rhythm for the Table of Twenty will combine select in-person conversations in various locations and virtual 90-minute orientation sessions, Table of Twenty (Squared): Where Transformation Expands.

Together, we'll explore what became visible when remarkable people gather around one question, and what becomes possible when we continue to collectively weave into this co-created conversation guided by our imagination, intuitive, and intention for impact.

STORIES BUILD BELIEF. BELIEF BECOMES EMBODIED THROUGH INTENTIONAL PRACTICE.

At reGEN, we believe the future of media (screentime interactions) does not need to be passive. It is participatory. We can choose the incoming messages, inputs, and influences that affect our daily lives. And we're choosing relational, personalized, and intentional. Human-guided and tech-enabled in service of something much larger than engagement metrics alone.

The Story of Us is ultimately about interconnectedness. Our interdependence and shared becoming.

We often move through modern life as though we are separate from one another, yet nature reminds us constantly that thriving happens through relationship.

BELIEF. INTENTION. PRACTICE.



Beneath the forest floor exists a vast mycelium network, tiny interwoven threads connecting trees across entire ecosystems. Through this unseen intelligence, trees communicate. Nutrients are shared. Support is offered. Young saplings unable to reach the sunlight are nourished through the collective strength of the larger network surrounding them.

The Story of Us is about remembering that the pathways of healing, creativity, courage, leadership, and transformation are deeply interconnected. That our lives affect one another. That intentional interactions matter. That stories shape systems. That participation changes outcomes. And perhaps most importantly, that we are not alone.



This understanding is also what inspired an upcoming immersive live experience called The Story of Us, a responsive performance exploring collective awakening, participation, rhythm, and future imagination. The experience invites people to move beyond passive observation into active co-creation, where audience energy, voice, movement, and interaction help shape the unfolding experience in real time.

In many ways, the performance is simply another expression of the same deeper philosophy behind Akin and reGEN: The power of transformation compounds when collectively experienced.

This is not another course. Not another app. Not another one-off tool for self-improvement. What we are committed to is the foundational connective tissue of something much larger.

- Technology not designed simply to capture attention, but to strengthen connection.
- Incoming media, messages, and screen-based input not designed merely for consumption, but for nurturing regeneration.

Remembering ourselves, remembering one another, remembering that the future is something we shape together, one intentional - and regenerative - interaction at a time.

TECHNOLOGY IS AN ENABLING TOOL. LIKELY THE MOST POWERFUL ONE OF OUR GENERATION. BUT ENABLING WHAT?

Phase 1 of our work with Akin is rooted in remembering: Know thyself.

It begins with understanding your rhythms, values, patterns, priorities, and the often invisible gap between who you want to be and how you are living each day. Before optimization comes orientation. Before expansion comes awareness.

This is why Akin's early work centres on reflection, alignment, discernment, and daily relational check-ins.

Not because people are broken, but because many of us have been shaped by systems that disconnect us from ourselves. But the story does not end with the self. We are relational beings.

Healing, growth, and transformation are never entirely individual. They ripple into our families, communities, workplaces, ecosystems, and futures.

This is where Phase 2 begins. Not endless content or more noise. Not another algorithm competing for attention, but *personalized* care and fuel, including content, resources, and support, designed to help each person intentionally build the life they are here to live.

Human curators working with intentional technology to deliver what is resonant, nourishing, timely, and aligned. The goal is not more consumption. It is meaningful distillation for greater satiation and coherence.

AI FOR LIBERATION: TURNING TECHNOLOGY INTO POWER FOR FEMINIST MOVEMENTS

Author's Note: On April 28, 2026, Revolutionary Woman Global gathered at Women Deliver in Narm (Melbourne). Amidst the 6,000 delegates navigating the world's largest gender equality stage, we brought together over 200 feminist leaders, Indigenous activists, and grassroots organizers for our session AI for Liberation: Turning Technology into Power for Feminist Movements. Our mandate was clear: to show leaders that they have meaningful choices beyond Big Tech and to demonstrate how they could harness AI to escalate their movement's impact - without scaling harm - by grounding their work in ethical, values-aligned tools.



We are navigating the most potent technological shift of our era - a force actively rewriting our reality at breakneck speed. It leaves us at a critical divide: will we be the architects of this future, or its casualties? We are not here to let that choice be made for us; we did not gather to be passive spectators. We are here to seize that divide and redirect it toward the world we know is possible.

Are we building AI to accelerate the world as it is, with its unequal power and extraction? Or are we building it to create the world we know is possible?

Revolutionary Woman Global led this session with a clear goal: to demand that the systems shaping our future deliver justice for women and girls. Our team itself was a statement of this methodology in action, bridging geography and lived experience: uniting an Indigenous media-tech founder, a Rwandan technologist, an AI filmmaker, a tech systems thinker, and a matriarchal publisher. Feminist movements know that change happens at the intersections, not in silos. We united our expertise to show what becomes possible when we treat AI as a system to be stewarded.

FROM FEAR TO FLUENCY

When we asked the room what they feared, the responses were immediate and visceral surveillance, the extraction of sacred oral traditions, and the erosion of human trust.

Charlene SanJenko, CEO of reGEN Impact Media, noted that these fears weren't roadblocks. They were signposts, showing us exactly what our movements were fighting to protect: our safety, our stories, and our sovereignty.

The room then named what it stood for: Consent, Care, Accountability, Justice, Dignity, Trust, and Liberation. These values became our framework - the essential constraints we use to ensure that every AI tool we choose serves our community's liberation.

ON CURIOSITY, FEAR, AND WHO GETS LEFT BEHIND

The Great Inversion: What Happens When the Activists Become the Conservatives

In the span of twenty-one days, I traversed three distinct ideological continents: the radical feminist solidarity of Women Deliver in Melbourne, the silicon-slick disruption of Web Summit in Vancouver, and the impact storytelling ecosystem of Media That Matters. I went looking for the future of social change - as someone who works at the intersection of AI, storytelling, and advocacy - but I found something more unsettling: a cultural role-reversal where the systems builders are showing more flexibility than the activists. And where the people with the most to gain from powerful new tools are most at risk of being left behind by them.

RADICAL RESISTANCE OR RIGID TRADITIONALISM?

At Women Deliver, the main objective was to dismantle systems of oppression. Over 6,000 people converged from 189 countries to coalesce, collaborate, and provide input into the newly minted Melbourne Declaration, which advocates for protecting human rights, empowering strong feminist movements, and aligning global support to guarantee that dignity and justice are universally protected rights. The conference described itself as a radical space for movement-building designed to resist anti-rights movements. The goals it aims to address are urgent and real: bodily autonomy, climate justice, and decolonization - to name a few.

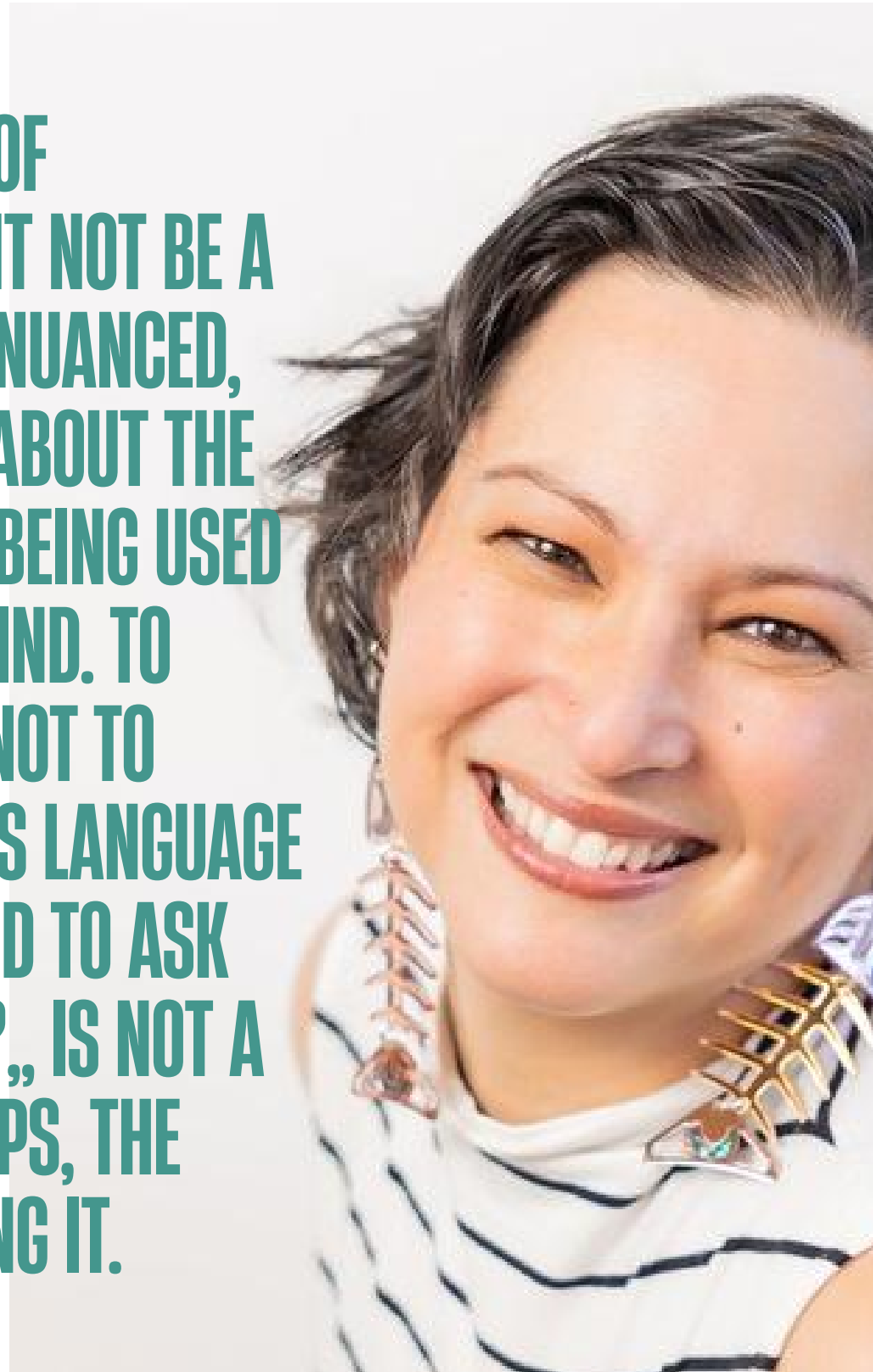


THE NEW NORTH STAR: AGGRESSIVE DISRUPTION

Meanwhile, at Web Summit, the atmosphere was one of relentless forward motion. With a mission to create meaningful connections between the CEOs and founders reshaping the world, the event focused on AI as the new "North Star." Under headings like "Always shipping, never safe" and "Designing intelligence, disrupting society," the tech elite framed themselves as the architects of a world-changing future.



THE MOST RADICAL ACT OF RESISTANCE TODAY MIGHT NOT BE A PROTEST. IT MIGHT BE A NUANCED, AGGRESSIVE CURIOSITY ABOUT THE VERY TOOLS CURRENTLY BEING USED TO LEAVE ACTIVISTS BEHIND. TO UNDERSTAND A TOOL IS NOT TO ENDORSE IT. TO LEARN ITS LANGUAGE IS NOT TO BECOME IT. AND TO ASK “HOW DOES THIS WORK?,” IS NOT A BETRAYAL – IT IS, PERHAPS, THE BEGINNING OF RECLAIMING IT.



THE IMPACT ANXIETY: FEAR OF THE TOOL

This tension reached its most personal pitch at Media That Matters. Here, among filmmakers and storytellers - my own people, or so I thought - I hoped to find the bridge. Instead, I found the fault line at its sharpest.

THE COST OF INFLEXIBILITY

The “aha” moment of this three-experience journey is that progressivism has changed its address. The tech builders, once the disruptors pushing at the edges of power, have moved toward a conservative consolidation of it. Meanwhile, the activists, in their legitimate fear of new digital architectures, have retreated into a posture that prioritizes resistance over mastery - and in doing so, risk ceding the most powerful levers of the 21st century to the very systems they hope to dismantle.

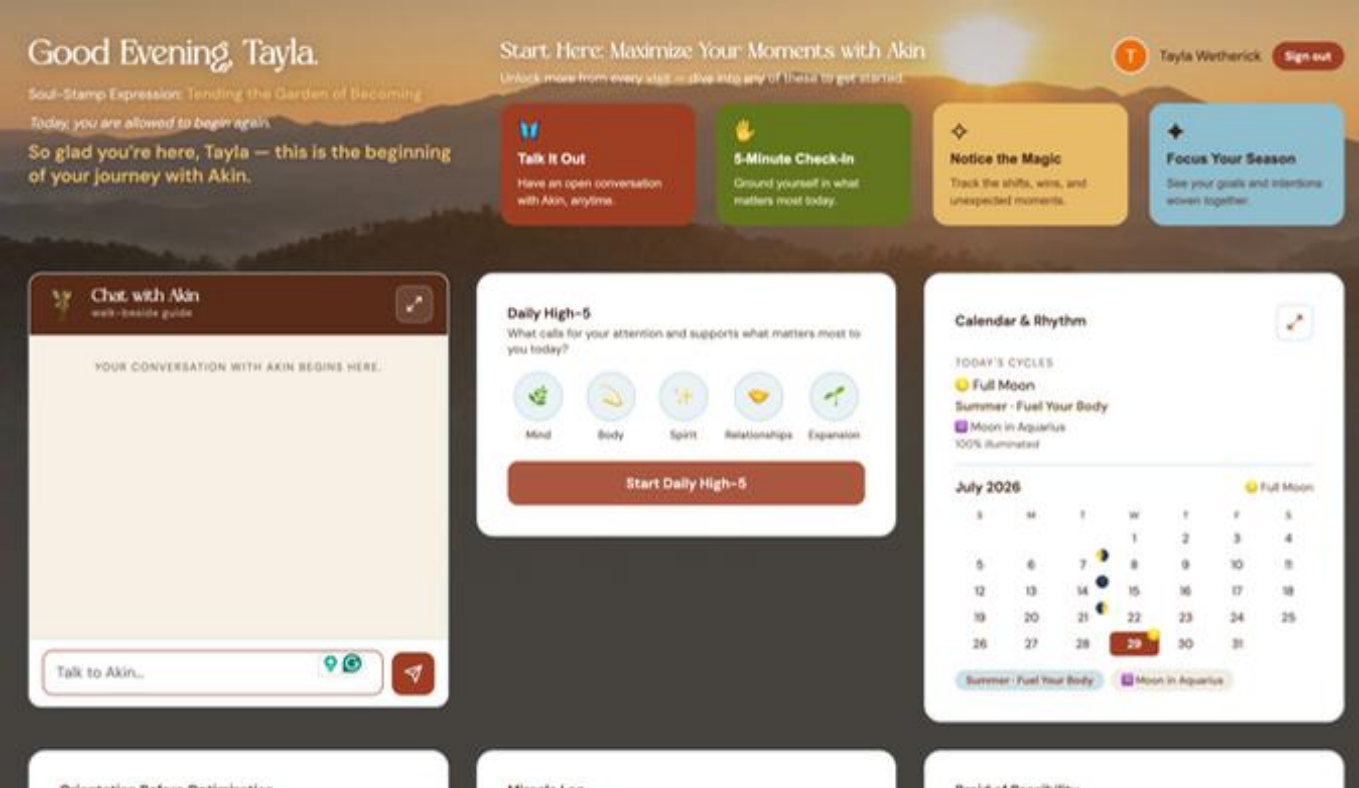

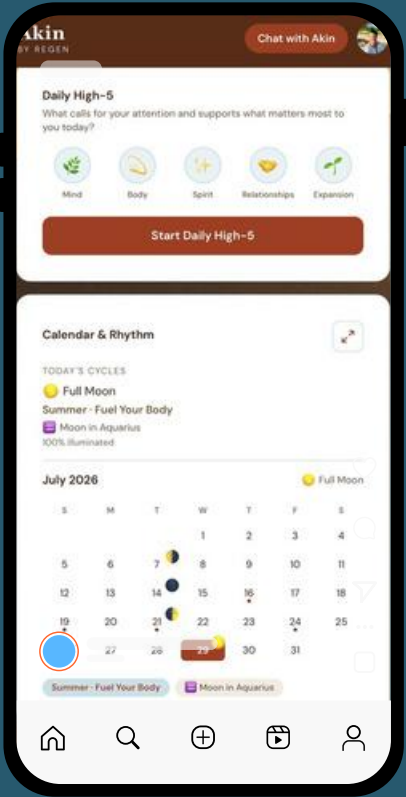

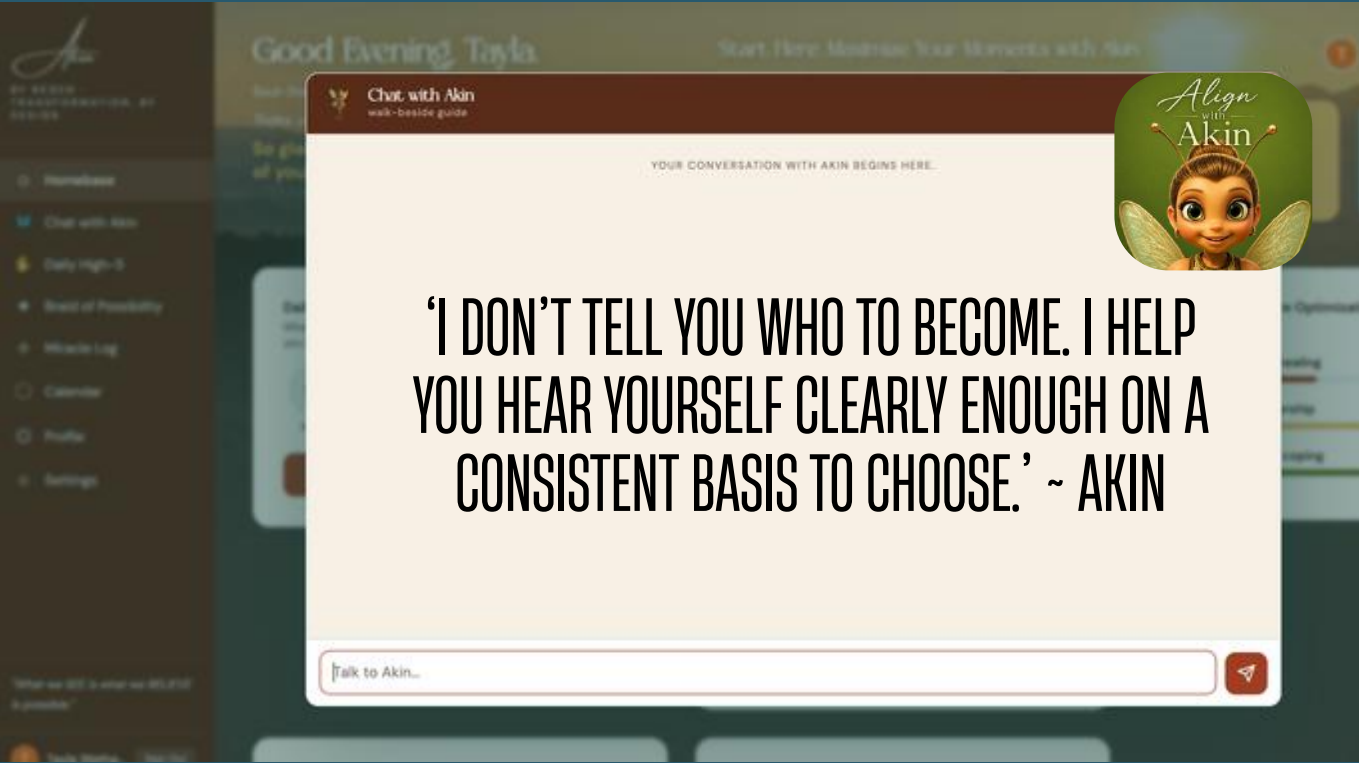
