ABOUT THE BOOK

It took only one doorbell ring to turn married couple Erez and Sigal's life upside down. Sigal did not expect Sylvie, the neighbor's caregiver, holding a baby. And she definitely did not expect to hear one little sentence: "This is Aya, Erez's baby."

While Erez swears it was just a one-night stand, Sigal cannot bear the ultimate betrayal and leaves him to handle the mess. Left on his own, Erez helps Sylvie raise Aya until one day, Sylvie disappears, leaving behind one request—that Aya know she is her mother.

When Sigal meets Aya by chance, she is instantly drawn to the sweet girl. Over time, the two develop a strong bond, and Sigal feels ready to reconcile with Erez and raise Aya as their daughter under one condition: Aya can never know who her real mother is. Afraid to lose Sigal again, Erez agrees to the "white lie" that will define their family.

Our Secret Daughter explores the universal themes of motherhood, identity, and the consequences of deception. Comparable to *The Light Between Oceans* (M.L. Stedman), *Little Fires Everywhere* (Celeste Ng), and *The Kite Runner* (Khaled Hosseini), this novel appeals to readers who appreciate morally complex characters, emotionally gripping family dynamics, and stories that ask difficult ethical questions.

THE STORY

Yet, as Sylvie desperately tries to reconnect with Aya from Ukraine, Erez knows their secret is not safe for long. He will do anything to save his marriage, but can he keep lying to his daughter? Or will he risk his marriage so that Aya learns the truth?

Our Secret Daughter is a gripping and emotional story about love, marriage and parenthood that speaks to the universal questions every parent faces: How far would you go to protect your family? What is the price of a lie told in the name of love? Can a family built on secrets survive when the truth comes out?

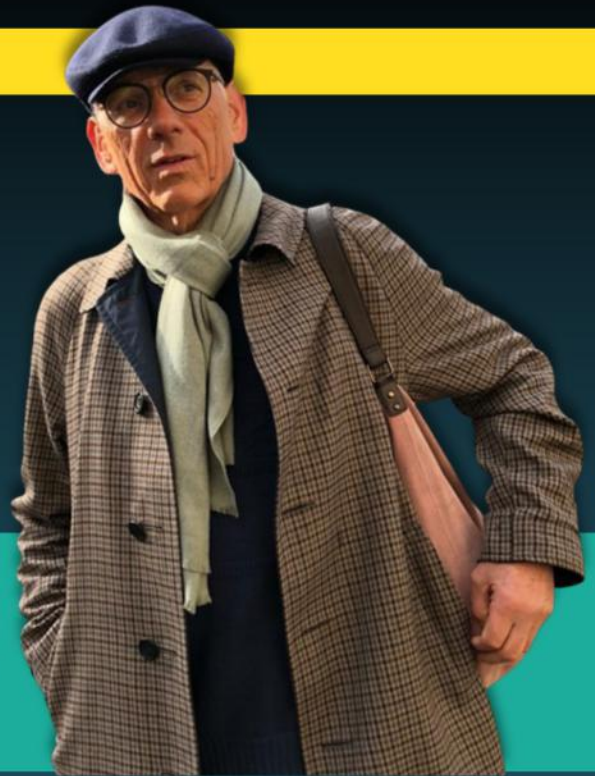
Through fifteen years of intimate family life in Tel Aviv and Herzliya, with moments of escape and reflection aboard the yacht Hera on the Mediterranean, the novel traces the fragile bonds that hold a family together—and explores the devastating consequences when truth can no longer be hidden. The story unfolds with increasing tension as Aya grows into adolescence, sensing the lack of alignment between her reality and her parents' story. From a near-suicidal act of desperation to a moment of impossible choice, Erez must finally decide whether honesty or protection matters most.
