A 13-day cruise and land journey from Toronto through Bergen, Norway's inner fjords and Oslo. Sail aboard MS Trollfjord for seven nights, then continue by rail, coach and fjord cruise on the classic Norway in a Nutshell route.

Please note: Scenic sailing, excursions and sightseeing order may be adjusted due to weather, sea conditions and operational considerations.

DAY 1

Journey Begins

Begin your Norway adventure as you depart Toronto on your overnight flight to Europe, connecting onward to Bergen. Settle in and look ahead to Norway's dramatic fjords, coastal cities and rich maritime heritage.



DAY 2

Welcome to Bergen

Arrive in Bergen, the gateway to Norway's fjords. Meet your local representative and transfer to your hotel, then take time to settle in after your overnight journey. This evening, gather with your fellow travelers for a welcome dinner as your Norway adventure begins.

DAY 3

Bergen

Gateway to The Fjords

Begin the day with a guided tour of Bergen, known as the Gateway to the Fjords. Ride the Fløibanen Funicular to Mount Fløyen for sweeping views over the city, harbour and surrounding fjords, with time to enjoy the scenic viewpoints.

This afternoon, transfer to the pier and board MS Trollfjord. Meet your Expedition Team, settle into your cabin and enjoy your first dinner onboard as the ship departs Bergen, beginning your voyage through Norway's majestic fjords.

DAY 4

Kvinnheradsfjord

Rosendal & the Heart of Hardanger

Cruise into Kvinnheradsfjord, a scenic branch of the great Hardangerfjord. Surrounded by steep mountains, waterfalls and peaceful coastal landscapes, this beautiful fjord offers your first glimpse into Norway's inner fjords.

At its heart lies Rosendal, a charming village framed by orchards and glacier views. Spend time discovering Barony Rosendal, Norway's only manor house of its kind, or enjoy the village's gardens, galleries and mountain scenery.

DAY 5

Stavanger



Stavanger & the Fjord of Light

Sail through dramatic Lysefjord, where soaring cliffs rise more than 3,000 feet above the sea and iconic Preikestolen, or Pulpit Rock, towers over the fjord. Later, arrive in Stavanger, a lively coastal city blending Viking heritage with modern charm. Explore the picturesque Old Town, lined with white wooden houses, cafés, galleries and waterfront restaurants, or browse local shops for Norwegian crafts and traditional wool sweaters.

Included Shore Excursion

Walking Tour of Stavanger

Explore Stavanger's harbour, historic old town, colourful Øvre Holmegate and cathedral while discovering the city's culture and maritime heritage.



DAY 6

Hardangerfjord

Queen of the Fjords

Today's journey brings you into the magnificent Hardangerfjord, often called the Queen of the Fjords. Framed by glaciers, orchards, villages and snow-capped peaks, this beautiful waterway reveals some of Norway's most poetic landscapes.

At the fjord's innermost reach lies Eidfjord, a peaceful village surrounded by cliffs and tumbling rivers. Here, you may visit the Hardangervidda Nature Centre or join an excursion to the dramatic Vøringsfossen waterfall.

DAY 7

Sognefjord



Nearby stands the UNESCO-listed Urnes Stave Church, Norway's oldest stave church, where intricate wooden carvings blend Viking artistry with early Christian symbolism.



Deep into Norway's Heart

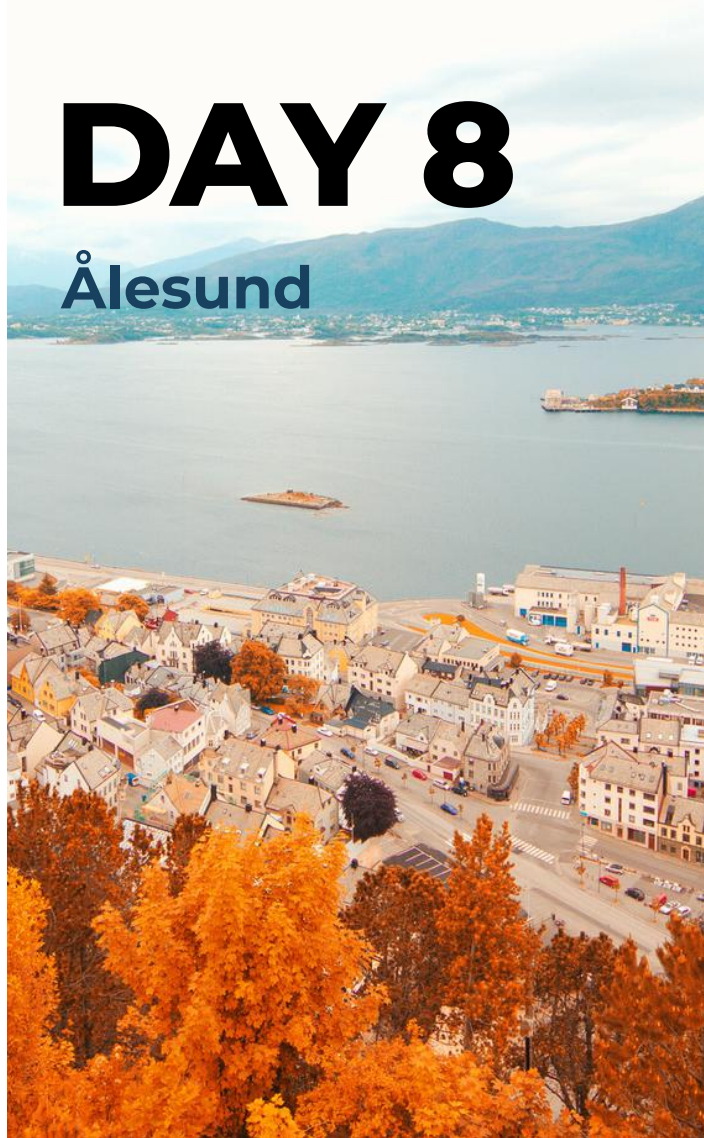
Journey into Sognefjord, the King of the Fjords, stretching deep into Norway's mountain landscapes. Towering cliffs, waterfalls and glacier-carved valleys surround Skjolden, creating one of the country's most dramatic natural settings.

From here, guests may explore Jostedalsglacier, mainland Europe's largest glacier, or follow scenic valley trails toward historic mountain farms and peaceful viewpoints.

DAY 8

Ålesund



Art Nouveau by the Sea

Arrive in Ålesund, a beautiful coastal city known for its elegant Art Nouveau architecture, pastel buildings and scenic waterfront setting.

Stroll along cobbled streets and cafés, explore the city's design heritage, or head to Mount Aksla for sweeping views over Ålesund and the Sunnmøre Alps.

Ålesund Panoramic Bus Tour

Discover Ålesund's Art Nouveau streets and harbour on a panoramic bus tour, including Mount Aksla's Fjellstua viewpoint for sweeping views of the town and Sunnmøre Alps.



DAY 9

Nordfjord



Included Shore Excursion

Jostedalsbreen Glacier

Discover Olden's glacier scenery on an excursion to Briksdal, an arm of Jostedalsbreen, with waterfalls, mountain views and access by scenic trail or troll car.

Glaciers, Valleys & Village Life

The approach to Nordfjord is among Norway's most scenic sailings, stretching inland from the open sea toward glacier-carved valleys and mirror-bright lakes. Along the sheltered shores, red boathouses, green pastures, forested slopes and silver waterfalls create a peaceful rhythm of village life beneath steep mountain peaks.

DINING: B, L, D

At the fjord's innermost reach lies Olden, a quiet village framed by the turquoise Oldeelva River and the mighty Jostedalsbreen Glacier. From here, enjoy an included excursion toward Briksdal Glacier, travelling through beautiful valleys and mountain scenery to experience one of Norway's most memorable glacier landscapes.



DAY 10

Bergen



Bergen Disembarkation

Arrive back in Bergen this morning, returning to the Gateway to the Fjords after your journey through Norway's western fjords. After disembarkation, transfer to your hotel and enjoy the rest of the day at leisure.

Take time to explore Bergen at your own pace, perhaps discovering Bryggen's UNESCO-listed alleyways, harbourfront views and charming streets. This evening, gather for dinner at a local restaurant.

Norway in a Nutshell

Begin your scenic journey from Bergen to Oslo, travelling by rail, coach and fjord cruise through some of Norway's most iconic landscapes. Ride the Bergen Railway to Voss, continue by coach through dramatic valleys to Gudvangen, then cruise along the UNESCO-listed Nærøfjord to Flåm. From there, board the famous Flåm Railway to Myrdal before continuing onward to Oslo.

Accommodation: *Clarion Hotel The Hub Oslo or similar (2 nights)*

DAY 12

Oslo



Visit the Fram Museum, which tells the story of Norway's polar exploration, followed by the Kon-Tiki Museum, known for showcasing remarkable expeditions across the seas. Continue with a sightseeing tour of Oslo, Norway's elegant capital city.



Oslo City

Discover Oslo's main landmarks on a guided sightseeing tour through Norway's elegant capital. Admire the Royal Palace, National Theater, Parliament, waterfront Opera House and the medieval Akershus Fortress, each offering a glimpse into the city's history, culture and modern Nordic design.

The rest of the day is at leisure, giving you time to explore at your own pace, stroll along the harbour, browse local shops or relax before the journey comes to a close. This evening, gather with your fellow travellers for a farewell dinner at a local restaurant.

DAY 13

Oslo

Farewell Norway

Enjoy breakfast at your hotel before checking out and transferring to Oslo Airport for your return flight home.

Depart Norway with wonderful memories of Bergen, the inner fjords, scenic rail journeys and Oslo's cultural highlights. Your journey concludes as you fly from Oslo to Toronto via Reykjavik.

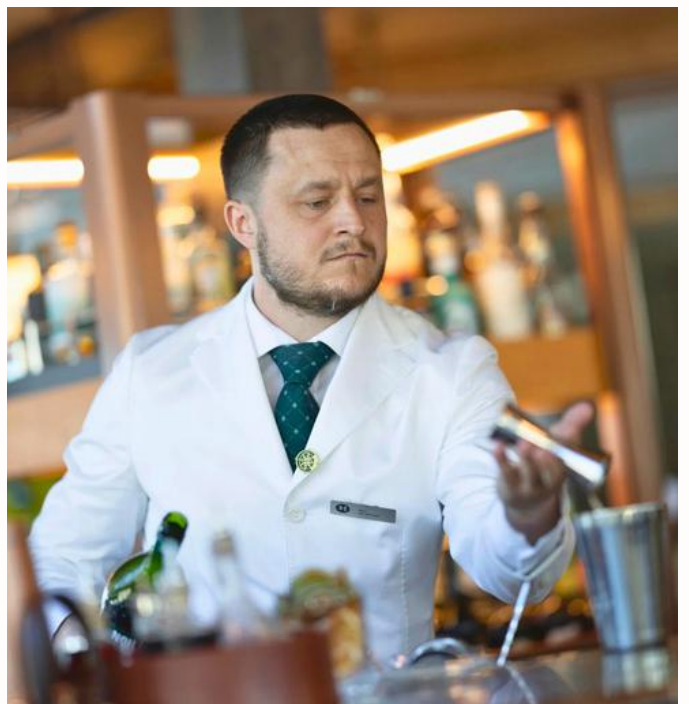

MS TROLLFJORD

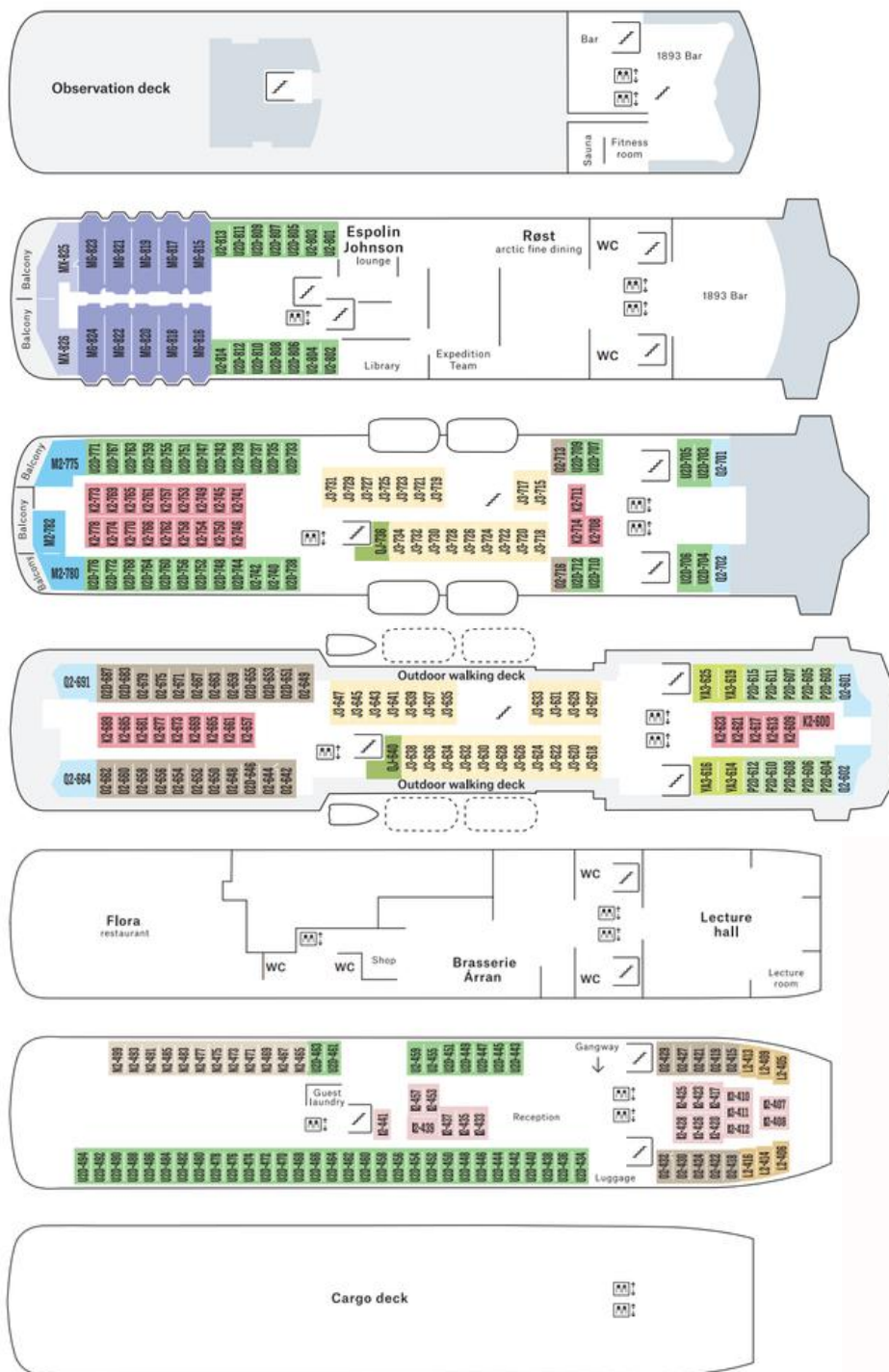
MS Trollfjord is an homage both to Norwegian nature and our 130-year heritage sailing the Norwegian coast.

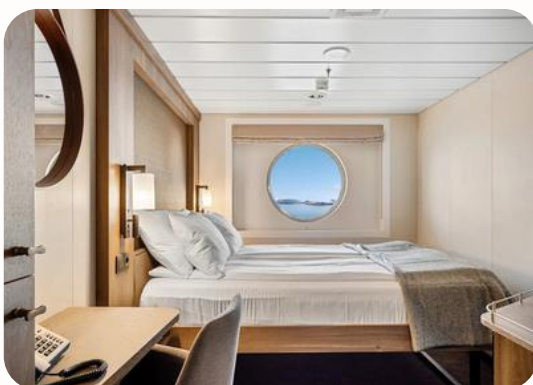
