SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT GIVES BACK!

- Can you tell us your name, what scholarship you received, and what college you attended?

My name is Charleigh Marks, and I was blessed with receiving the 3rd place Antioch Missionary Baptist Church scholarship totaling \$3,500, and the Lady Dorrie Scholarship totaling \$1,000. After I graduated from West Brook Senior High School in 2015, I then attended Stephen F. Austin State University in Nacogdoches, Texas where I obtained my Bachelors of Science in Communication Sciences and Disorders in 2019. I then went back to school in 2020 and graduated from Lamar University with a Masters in Science in Speech Language Pathology in 2022.



- What did it mean to you to be selected as a top scholarship recipient at Antioch?

The moment I found out that I won one of the top scholarships, I do believe I was in a state of shock, but also so blessed for the opportunity. We attend a church that pours into the youth and collects so much money to help with graduating seniors, and to be a recipient of that was a moment that caused me to be speechless, but also genuinely grateful.

- How did the scholarship impact your college journey—both financially and emotionally?

We all know that continuing your education is such an expensive expense. When we were in classes in the graduation ministry, it was always something that was talked about, but when you actually see the bill for your college expenses, it puts things into perspective really quickly. Winning the scholarships did impact my journey in a positive way both emotionally and financially. Instead of worrying where the money was going to come from, God allowed the blessing to flow in the ways of scholarships. This allowed not only me, but also my family, to relax and let God truly take it over and provide for us, and he did just that.

- After college, what inspired you to return to Antioch and get involved?

Antioch is home. I've always had the heart to help and give back. When I decided to begin to get active in my adult years in Antioch, helping the youth and sharing my story to help them navigate their story was always something that was easy for me to do. I learned so much in my years of being away in school. Coming back and reaching the next generation was something that needed to be done, and God just led me right to the high school youth and that is where my heart has been.

- How has being active in ministry shaped your personal and spiritual growth?

Being active in ministries helps with the foundation of our spiritual growth. As we have heard before, “you do better when you know better”. In these ministries, it helped me know what the “better” was and that no matter what, God is right there on our sides. Once I got to college, I truly had to practice my faith on my own as I did not have my parents/family there. This helped me be able to grow a relationship with God for myself and truly know God for myself. Since having that time, both my personal and spiritual journeys have grown as I am able to feed my soul with the word of God, and then teach the word of God to the youth.

- Looking back, what would you tell your younger self when you were sitting in the pews as a student?

I was always one that stressed on what the future would look like, how I would get there and what resources would look like. What I would tell myself is to take a deep breath, do your best and let God handle the rest. When I was in those times as a youth, I always wanted to get a glimpse of how “grown Charleigh” was set. “Grown Charleigh” had to learn to trust in God’s timing and know that his plans for me were way better than any plan that I had for myself. No need to worry about what is to come, God has it all in the power of his hands.

- What advice do you have for the youth at Antioch who may be thinking about college or unsure about their future?

Listen, it is important to remember this verse when you get in those unsure times, “For I know the plans I have for you” says the Lord. “They are plans for good and not disaster, to give you a future and hope” (Jeremiah 29:11). We do not know what the Lord has in store for us, but we just need to trust that he has it all in his hands. Although it may be easier said than done, do not stress nor worry about what is to come. God has kept you this far, he will not forsake you now. We all have plans, but the Lord’s plan will prevail. Just enjoy the time and pray through this season. God will direct you and guide you along your path.

- Is there anything you’d like to say to the scholarship committee or the Antioch family as a whole?

All I can say is Thank you, Thank you, THANK YOU.. to the amazing individuals on the scholarship committee and to my amazing Church family. You do not understand the impact that you have on our lives and how grateful we are to be a part of this great church. You are making dreams come true for high school seniors and allowing them to be able to continue their education, without the financial burden. I pray that God continues to bless each and every one of you as you continue to do great things in the life of the youth.
