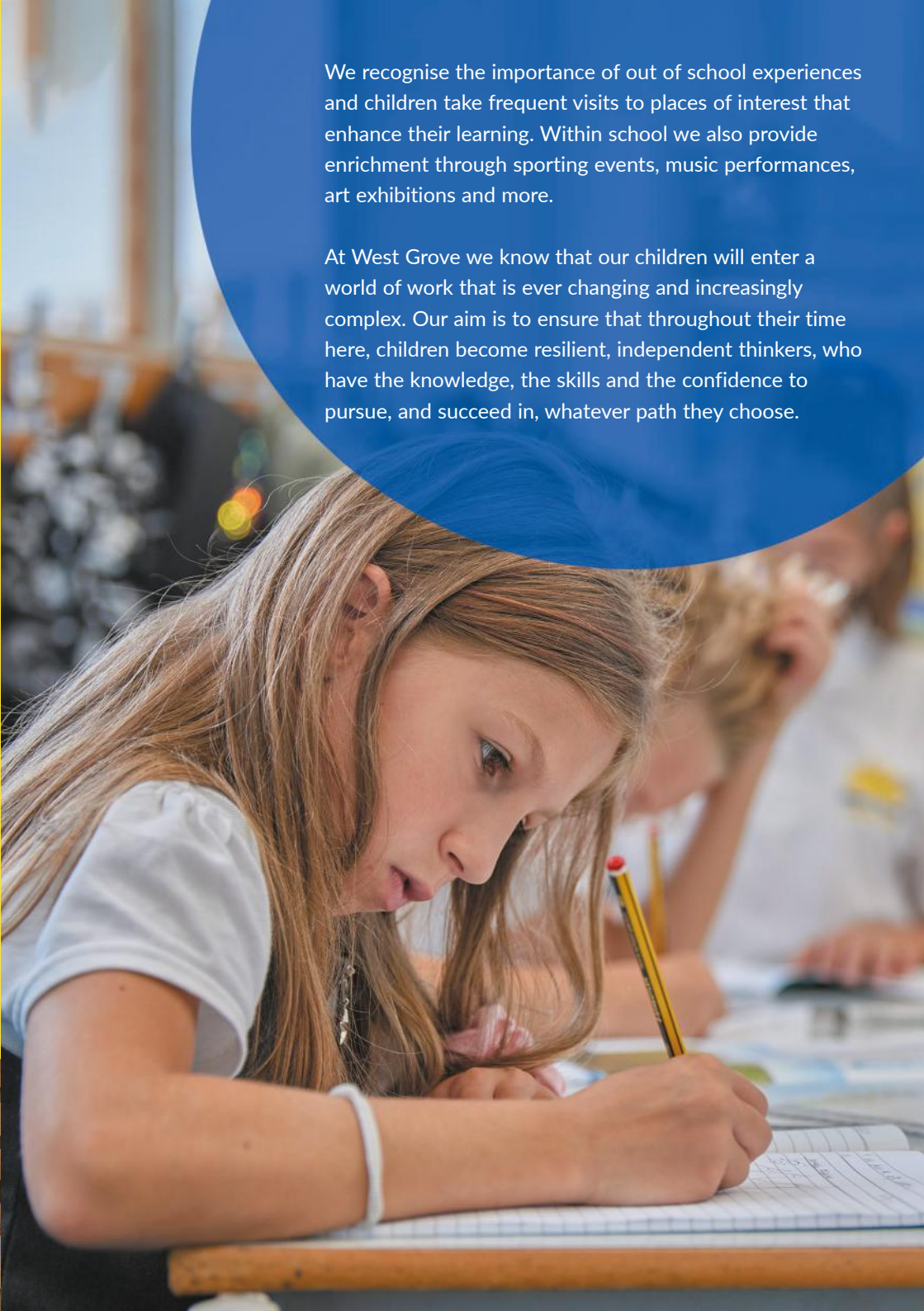


Our Curriculum

We are committed to providing a first class education for every child. Our curriculum is broad and balanced with resources designed to enhance and ignite learning. Our Enrichment

Children at West Grove benefit from a wide range of unique experiences and enrichment activities. Our specialist music teacher delivers whole-class sessions for all children from Nursery through to Year 6. These sessions include access to a wide variety of instrumental instruction, singing, dance and drama. Performances are then choreographed and performed for families throughout the year, developing children's confidence and creativity.

The outdoor spaces at West Grove are an integral part of our offer, we are so lucky to have large green spaces and other outdoor facilities. Alongside specialist sports lessons we take part in local leagues for football, basketball and cricket. Our sports days are an exciting annual event and we welcome families to join us for the competition and stay for a picnic with their child on our fantastic field.



Our Inclusion

At West Grove we value each child as an individual. We expect and enable every child to achieve their very best. Everyone is welcome here and inclusion is at the heart of everything we do. We ensure that all pupils have equal access to a broad, balanced curriculum, delivered through quality first teaching, which is adapted to meet individual needs and abilities.
