We offer a wide range of career pathways, with courses designed to prepare you for your chosen industry.

A LEVELS AT MIDDLESBROUGH COLLEGE SIXTH FORM

A Levels are ideal if you enjoy academic study, want to explore subjects in greater depth and keep your future options open. They can lead to university, apprenticeships or employment.

You'll study three or four subjects over two years, with your final grade assessed by examinations.

Did you know? At Middlesbrough College Sixth Form you can combine different qualifications to build a programme that suits your strengths and future goals, including:

- ↳ **A Levels**
- ↳ **A Level equivalent subjects**
- ↳ **V Levels – NEW FOR 2027!**

T LEVEL QUALIFICATIONS

T Levels are ideal if you already know which industry you would like to build a career in, combining classroom learning with real industry experience.

Designed with employers, T Levels include a minimum 45-day industry placement, giving you the technical knowledge, practical skills and workplace experience needed for skilled employment, an apprenticeship or higher education.

Depending on your chosen pathway and GCSE grades, T Level pathways are studied over two or three years.

We also offer various study options and qualification types, so you can choose a learning style that matches your goals and interests.

OTHER VOCATIONAL AND TECHNICAL QUALIFICATIONS

Vocational and Technical Qualifications are ideal if you prefer a practical, career-focused approach to learning.

These qualifications combine classroom teaching with hands-on experience, helping you develop industry-specific knowledge and skills. Typically studied over two years, they're assessed through a mixture of assignments, projects, presentations and examinations, providing a clear route into employment, apprenticeships or further study.

APPRENTICESHIPS

Are you ready to start your career now? Apprenticeships are ideal if you know what career you want and are looking to earn while you learn.

You'll combine paid employment with training, gaining valuable workplace experience, industry skills and a nationally recognised qualification. Around 80% of your time is spent learning in the workplace with your employer, with the remaining 20% dedicated to off-the-job training that supports your qualification.



Understanding **YOUR OPTIONS**

Whether you're comparing T Levels to A Levels or simply want to understand more about career pathways, we've answered some of the most frequently asked questions to help you make an informed decision.

WHAT IS A PATHWAY?

A pathway is a group of courses that lead to similar careers or industries.

Whether you already have a career in mind or are still exploring your options, they help you find the right course for you.

WHAT ARE THE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR A PATHWAY?

Entry requirements can vary depending on the course you study within each pathway. When you apply, our team will discuss your predicted or achieved grades and recommend the most suitable programme and route to help you achieve your goals. You can also find entry requirements for individual courses on our website.

WHY ARE COURSES ORGANISED INTO PATHWAYS?

We know that many students have a career in mind but aren't always sure which qualification is right for them. Our pathways make it easier to explore your options, understand where each route can lead and choose the programme that's right for you.

Whether your goal is university, an apprenticeship or employment, every pathway offers a clear route to your next step.

HOW DO I KNOW WHICH PATHWAY IS RIGHT FOR ME?

Start by thinking about the type of career or industry you're interested in, rather than the qualification itself.

For example, if you're interested in becoming a nurse, paramedic or healthcare professional, our Nursing & Midwifery pathway could be the right choice. If you're passionate about fitness, coaching or sports science, our Sport pathway could be a better fit.

WHAT IS A V LEVEL?

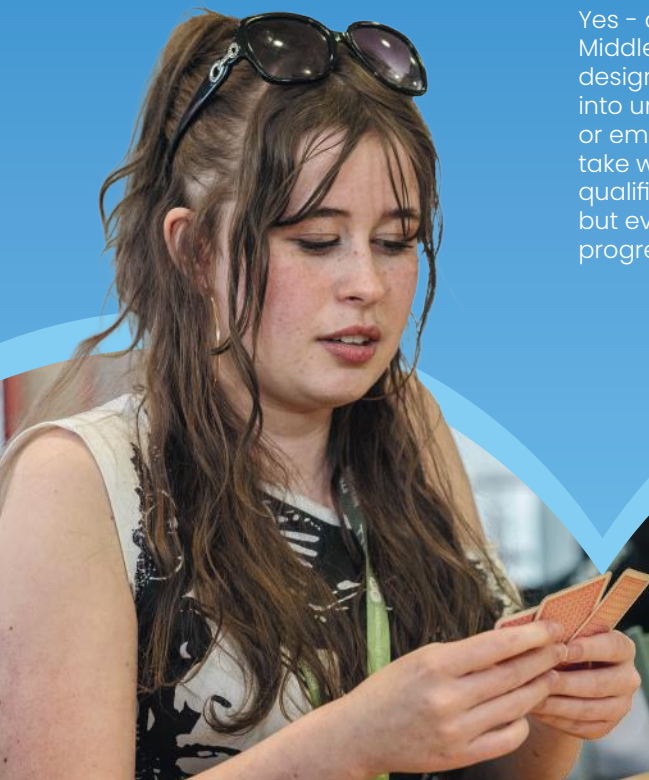
V Levels are brand new Level 3 qualifications being introduced from 2027. V Levels are equivalent to one A Level. They are studied over two years and combine practical learning with broader subject knowledge and transferable skills.

DO ALL PATHWAYS LEAD TO UNIVERSITY OR EMPLOYMENT?

Yes – all pathways at Middlesbrough College are designed to support progression into university, apprenticeships or employment. The route you take will depend on your chosen qualification and career goals, but every pathway offers clear progression opportunities.



WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN T LEVELS AND VOCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS?

T Levels are employer-designed qualifications that combine classroom learning with a minimum 45-day industry placement. Vocational and Technical Qualifications may include work experience, but this isn't a mandatory part of every programme.

WHAT IF I DON'T KNOW WHAT I WANT TO DO YET?

Don't worry – that's completely normal. Many students start college without knowing exactly where they want their future to take them.

Our experienced Careers Team will help you explore your interests, understand your options and choose a pathway that keeps your future opportunities open.

HOW LONG DOES A T LEVEL TAKE?

There are two ways to study a T Level at Middlesbrough College, depending on your pathway and your starting point when you join us.

2-Year T Level pathway

For students who are ready to begin their T Level programme straight away, with two years of specialist study and industry experience.

3-Year T Level pathway (Foundation Year + T Level)

Designed to provide a strong stepping stone, this pathway begins with a foundation year to build your skills, knowledge and confidence while achieving your Maths and English language qualifications (if required), before progressing onto your 2-year T Level programme.

Whichever route you take, you'll work towards the same goal – preparing for employment, apprenticeships or higher education.

Your core qualification is the study option you choose after your GCSEs (e.g. A Levels, or a Vocational Course, Apprenticeship or T Level).

2. MATHS & ENGLISH

Maths & English are two of the most important skill sets a person can have and are an essential foundation for every career. If you do not achieve Grade 4 for your Maths and English GCSEs, this will be added to your timetable to help you achieve them.

3. WORK EXPERIENCE

We work with leading employers across the North East to help you gain the skills, knowledge and experience employers are looking for. Depending on your course, you'll have the opportunity to gain valuable industry experience through work placements or work experience.

T Levels include a minimum 45-day industry placement, while many vocational courses also include 10-days work experience with local employers as part of your study programme.

4. THRIVE PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT

Personal Development sessions will be automatically scheduled into your timetable to help build your confidence, communication, and valuable life skills. These include team building, first aid, UCAS application support and more.

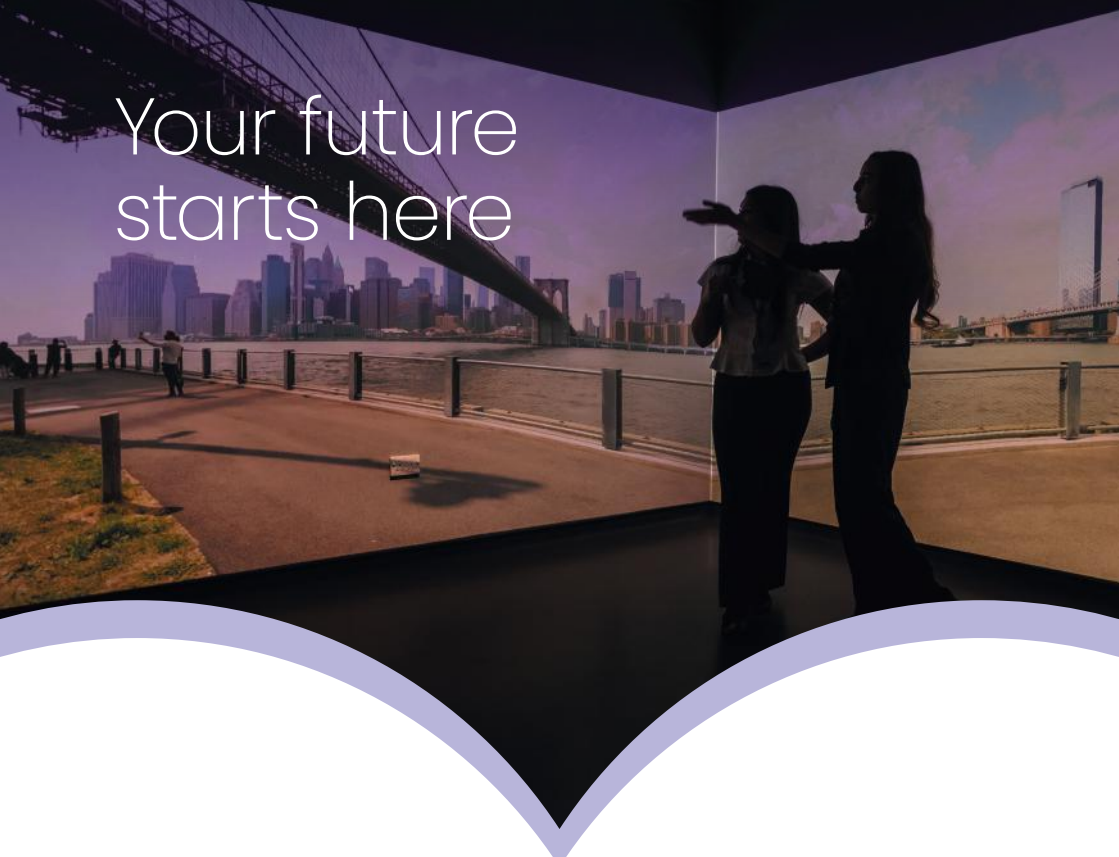

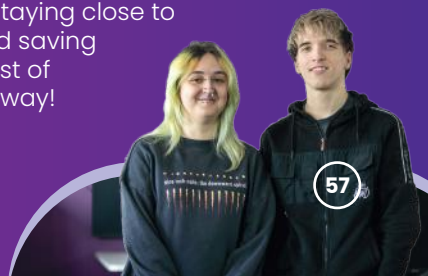

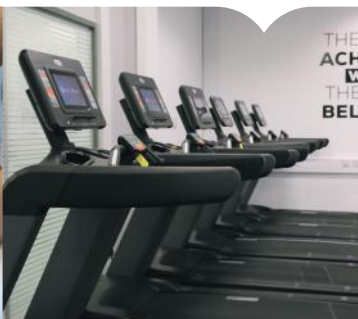
