# Community program

Thanks to your trust, we help associations and local leaders across the country make a difference in their communities.



We don't just give funding: we guide our program participants through the entire process. We connect them with peers, offer them learning opportunities and help them develop their skills so they can turn their visions into reality and build stronger communities.

In 2025, we supported 163 community projects with total funding of CZK 7.2 million (\$341,026).

# Young Philanthropists

Young people can achieve great things. We support children and students who are making a difference in their communities by organizing charity events, improving public spaces and acting as environmental stewards.



Thanks to your support, we are also able to support school teachers. We offer them workshops focused on inspiring children and students to develop a passion for philanthropy

# Let's light up the Czech Republic

This brilliant fundraising drive helps those in need. Via helps make it happen.



This holiday campaign raises money to help people in need in various parts of the country, spreading hope across the Czech Republic. When a donor sends a gift, they can click on a virtual map to “light up” a place on the map. The proceeds go to 15 organizations that help people with severe illnesses, senior citizens, victims of violence and hospices.

In 2025, thousands of people and hundreds of companies gave more than CZK 17 million (\$750,000) and virtually created more than 60,000 points of light across the country.

# Kaufland Fund

Our partnership with the Kaufland company helps build stronger communities in the towns and cities where Kaufland operates.



Through two programs - **A Million For...** and **It's Growing, It's Sprouting** - residents can obtain support to turn their visions for community gathering places, neighborhood events and community gardens into reality.

In 2025, we awarded a total of CZK 2.9 million (\$137,400) for 50 community gardens and 34 neighborhood projects through the Kaufland Fund.

# We Can Do More and Stronger Changemakers

Through our partnership with Česká spořitelna bank and the Česká spořitelna Foundation, we are developing the potential of changemakers across the Czech Republic.



The **We Can Do More** program offers grants and non-financial support to residents who are leading community initiatives that bring people together and improve their towns and villages. Through the **Stronger Changemakers** program, we provide learning opportunities for people who have a long history of working indefatigably to strengthen community life. In 2025, we awarded nearly CZK 5.8 million (\$274,716) to support 80 projects and changemakers.

# Darujme.cz

Nearly half a billion crowns for good causes: in 2025, Darujme.cz once again shifted the limits of online giving in the Czech Republic, facilitating delivery of gifts totaling CZK 481 million (\$22 million).

Darujme.cz secures this entire process safely and smoothly. We also provide long-term support to organizations through free training focused on donor stewardship, data management and digital tools.



## Petra Calls 155:

This fundraising campaign was launched by Petra Vrbová, an emergency medical services doctor, after she was diagnosed with pancreatic cancer. The campaign raised over CZK 1 million (\$47,235) to support home hospices and raise awareness about palliative care.

# Corporate philanthropy

We partner with companies that want to give thoughtfully.

Through Darujme.cz, we offer a transparent giving model that meets the strictest standards for auditing and Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) reporting but most importantly, gives meaning to corporate philanthropy.

We also offer an app that makes corporate philanthropy easier to manage. A company's employees use the app to nominate projects and vote on which initiatives receive the company's charitable support. Last year, for example, Eurowag used the app to distribute over CZK 4.8 million (\$2.2 million) to selected organizations.

# Philanthropy in schools

Thanks to the support of our donors, we introduce the topic of charitable giving in schools and engage systematically with children and young people around philanthropy.



In 2025, thanks to our collaboration with the organization Můžeš podnikat (“You can start a business”), we reached over 9,000 high school students throughout the Czech Republic.

We are also present on university campuses. At Palacký University in Olomouc, Tomáš Baťa University in Zlín and the University of Economics in Prague, over 100 students have participated in our seminars and lectures.

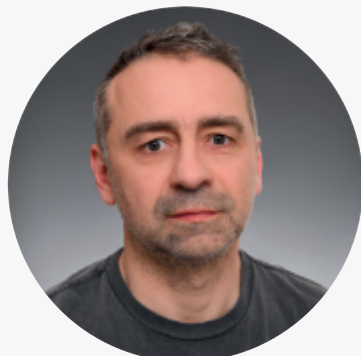

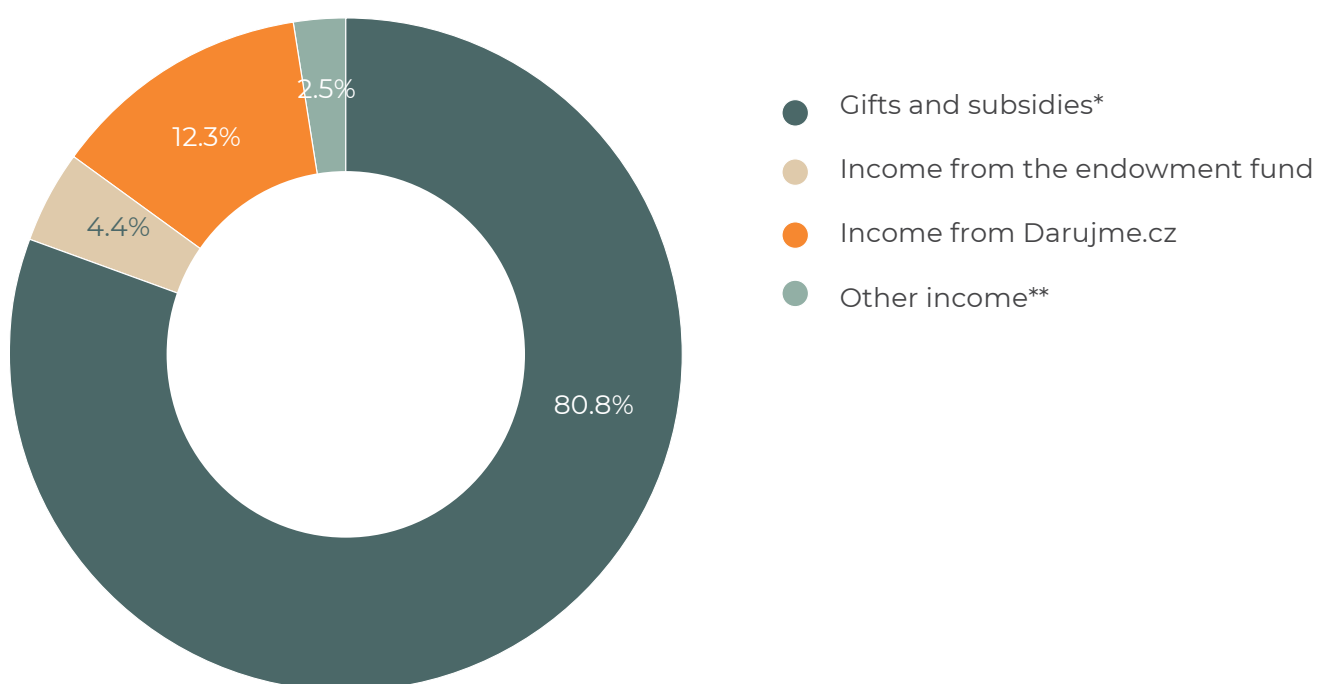

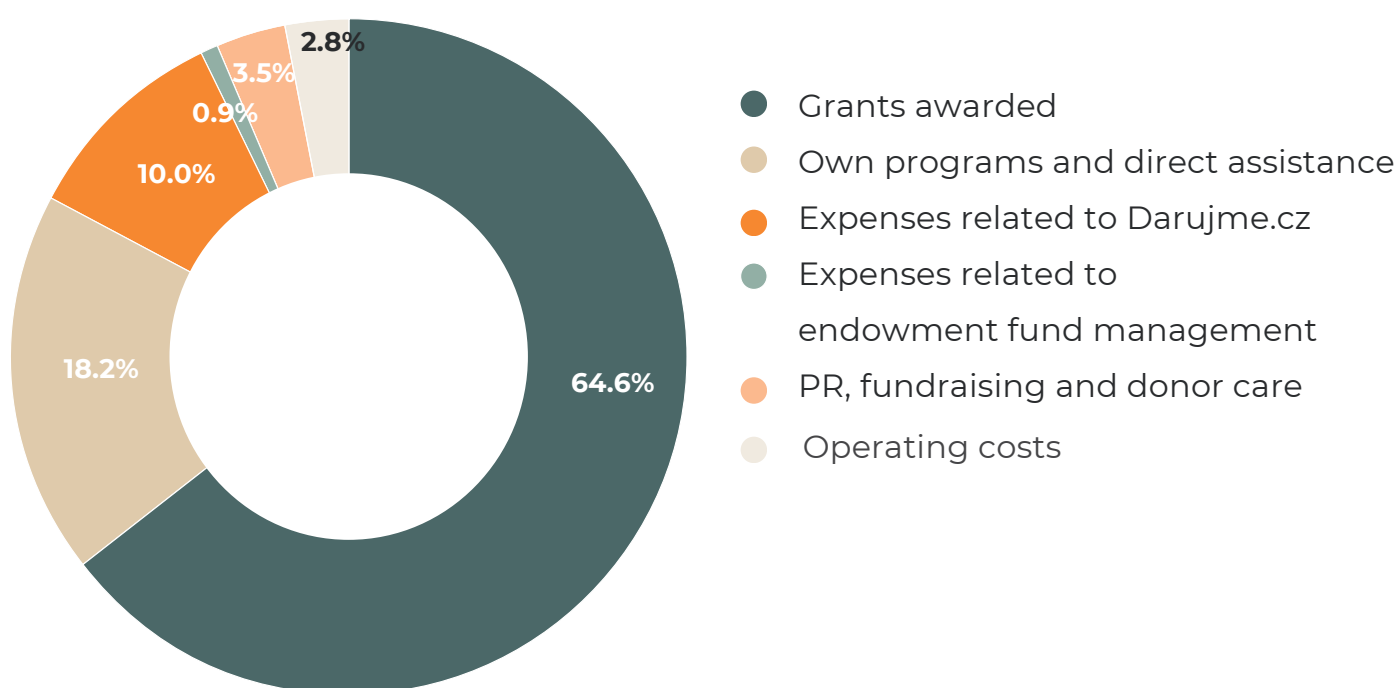
