BIOGRAPHY OF JITEX

Onajite Okere, known in the rap world as JITEX, spent his formative years in Warri, Delta State, Nigeria. His musical path began to take shape in 1997, evolving from street freestyle sessions to producing hits in the recording studio.

Growing up in Nigeria posed its challenges, compounded by a lack of support, exorbitant studio fees, and scarce opportunities. Despite these hurdles, JITEX persevered and

triumphed. His track "OGHENEWHERE," featuring King Enkapodia, earned him the spotlight on the cover of the January issue of DG Magazine, based in St. Louis, USA. This exposure led to interest from Port City Music Group near Atlanta, Georgia, and airplay on Hot 2100 Savannah radio in Georgia. He has also been featured on L-Vegas Radio, hosted by DJ Lugar Slam in Nigeria.

JITEX has performed at various venues, including the Ko Convention Centre and Terra Kulture Arena in Victoria Island, Hard Rock Cafe in Lagos, The New Afrika Shrine in Ikeja, and Landmark Beach Event Centre in Victoria Island. In Warri, he's showcased his talent at locations like Warri Township Stadium, KFT Event Centre, Bowlers Event Centre, Warri City Stadium, Brown Hill Hotel, and Kool Up Hotel. His skills are integral to the expansion of Port City Music Group into Africa.
