After 11 years, Art on a Postcard will host its final postcard auction in support of The Hepatitis C Trust, a moment that marks the end of an extraordinary era. Guest curator Lauren Estelle Jones has invited over 50 artists to create new works in the format of a postcard, a small vessel for something vast. Taking inspiration from The Mama's & The Papa's song Dedicated to the One I Love, the project asks artists to send a visual message to someone they love, either in the present or as a fragment returned to the past. Each postcard becomes a letter of devotion, memory, and becoming - a delicate bridge between lives that have been lived and those still being dreamt up.

This farewell auction also celebrates the achievements of The Hepatitis C Trust. Since its founding in 2002, the charity has grown from a small patient-led organisation leading the call for the elimination of hepatitis C into a national, peer-led service delivering tailored support to some of the most marginalised communities. Thanks to this pioneering work, the UK now stands on the brink of becoming one of the first countries in the world to eliminate hepatitis C.

Lauren Estelle Jones is the co-founder of the contemporary art organisations Art Barter and Alteria Art and acts as an independent curator, consultant, and advisor. She works internationally to initiate projects featuring emerging and established contemporary artists across creative disciplines, with a focus on visual art and music. Jones has worked closely with over 800 artists throughout her career and has selected some of her favourite artists participate in this auction, ensuring that there is a mix of established names alongside emerging talent, as is typical of her practice that aims to democratise the way that people experience art.

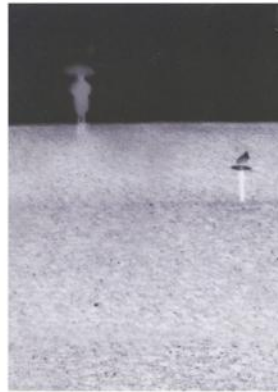
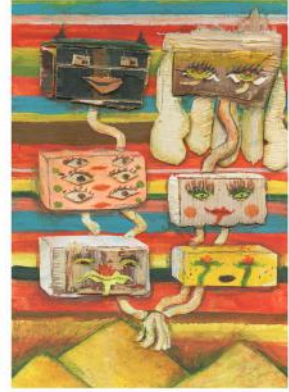
REGISTER TO BID

“This Is Dedicated To The One I Love”

It was such an honour to be invited to bring together artists for one of the last Art on a Postcard auctions. My first instinct was to create something uplifting as a counterpoint to the surreal and disheartening reality of the daily news.

Ruminating on the idea of the postcard led me to one of my favourite songs, The Mamas & The Papas’ soulful rendition of Dedicated to the One I Love. I shared this as a starting point when inviting artists to participate, and asked them to respond with a love letter of their own, either to a former or future self, or another love in their life.

I was keen to expand on the traditional notion of what a postcard can be, and encouraged the artists to be bold with their materials and ideas. The results are honest, surprising, and at times profoundly moving. The auction will include works in concrete, ceramics, embroidery, drawing, painting, collage, and origami - each work a visual message held in the palm of your hand.

Creating platforms that make art more accessible while challenging ideas around value has always been central to my practice. For this project, I've brought together a group of artists whose work I admire, ranging from established figures to emerging voices, all united by a willingness to share something personal and support a meaningful cause.

Since 2014, Art on a Postcard has stood at the intersection of art and activism, amplifying the voices of emerging talent; offering collectors the chance to own original artworks at affordable prices; and supporting life-changing charitable work. Proceeds from this auction directly support The Hepatitis C Trust, whose pioneering work is transforming lives across the UK. The charity is known for its advocacy for the elimination of hepatitis C, but also delivers frontline support to some of the most marginalised communities, including vital peer-led programmes in women's prisons, where they provide education, testing, and treatment access for those who are often overlooked by the healthcare system.

A viewing room of the original artworks will be hosted at Colony Room Green, an art installation in its own right curated by Darren Coffield. The space is a recreation of the original Colony Room Club, the infamous Soho haunt once frequented by artists like Francis Bacon and Lucian Freud as well as several of the artists who feature in this auction. The venue also lends itself to the musicality of the project and the event will come to life with acoustic performances by emerging stars Venus Ray - the next generation in a revered musical lineage.

I am incredibly grateful to all the artists who have so generously given their time and creativity to this project, and to everyone engaging with the auction. Whether you are discovering new talent, bidding on a work by a long-admired favourite, or simply taking a moment to reflect on these small but dynamic pieces, I hope this collection lifts your spirits, creates connection, and offers a heartfelt reminder of the power of love in its many forms.
