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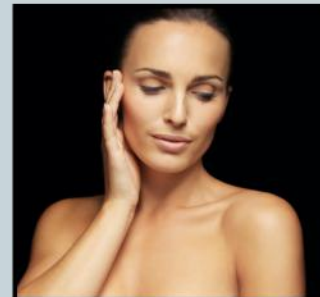
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BURIED ALIVE

BUT GOD RESCUED ME FROM ABOVE

Several years ago, I was invited to travel on a mission to Africa to speak to a gathering of nearly 40,000 people. It was meant to be a powerful time of sharing the message of the Kingdom of God. But what began as a mission of hope quickly turned into one of the most life-threatening moments of my life.

Unknown to me, war had broken out in the region shortly before my arrival. Rebel forces—deeply influenced by witchcraft and violent spiritual oppression—had taken control of the city. Villages were burning, thousands were fleeing as refugees, and many lives had already been lost.

When I entered the city, I had no idea how dangerous the situation had become.

Not long after arriving, I was captured by a group of these rebels. They stripped me of all my belongings, threw me into a small metal cage, and began speaking about killing me. Fear gripped my heart as I realized they were not just threatening my life—they were preparing to bury me alive.

One man began digging a grave while I sat helpless in the cage.

In that moment, there was nothing I could do in the natural. Surrounded by violent men and facing certain death, I turned to the only place where true help comes from. I began to pray.

With all my heart I cried out to the Lord, asking Him to deliver me from these evil men. I didn't know how He could do it. I couldn't see a way of escape. But I prayed that God would bring confusion among them and stop them from carrying out their plan.

About twenty minutes later, something extraordinary happened.

Suddenly, the men who had captured me began arguing with one another. The tension escalated quickly into chaos. In a moment of supernatural confusion, they turned against each other and began fighting violently among themselves.

The very people who had planned my death were now attacking one another.

In the middle of the chaos, one of the men ran to the cage, opened it, and shouted at me, "Get out of here! Run!"

I didn't hesitate. I ran for my life.

What the enemy meant for my destruction, God turned for my deliverance. In a moment when death seemed certain, the Lord intervened and set me free.



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HOUSE —OF— DAVID

LEADERSHIP, CALLING, AND THE MAKING OF A KING

The new series House of David on Amazon Prime Video and WONDER Project brings one of the most compelling figures in history to the screen: David, the shepherd who became king. His story is not just a biblical account or historical narrative—it is a leadership story, a story of calling, courage, failure, repentance, and legacy. The series explores the rise of David from obscurity to kingship, and in doing so, it highlights timeless lessons about leadership, character, and what truly makes a man great.

David's story begins not in a palace but in a field. He was a shepherd, the youngest son, overlooked even by his own family when the prophet Samuel came to anoint the next king of Israel. This detail alone tells us something important about leadership: God often chooses leaders that the world overlooks. David was not the obvious choice. He was not the oldest, not the strongest-looking, and not the most experienced. But he had something far more important—heart, faith, and courage.

One of the most defining moments in David's early life was his confrontation with Goliath. While trained soldiers stood in fear, David stepped forward with nothing but a sling and faith in God. This moment is often told as a story about courage, but it is also a story about leadership. Leaders step forward when others step back. Leaders take responsibility when others make excuses. Leaders act on conviction, not on fear.

The series House of David does a good job showing that David was not fearless because he was strong; he was fearless because he believed God was with him. This is a major leadership principle: confidence rooted in faith is stronger than confidence rooted in ability alone. David did not see Goliath as unbeatable because he did not measure the giant against himself; he measured the giant against God.

As David's life progresses, we see that leadership is not just about victory in battle but about character over time. David had multiple opportunities to kill King Saul, who was trying to kill him. Yet David refused. He would not take the throne by force, manipulation, or revenge. He waited. This shows one of David's greatest attributes as a leader: restraint and respect for authority. He understood that if God wanted him to be king, God would make it happen in the right time.

Many people want authority, but they do not want the process that prepares them for authority. David spent years running, hiding, leading a small group of misfits and outcasts before he ever became king. That period was not wasted time—it was leadership training. He learned how to lead men, how to survive hardship, how to trust God when nothing made sense, and how to make decisions under pressure.

This is another leadership lesson from David's life: the wilderness often comes before the throne. Hard seasons often prepare people for greater responsibility later.

When David finally became king, he united the tribes of Israel, established Jerusalem as the capital, and brought stability to the nation. He was a warrior, a strategist, a poet, and a worshiper. Very few leaders in history combined military strength with spiritual devotion the way David did. He wrote many of the Psalms, which show a man who was not afraid to express fear, doubt, joy, repentance, and worship. This is important because it shows that strong leaders are not emotionless; they are honest, humble, and willing to seek God.

However, David's story is not perfect, and that is one of the reasons it is so powerful. David committed serious sins, most notably his sin involving Bathsheba and the death of her husband Uriah. This part of David's story is critical because it shows that even great leaders can fall. But what separated David from many other leaders was not perfection—it was repentance. When confronted with his sin, David did not make excuses, blame others, or justify his actions. He repented and humbled himself before God.

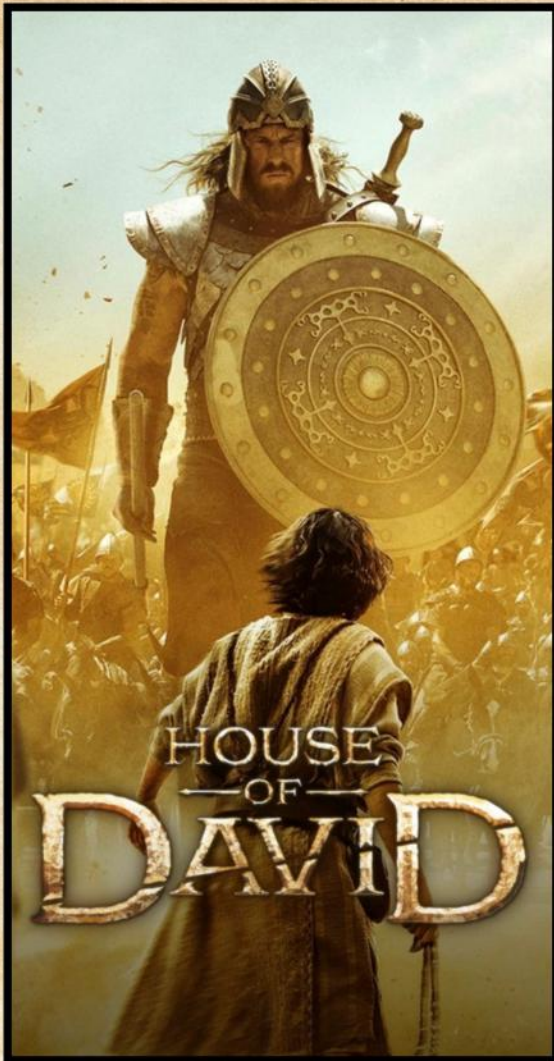


This may be one of the greatest leadership lessons from David's life: it is not the absence of failure that makes a great leader, but how a leader responds to failure. Pride destroys leaders, but humility restores them. David remained known as "a man after God's own heart" not because he was perfect, but because he continually returned to God with humility.

The series *House of David* portrays the complexity of David well—the warrior and the poet, the king and the shepherd, the leader and the flawed man. That complexity is what makes David one of the most relatable and studied leaders in history. He was brave but emotional, powerful but humble, successful but flawed, chosen but tested.

David's leadership can be summarized through several key attributes: courage, faith, patience, humility, repentance, and devotion to God. He protected his people, led in battle, unified a nation, wrote songs of worship, and left a legacy that would last generations. In fact, the Bible later refers to Jesus Christ as the "Son of David," showing how significant David's legacy became.

Leadership today often focuses on power, influence, money, and status, but David's life shows a different model of leadership.

True leadership is about responsibility, courage, character, and obedience to God. David did not become great when he became king; he was already becoming great when he was a shepherd, when no one was watching. That may be the biggest lesson from both David's life and the House of David series: leadership begins long before the title, the position, or the recognition. Leadership begins in private—through character, faithfulness, courage, and obedience. David was a shepherd before he was a king, a servant before he was a leader, and a worshiper before he wore a crown. And perhaps that is why he became one of the greatest kings in history—not because he sought power, but because he sought God. The story of David is ultimately a story about calling, preparation, failure, redemption, and legacy. It is the story of a boy who killed a giant, a man who led a nation, a sinner who repented, and a king who left a legacy that would change history.

-Luke 15:4

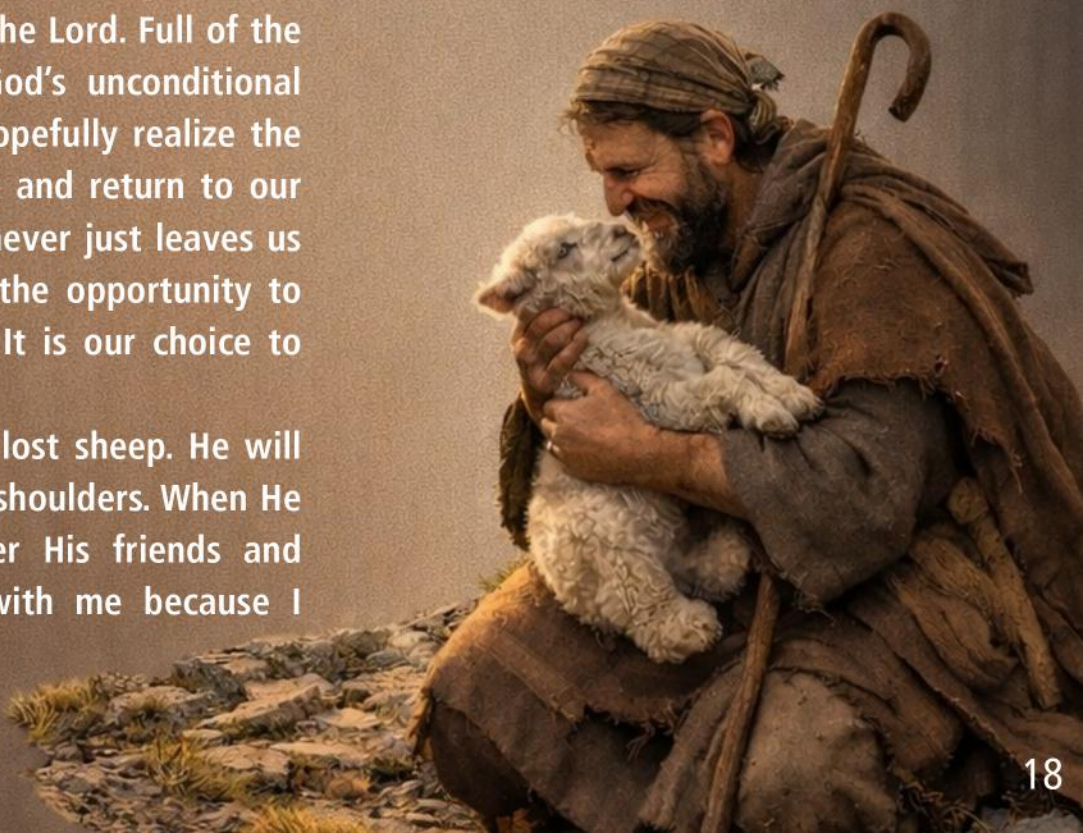

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SHOULDERS DON'T BECOME CASUAL WHEN CARRYING SACRED THINGS

David built a new cart.

It was a good cart. Solid wood. Strong wheels. The kind of thing that made sense. He had to move the Ark of God, and the Philistines had used a cart; it worked for them. So David borrowed their method.

It seemed wise. Efficient. Modern.

And a man died because of it.

Uzzah reached out to steady the Ark when the oxen stumbled. His hand touched what only priests were meant to carry. God struck him dead. Not because Uzzah was wicked. Because he was casual. He had gotten familiar with a holy thing. He forgot the weight of what he was touching.

I have been Uzzah.

Not with the Ark. With my family. With my marriage. With the things God put in my hands and told me to carry.

I used the world's methods. I outsourced my presence. I hustled when God said be still. I built systems when God said be faithful. I put my wife on a cart — managed her instead of pursued her. I put my children on a cart — programmed them instead of disciplined them. I put my walk with God on a cart — consumed content instead of carried the cross.



The cart looks impressive. It rolls smooth.

But it is not God's way.

God told the Levites to carry the Ark on their shoulders. Not on wheels. Not pulled by animals. On human shoulders. Bone and muscle and sweat. It was slower. It was heavier. It hurt.

It was worship.

David learned this. After Uzzah. After the grief. After the fear. He gathered the Levites. They sanctified themselves. They put the staves on their shoulders. And they carried the presence of God into Jerusalem the right way.

David danced before the Lord with all his might. His wife despised him for it. He did not care. He had learned what mattered.

A mighty man of God is not the man with the smoothest cart. He is the man with the heaviest shoulders. He carries his marriage. He carries his children. He carries the weight of leading a family through a world that wants to sell him a shortcut.

The holiest things are the heaviest things. Your wife is holy ground. Your children are holy ground. Your walk with God is holy ground.

Do not get casual with holy ground.

Do not build a cart for what God told you to carry.

Put it on your shoulders. It will be slow. It will be heavy. It will cost you something.

That is the point.

The House of David was not built on convenience. It was built on obedience. One heavy, faithful step at a time.

Pick up the weight. Walk with God.

The *hard* way is the only way home.



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A LIFE CUT SHORT AT 18 BUT A **WAKE UP CALL** for **THOUSANDS**

In a split second, your whole life can change. April 6, 2012—Good Friday—is a day I will never forget. I woke up that morning with a heaviness I couldn't explain. Something was wrong. I didn't know what, but deep down I knew. Shortly after, his mother told me there had been a serious accident on Highway 428. No one knew who it was yet. I couldn't sit still. I grabbed my keys and began driving toward the unknown, praying the entire way:

"God... not him. Not the one who tells everyone about You."

Ryan was eighteen years old, but he had the heart and wisdom of an old soul. Just days before, he had told me—and some of his friends—that he didn't think he would have children, that his time here might be short. Yet he radiated joy, faith, and light everywhere he went. The night before the accident, he told his mom something that stuck with all of us. Holding his phone, he said, "Mom, I feel like this phone... it's going to open up evil like never before. Bullying won't be one-on-one anymore—it will be a thousand-on-one." He had a way of seeing things deeply, beyond his years.

None of us are promised tomorrow.

Ryan had fallen asleep behind the wheel. His truck crossed the line and collided head-on with a tractor. When I arrived at the scene, the smoke, heat, and smell of metal and fuel hit me before I even saw the wreckage. Twisted steel, shattered glass, and flames surrounded the road. My hands trembled, and my heart felt like it would burst out of my chest.

Grief strips the world down to bare truth. In those moments, all the questions come: Why him? Why now? Could anything have been different? And yet, in the middle of that pain, I realized something eternal—life is not measured by how long we live, but by the character we leave behind.

Ryan's eighteen years were brief, but what he carried was eternal. His joy, kindness, and faith reached everyone he met. He once said, "I'm on top of the world when there is nobody in the world left to love." He also told me, "To create does not always mean to build, but to chip away from ourselves." He understood that life isn't about accumulation—it's about peeling back selfishness, fear, and pride until all that remains is love.

Months before the accident, Ryan and I were driving along Highway 45 to meet a client. Traffic suddenly came to a standstill. I told him it was probably more than construction—possibly a fatal accident—and that we should pray. We got out of the truck to stretch and started talking with other drivers. A man came back from up ahead and told us two young people had been killed when a car crossed the median and was hit by an 18-wheeler.

We walked back to the truck in silence. As traffic started moving and we passed the wreckage, the weight of it stayed with us. A few minutes later, I asked, “Son, are you okay?” He hesitated and then said something I will never forget: “Dad... I feel like that’s going to happen to me.” I was stunned and asked why he would say that. He said, “I don’t know... I just have that feeling.” At the time, I didn’t understand. But God did.

Later that winter, around Christmas, I heard something in my spirit as clearly as I’ve ever heard anything: “Go tell Ryan that I am going to use his life to save thousands.” I paused and prayed,

“Lord, if this is You, let it touch his heart.” I walked into his room, put my hand on his shoulder, and said, “Son, I don’t know when or how, but the Lord just told me He is going to use your life to save thousands.” Tears filled his eyes, and he said, “Dad... thank you. I needed that.”

After Ryan passed, those words haunted me. I couldn’t see how they could possibly be true. Grief, fear, and doubt had me trapped. One day in the backyard, the pain became too much. I fell to the ground, pounding my fists on the pavement, telling his mother I had lied to Ryan—that God would never use his life to save thousands. She lifted my face, looked me in the eyes, and said something I will never forget: “Dad... he already has those words.” In that moment, something inside me released. God’s promise had not died with Ryan.

At Ryan’s funeral, over 1,300 people came. The church was packed. When the invitation was given for salvation, no one moved at first. Then Ryan’s mother leaned her head back toward heaven and said, “Jesus, for the sacrifice of my son, please have one soul come forward.” I prayed the same prayer. Then one man walked forward.

Then another. Then another.

By the end, 63 people had given their lives to Christ that day.

In the middle of grief, something was being born—a message, a mission, a ministry. One day while mowing the yard with my son Cooper, I was overwhelmed with grief and struggling to hold myself together. As I wrestled with everything inside me, one word came to my mind: Character. At that same moment, Cooper ran over and hugged me when he saw I was struggling. I looked at him and said, “Son, if I die today, remember this: a man is measured by his character.” The moment those words left my mouth, I knew they carried weight. That was the birth of Measured By Character.

Today, Measured By Character is reaching into public schools, sharing Ryan’s story and the message that life is not measured by popularity, money, or success—but by character, faith, and how we treat others. Through school assemblies, church events, and student gatherings, this ministry has now reached students in more than 140 public schools, and many students have given their lives to Christ after hearing Ryan’s story. What started from tragedy has turned into a movement of hope, faith, and purpose for the next generation.

Ryan’s life was only eighteen years long, but his impact continues to grow every year. God kept His promise. Ryan’s life is still helping save thousands—not because of how long he lived, but because of how he lived.

His story reminds us all of something important: we don’t know how much time we have, but we do know this—every day we are building a legacy. And in the end, we will not be measured by our possessions, our titles, or our achievements.

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Delivered from Darkness

"I DRANK HIS BLOOD!"

Why? Why would I drink someone's blood? Shame covered me. How have I gotten here?

I was only three years old when the sexual abuse began. At night I would look up at the ceiling and whisper, "God, are you there? Can you help me?" I didn't know why, but I believed someone heard my cries.

Growing up, I desperately wanted acceptance. I wondered if they knew the shame I carried from the abuse. I often felt like the odd one in my family.

In middle school I decided to date Max, a very popular guy. When I broke up with him, all the cool kids kicked me out of their group. Everyone was talking bad about me. My hopes of love and acceptance were gone. I now truly believed I was worthless.

Months passed and I had a party at my house. Some of my friends invited a girl who was a witch. She pulled Tarot cards out and began doing readings on me. She asked if I wanted to go deeper. She told me to get a Bible. She put the Bible together with her satanic book while she spoke a spell. To my shock, the books began moving on their own.

After that night, something dark stayed with me. Soon I was drawn into even darker things. I now felt like wearing all black and became Goth. I met a new friend and went to a party at his house. A long table was in the back.

They wanted someone to dedicate themselves to a spirit. Without hesitation I volunteered and they performed a seance on me. I felt fear enter me. What have I done?

After months of drugs and partying, I went to my friend Stephanie's house. She asked if I wanted to become a white witch. After convincing me, she said I had to take a blood oath.

We cut ourselves and drank each other's blood as we read the spell book.

The room felt heavy and dark.

The following week we went downtown. I saw a stranger and looked him in the eyes. "Can I drink your blood?" I asked. He said yes without a care in the world. After I drank his blood, shame overwhelmed me. I was exhausted from drugs, alcohol, fear, and witchcraft. I wanted out but didn't know how. One friend convinced me to try drugs again. "This one will be different," she said.

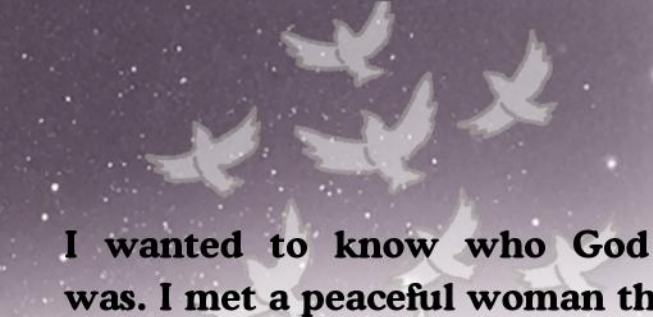
It was worse.

After I took the drug, hours passed and I was still high. After 72 hours of still being high, panic consumed me. Desperate, I rode my skateboard downtown and sat on a sidewalk.

Looking up, I prayed again. "God, if you're real, please help me." Suddenly I remembered where an Alcoholics Anonymous meeting was held. I walked inside. That night my sobriety journey began.

Though better, I was still searching for the truth. My dad was Muslim and my brother was Buddhist.





I wanted to know who God really was. I met a peaceful woman that told me Jesus was the true God and could set me free from all my fear.

For weeks I wrestled with that idea. Then one day I decided to give my life to Jesus. I prayed in a parking lot. I confessed Jesus was the son of God and died on the cross and rose again. I prayed for Jesus to forgive me. In that moment I felt the peace I had been searching for my entire life. I left everything behind and started a new life.

Years passed and my sister told me my brother was struggling. During a phone call I shared my faith with him. My Buddhist brother gave his life to Jesus. I was so happy.

Soon after, I felt God prompting me to talk with my Muslim dad. After years of prayer I asked him, "Dad, would you like to accept Jesus?"

Without hesitation he said yes. My heart pounded as I led him in prayer. Then he told me, "I am so proud of you, Annetta." Tears of gratitude filled my eyes. Months later my sister called to say my dad was very sick. I flew to Texas to see him, and within days he passed away. Though grief filled my heart, I had peace knowing he was with Jesus.

At his funeral I knew God told me to share. With my heart pounding, I stepped up to the microphone and said, "I led my dad to Jesus." As I looked across the room, tears filled my eyes. I knew God had used that moment to share the gospel with everyone there.

Even after feeling close to Jesus, I would have dark, evil thoughts and desires. I learned there were doors opened through witchcraft, abuse, and new age crystals.

I met with a couple who did deliverance on Christians. They casted demons out one after the other. For two and a half hours we prayed. Finally we finished. There was peace and joy in my soul. The noise inside my head finally stopped. I truly felt free.

If you are searching for freedom and peace, Jesus can ultimately set you free. There can be deliverance for you no matter how far you have gone. He did it for me and he can do it for you.

The girl who once searched for power in darkness finally found true peace in Jesus.



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STRONG MEN...MARRIAGE GOD'S WAY AND A SACRED COVENANT WORTH PROTECTING

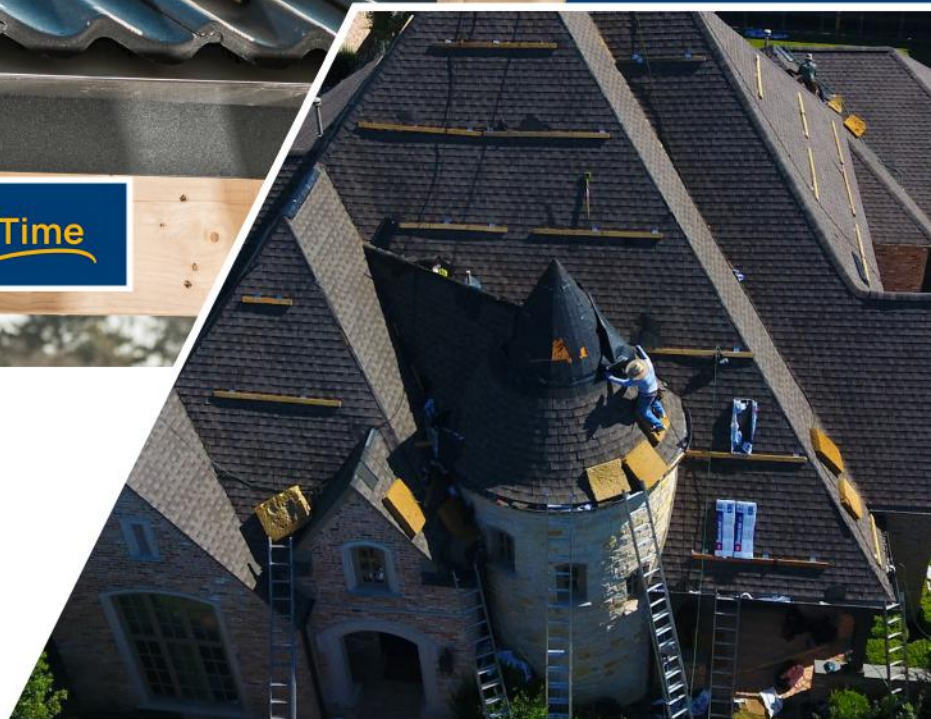




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A Man of Might

A man is more than an XY genetic code that carries seed to fertilize a new generation. He is more than a workhorse who brings home a paycheck. He is more than an errand runner in his own home. A man is a vessel—built, designed, and called to protect, provide, and stand for truth. He is meant to stand against evil, defend the vulnerable, and lead with courage when others hesitate.

If you watch young boys when they are very small, you will often see something interesting. A boy will tie a bedsheet around his neck like a cape, jump from the couch to the loveseat, and fight imaginary villains with fearless determination. He will defend the family dog from invisible enemies and rescue imaginary people in distress. This is not taught in a classroom. No one sits a four-year-old boy down and teaches him heroism. There is something inside him already—something hardwired into his identity. From early childhood, boys naturally gravitate toward protecting, building, fighting injustice, and standing up for others.

Defending the vulnerable and standing for justice are not learned behaviors alone; they are deeply connected to a man's sense of purpose and identity. The question is: where did this come from? Is it random? Is it cultural? Or was man designed this way intentionally?

The answer goes back to the very beginning.

On the sixth day of creation, God created man, and shortly after, He created woman. In the book of Genesis, we see that woman was created as a helpmate for man, and together they were to steward what God had created. Man and woman were designed with different gifts, different strengths, and different roles, but they were meant to work together as one unit—one flesh—facing the challenges of the world side by side. If men were designed to protect, lead, and provide, then why does modern culture often run completely opposite to this design? Why wouldn't women want to feel protected and secure? Why wouldn't men want to stand up for truth and justice? Why are so many men passive today compared to generations before them? Why are so many men confused about their roles in society and, more importantly, in marriage?

The answer is actually much simpler than most people want to admit.

There is an adversary that seeks to kill, steal, and destroy. The Bible calls him the enemy of our souls—the devil. The devil hates the order of God, and he especially hates the union of man and woman becoming one flesh. He hates strong families, strong marriages, and strong men who follow God. Because of this, he will use anything and anyone to disrupt what God designed. One of his most effective tools throughout history has been culture.

Worldly culture is often the opposite of God's design and God's Word. This has been true from ancient civilizations all the way to modern America. Culture constantly tries to redefine truth, redefine marriage, redefine manhood, and redefine family. But truth does not change just because culture changes.

The Bible teaches that we are called to live in the world but not be of the world. That means we live in society, we work jobs, we have friends, and we participate in everyday life, but we do not adopt every value, belief, and behavior that culture promotes. We can have a job but not be greedy. We can have money but not love money. We can have friends but not be influenced by their sin. We can live in society without allowing culture to become our authority over God's Word.

One example of cultural thinking that has affected marriages is the phrase, "Happy wife, happy life." While it may sound harmless, it often promotes a passive husband who avoids leadership and avoids difficult decisions just to keep peace in the home. But passivity is not leadership, and a passive husband leaves his family without direction and protection.

A passive husband is actually a dangerous husband—not because he is aggressive, but because he is absent in leadership. When a man refuses to lead, refuses to stand for truth, and refuses to protect his family spiritually and emotionally, he leaves a vacuum that something else will fill—usually culture, fear, or confusion.

A strong man does not lead with arrogance or control; he leads with conviction. There is a big difference between conviction and conformity. Conformity follows the crowd to avoid conflict. Conviction stands for truth even when it is uncomfortable.

The most important thing a strong man must do is cultivate a relationship with God. Before he can lead a family, he must first be led by the Lord. A godly husband places God at the top of his life, even above his wife, because only when God is first can everything else be in the right order.

A godly husband loves his wife sacrificially. He protects her, prays for her, prays with her, and stands between her and the pressures and attacks of the world. He seeks God's wisdom in prayer instead of relying only on his own understanding. He puts aside pride and walks in humility, because the Bible says that God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble.

Pride destroys men, marriages, and families. Humility builds them.

A strong man seeks God's Word before he seeks the opinions of the world. He stands with courage when it would be easier to stay silent. He chooses truth over popularity. He chooses responsibility over comfort. He chooses leadership over passivity.

The Bible also makes something very clear that can be difficult for many people to accept: a man must love God above everyone else—even above his wife, his parents, and his children. This does not mean he loves them less in a negative way, but it means God must be first in his life.

When God is first, he becomes a better husband, better father, and better man.

A mighty man is not created by culture. He is created by God. He is designed with purpose, responsibility, and leadership written into his identity. His role is to protect, provide, and lead, but most importantly, he is called to follow Jesus Christ and emulate His life as the ultimate example of manhood and leadership. A mighty man stands for truth and does not compromise.

A mighty man leads his family with courage and humility.

A mighty man protects what God has already given him.

A mighty man prays when others panic.

A mighty man speaks truth when others stay silent.

A mighty man does not need the world's approval because he already knows his calling.

He was built for responsibility.

He was built for leadership.

He was built for courage.

He was built for truth.

He was built to be a man of God.

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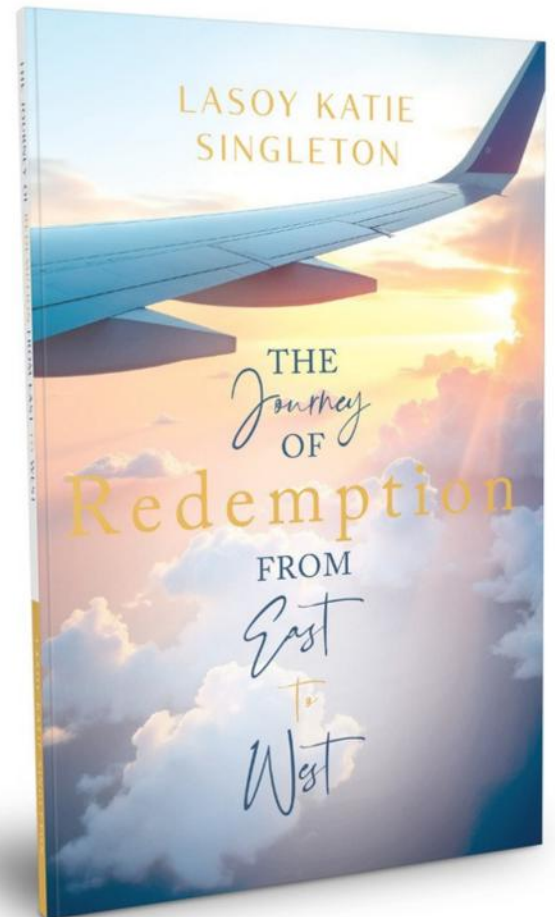
THE JOURNEY OF REDEMPTION FROM EAST TO WEST

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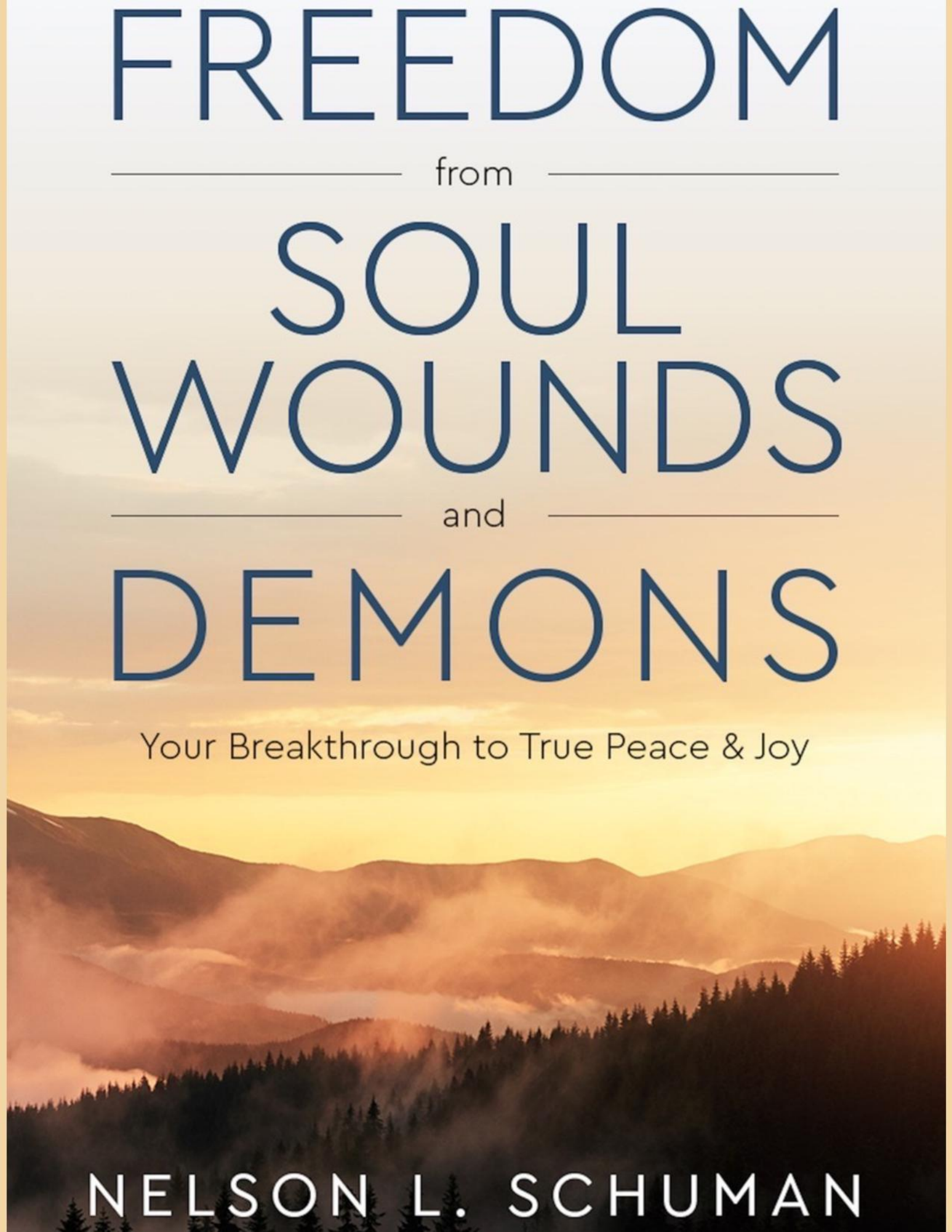


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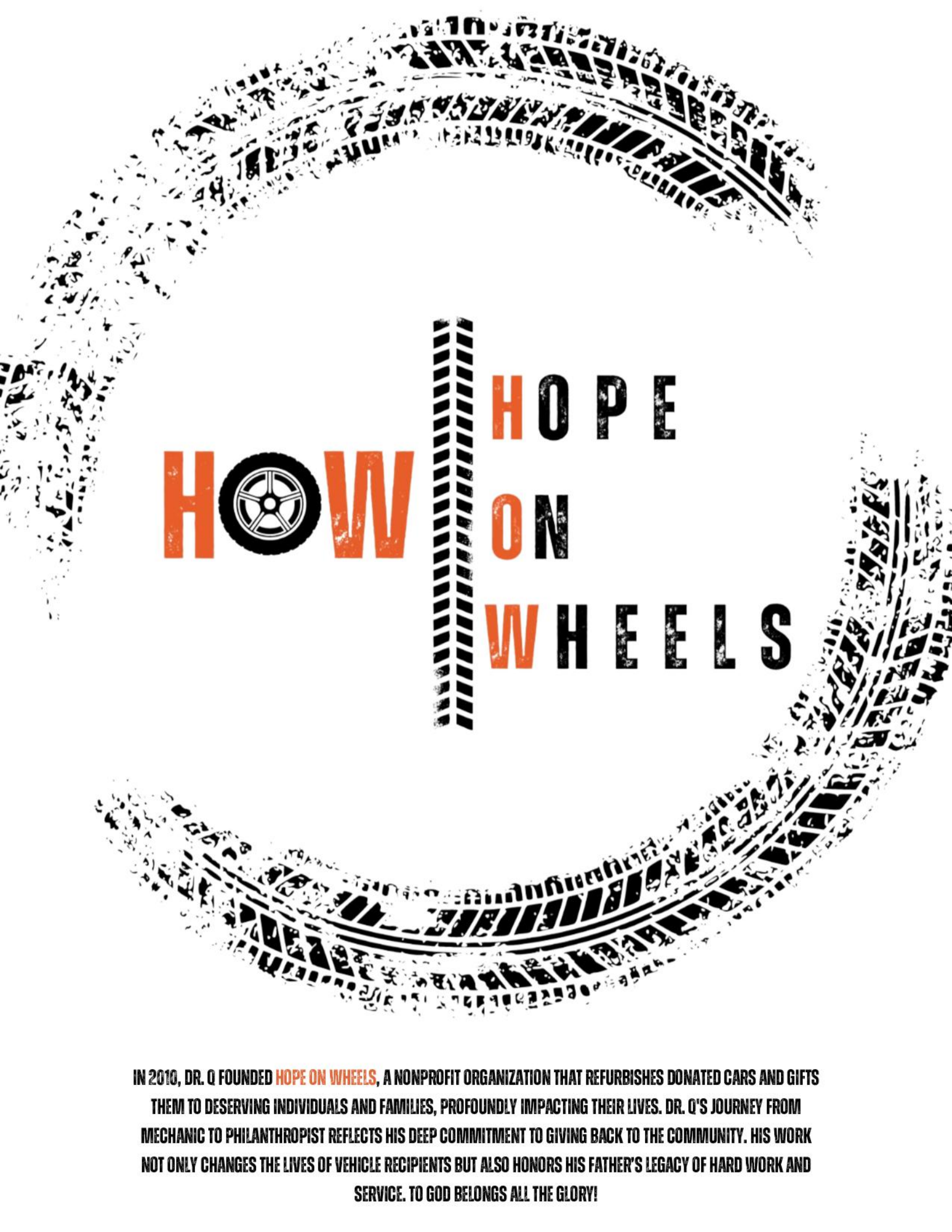

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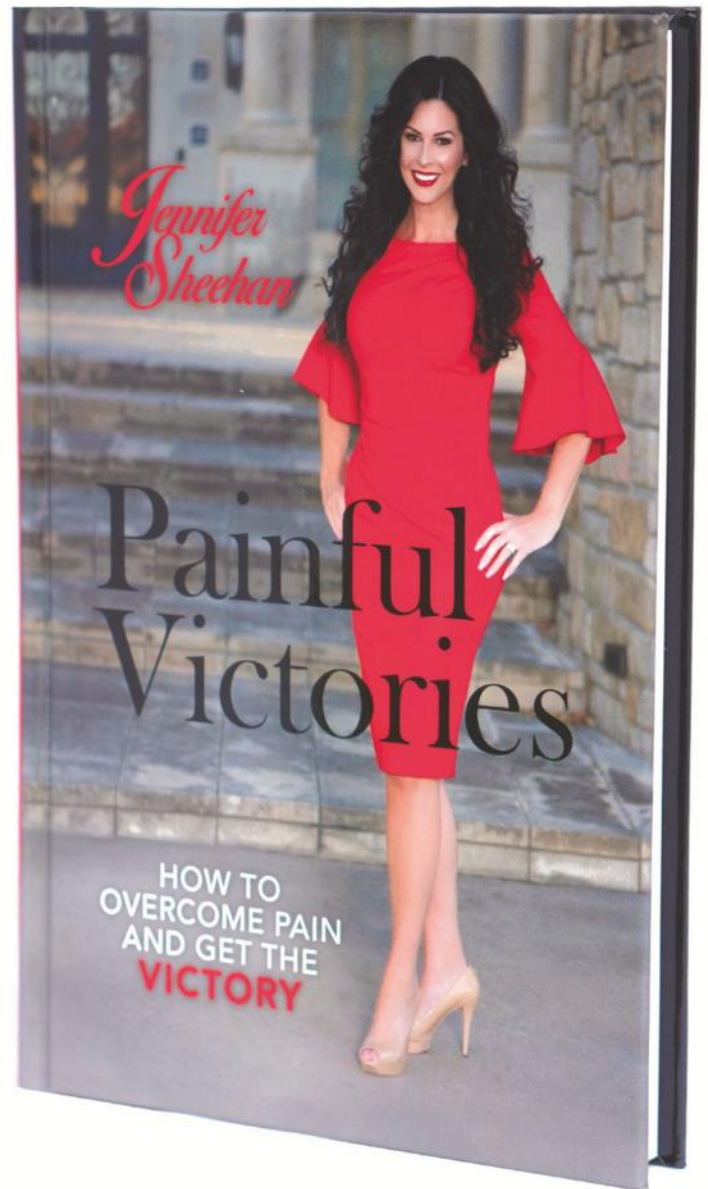
Painful Victories

It is shocking to most people looking at my life today and hearing where I came from. God took this abused, broken girl, and has lifted her up for His glory. We are all looking



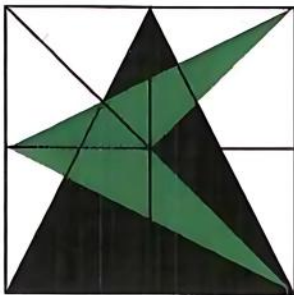

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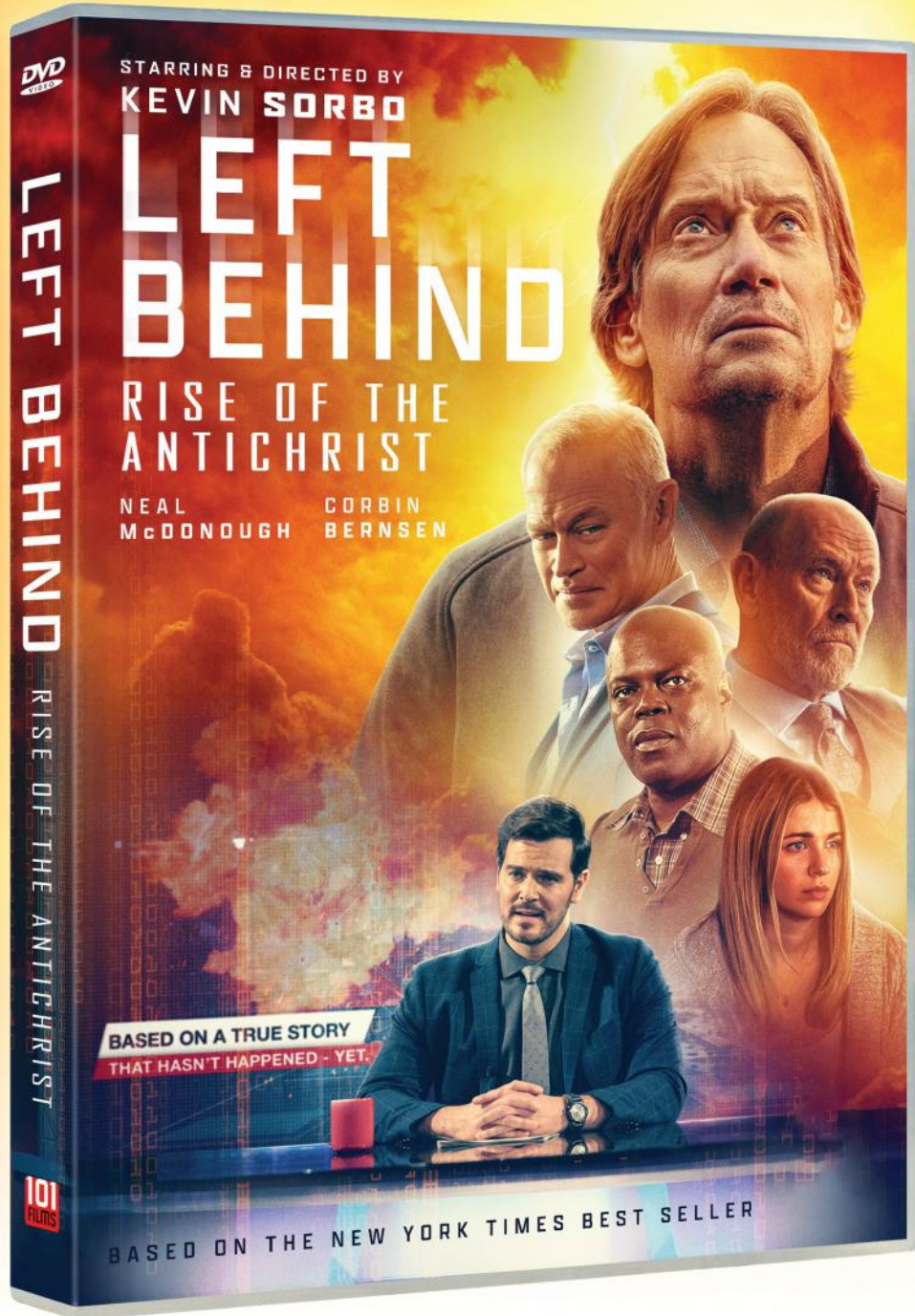
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
