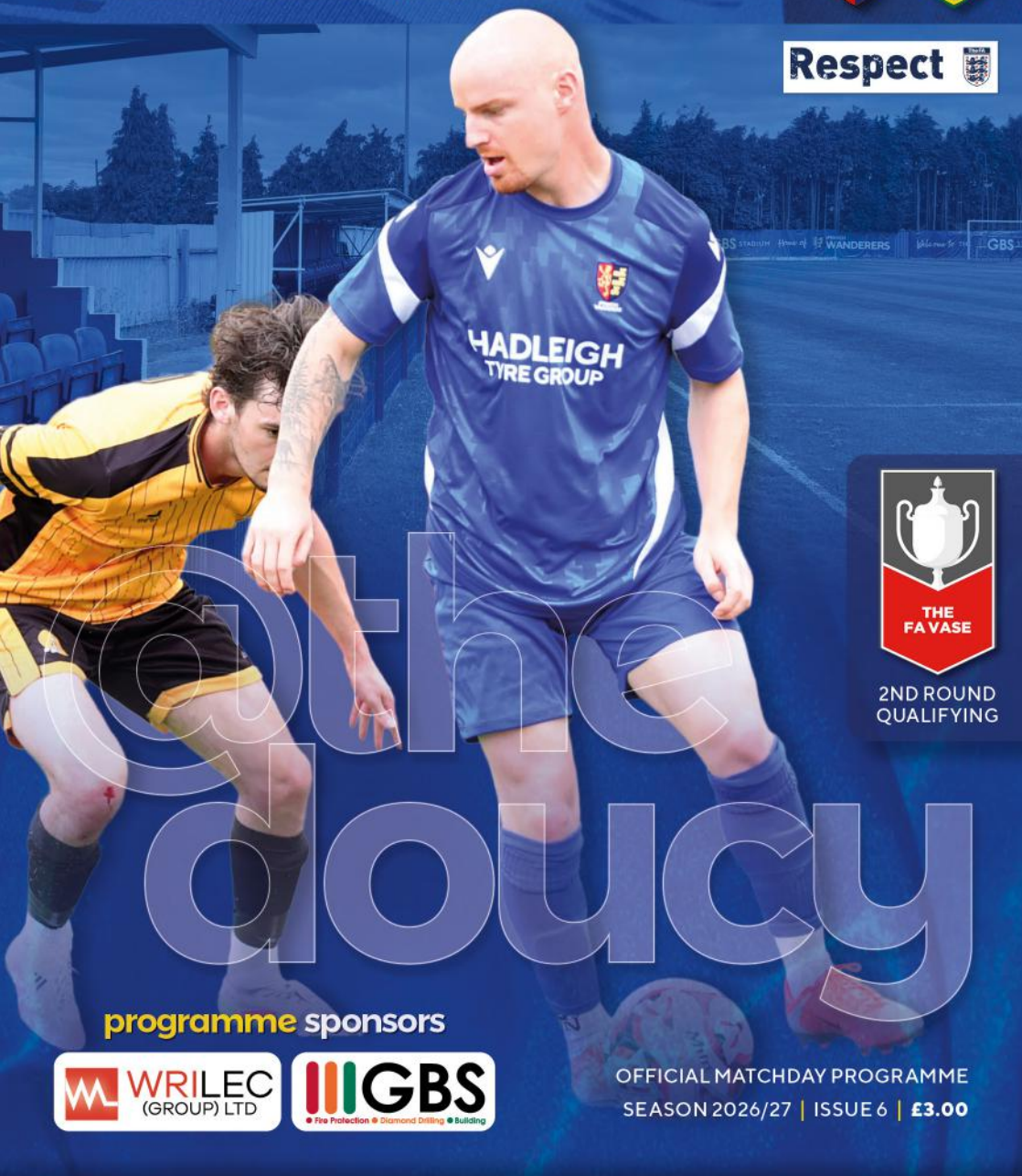

IPSWICH WANDERERS CLUB HISTORY

- 1980** ▶ The Club started as an under 14's boys team in 1980. Two yrs later they entered the lowest division of the Ipswich Sunday League.
- 1987** ▶ Joined the newly formed Eastern Counties Division One sponsored by Jewsons in 1987 as founder members.
- 1994** ▶ Home games were played at our present ground at Humber Doucy Lane, under the name of Loadwell Ipswich. Jimmy Barker became a very influential chairman and he negotiated a name change to Lancaster Ipswich FC before we eventually became Ipswich Wanderers. Jimmy died in November 1994 and his presence is sadly missed. Thankfully after all his work he saw the floodlights switched on in September 1994 in a match against Ipswich Town.
- ▶ Great ground improvements were made in the early years under the direction of Development Officer Roger Woshalo and ground Manager Tim Davey.
- 1996-97** ▶ A losing Suffolk Senior Cup appearance in 1996/97 lead to the following season becoming Champions of Division One, under the Chairmanship of Alan Haste, nine points clear of Maldon Town and losing only three league matches all season. Reaping the rewards of a successful youth policy which saw numerous trophies filling the clubhouse cabinet, a well organised side with a good balance between youth and experience saw us establish ourselves as a Premier Division side for a number of seasons until we suffered relegation on the last day of the 2002/3 season at Wisbech.
- 2005-06** ▶ The following season saw Jason Dozzell join the Club as Manager and after a midtable finish in his first campaign, the second season saw the Club sweep to the 1st Division title and with the assistance of Kevin Cunningham and Glynn Hague, the team finished 7th in the Premier Division in 2005/6, with the League's second best defence with home crowds on average exceeding 100.
- 2006-07** ▶ At the end of the 2005/6 Jason Dozzell and Chairman David Bugg left. Local businessman Ed Nicholls became Chairman and John Clarkson was appointed Manager having arrived with a reputation from the West Country. During the season he guided the club to the final of the Rudgeons League Cup, the 5th round of the FA Vase and a Suffolk Premier Cup Semi Final against Ipswich Town.
- 2007-08** ▶ At the end of the campaign John left the Club and with an exodus of players, the Club appointed ex player Louis Newman to the role. Louis built a young, inexperienced squad and after a poor start to the campaign which included some record defeats, was replaced by another former player Steve Buckle who was brought in to rebuild the squad and hopefully retain the Clubs' premier status. Unfortunately Steve was unable to prevent relegation and the only positive from the season was the Reserves capture of the Chell Trophy defeating Wroxham.
- 2011-12** ▶ Despite Steve's best efforts over the following few seasons the Club failed to build a promotion push throughout the campaigns and after a poor start to the 2011/12 season, Steve and Assistant Paul Grainger parted company with the Club. New chairman Terry Fenwick appointed Glenn Read and he brought in his own players and former Stowmarket Town boss Steve Jay as his assistant. He quickly revamped the squad and had the Club climbing the table before the end of the season.
- 2012-13** ▶ The 2012/3 season saw the Club just fail to clinch promotion to the Premier Division and lose on penalties in the semi final in the First Division Cup. The season did finish on a high as the Club clinched its first ever Suffolk Senior Cup trophy defeating local rivals Whitton United in the final. It was a remarkable victory coming from a goal down in normal time and then from 3-0 down in the penalty shoot out.
- 2013-14** ▶ 2013/14 saw promotion achieved with two long unbeaten runs ensuring a return to the Premier Division, we also lost a tight Senior Cup final against Whitton United and set a new club record with a 12-1 win over Downham Town.
- 2014-15** ▶ The 2014/15 was mixed as we adapted to Premier Division and finished 9th and enjoyed a good run in the FA Vase but off field the club lost one of its driving forces Roger Woshalo mid-season.
- 2015-16** ▶ In 2015-16 we defeated Canvey Island in the FA Cup and enjoy our best ever FA Vase run but with a heavy fixture backlog, relegation fears were only ended just before the season end. Glenn stepped down at the end of the season and for 2016-17 the Club appointed Shane Wardley as Player/Manager.
- 2017-18** ▶ Shane's first season saw us almost emulate our highest ever position, however, after a poor start to the 2017-18 season Shane resigned and following a disastrous spell under Mark Benterman, club legend Mark Goldfinch took over the side ably assisted by James Buckle and Daniel Thrower. Unfortunately, relegation could not be avoided and in 2018-19 we consolidated and lost in the Senior Cup Semi Final to Cornard.
- 2019-20** ▶ In 2019-20 with Stephen Boyle taking over as Chairman, we rebuilt and after a sticky spell in October we were closing in on the promotion pack and reached a Semi Final of the Suffolk Senior Cup before the season came to an abrupt end. With further additions on field and some good improvements off field under Stephen's leadership, we then looked to gain the vital promotion required for us to take the next steps forward with a good squad. The start to the next season was positive and a second Senior Cup trophy was clinched in the delayed final with a single strike from Connor Field clinching the trophy.
- 2021-22** ▶ After a couple of Covid-19 disrupted and curtailed seasons, for the 2021/22 season Wanderers went into action in the Thurlow Nunn First Division South. With what became a tight run affair and particular rivalry with Buckhurst Hill also aiming for the title, it went almost to the wire, Wanderers finally having the upper hand, and lifting the trophy with a goal 10 seconds from time in the final home game. With the final of the Suffolk Senior Cup to follow, we finished the season with 26 straight wins, and a well deserved double of league and cup was won!
- 2022-23** ▶ The following season started with four cup fixtures in the opening 7 games, and a haul of just 3 points from the first 5 league games meant Wanderers were already playing catch up when our league campaign really got going. A run of 6 wins in an 8 game unbeaten run helped to move us up the table before another rare defeat. More wins followed until in January, we visited top of the table Thetford, which ended in a 1-2 defeat. After this, Wanderers embarked on another 17-game winning run to the end of the season, including coming from behind to avenge the result against Thetford, going above them and ultimately become Thurlow Nunn Premier winners - back to back champions - and into Step 4 football for the first time in the club's history.
- 2023-24** ▶ The 2023/24 season, the first for the club in the Isthmian League North came with added pressure - both on and off the pitch. A poor start to the season on the pitch brought a change in September, with the departure of Mark Goldfinch & James Buckle. Glen Driver came in as manager, with the task of keeping the club clear of relegation. Off the pitch was a mammoth job with a huge amount of work needed to pass the ground grading requirements to stay at this level. The inspection in April brought a great deal of relief, and along with the efforts of Glen and his team on the pitch, meant the aims for the season were achieved.
- 2024-26** ▶ The following season saw us suffer relegation a poor run of results saw Glen Driver resign and Michael Brothers come in but whilst results improved we couldn't stay up. Last season saw a bright start under Michael Brothers but results stagnated and following his departure Jack Wignall steadied the ship before the club were delighted to welcome back Mark Goldfinch and James Buckle who masterminded a long unbeaten run which narrowly failed to reach the playoffs. Optimism is high as we enter 26-27 looking for a positive campaign off the back of those results.

Firstly, I would like to extend a very warm welcome to the players, management, committee and supporters of FC Peterborough. We hope you enjoy your afternoon with us and have a safe journey home afterwards.

It has been a demanding period for the lads, with three very tough games in a short space of time, but there have also been plenty of positives for us to take.

Our last home fixture against Cornard was a game of two very different halves. We were excellent in the first half, controlled the game well and went into the break with a 3-0 lead. Unfortunately, we came out for the second half and allowed Cornard back into the game. We lost our shape and composure at times and made life far more difficult for ourselves than it needed to be.

Thankfully, Reggie popped up with a late goal to secure a 4-2 victory. The three points were important, but there are certainly lessons for us to take from the way we managed the second half.

The game was also overshadowed by the injury to Kai Fletcher following a tackle which, quite simply, was better left away from football.

Kai now faces a long road back, and everyone at the club will do everything we can to support him throughout his recovery. We all wish him well and hope to see him back on the pitch as soon as possible.

Saturday saw us make the trip to Peterborough Sports in the FA Cup. We knew going into the game that we were facing a side two leagues above us, and the quality they possess was clear to see in the first half.

We struggled to get into the game and went into half-time 3-0 down. To make matters worse, we also picked up three injuries, with Dan Gilchrist looking likely to be out for a few weeks, Ollie Fraser suffering another flare-up with his ankle, and Jack Madley picking up a small groin injury.

Despite the scoreline, we were pleased with the response in the second half. We played some really good football in the final third, pressed higher up the pitch and created opportunities. We deserved to get something from that second half, even if we couldn't find the goal our play deserved.

We eventually lost 4-0, but I don't think anyone connected with our club could say that the players disgraced themselves. We went up against a very good side and, particularly in the second half, showed that we can compete and play our football against teams at a higher level.

I also want to say a massive thank you to the supporters who travelled to Peterborough. The noise and backing you gave the team from start to finish was outstanding. You made it a fantastic day out, and the players and staff certainly appreciated it.

Tuesday night brought another local fixture against Woodbridge Town, and after last season's "noisy neighbours" comment on social media, there was certainly a little extra spice to the occasion!

We started the game really well, hit the bar early and controlled large periods of the first half. However, once again, we made things difficult for ourselves by switching off on a couple of occasions and giving Woodbridge opportunities they could have punished.

From around the 37th minute onwards, the game became more of a basketball match than a football match, with both teams going from end to end.

The half-time message was clear. We needed more energy, more intensity and, ultimately, a greater desire to win the game. The lads responded well in the second half, although we were indebted to Marcus Garnham, who produced an excellent double save to keep us level.

We continued to push forward and eventually got the breakthrough through a Paulo free-kick. Then, to make the evening even better, Kye Webb, a former Woodbridge player, produced a fantastic finish against his old club.

I felt we deserved the victory, but once again we have to be more clinical in the final third. We are creating opportunities and getting ourselves into good positions; now it is about making those moments count.

That brings us to today's FA Vase tie against FC Peterborough. Cup football is always special, and these are the games you want to be involved in. We know it will be another difficult test, but we will approach it with confidence, belief and the intention of giving everything we have.

We have had a challenging few weeks with injuries and some tough fixtures, but the character within this group is something I am very proud of.

Finally, a huge thank you to everyone who continues to support us - home and away. Your backing makes a massive difference to the players.

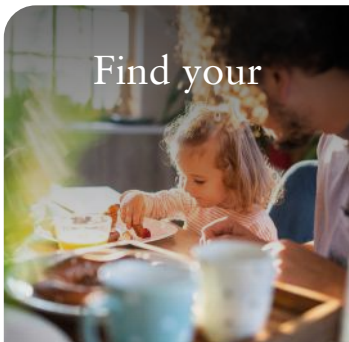

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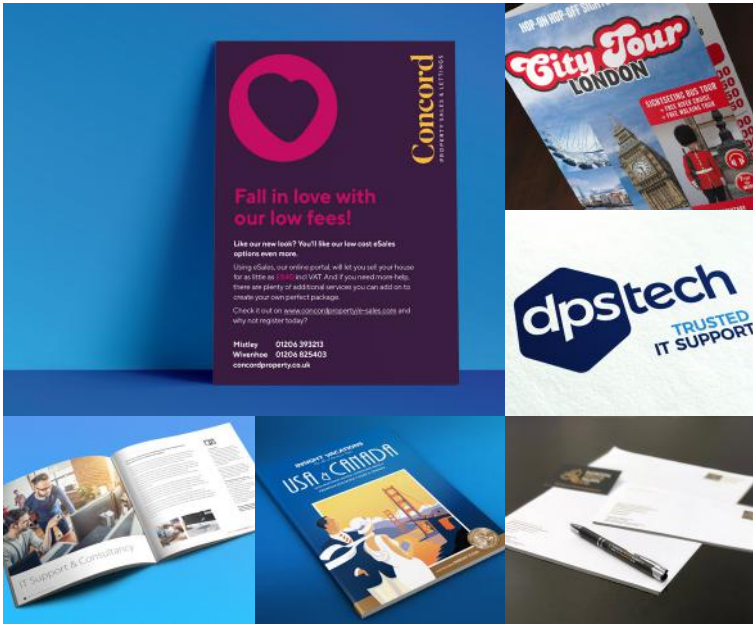

CLUB HISTORY

Founded in 2014, FC Peterborough emerged with a noble vision: to serve as a beacon of opportunity, empowerment and excellence for young individuals both on and off the pitch. From humble beginnings, the club has grown into a formidable institution, home to over 300 players spanning age groups from U7s to adults, a true community driven force grounded in ambition, perseverance and unity.

Our journey commenced in the 2014/15 season with a single team competing at the Fulbridge Recreational Ground, a public park emblematic of our grassroots ethos. That inaugural campaign concluded with remarkable success: runners-up in the league and victors of the Chromasport League Shield.

Momentum continued into 2015/16, as the team secured second place in PDFL Division Four and narrowly missed glory in the PFA Minor Cup Final. The 2016/17 season brought further advancement: another runners-up finish in Division Three, a place in the PFA Junior Cup Final and the establishment of our Veterans team expanding our legacy into the seasoned echelons of the game.

The 2017/18 season saw us ascend into Division Two, with both the First Team and Reserves achieving promotion, evidence of the club's growing depth and calibre. In 2018, the stewardship of the First Team transitioned to Ahmed Mustafa, under whose

leadership we competed in Division One with competitive spirit, albeit missing out on further promotion.

The 2020/21 season, impacted by the global COVID-19 pandemic, marked a managerial transition as Imtiaz Ali assumed control of the First Team. The following season brought about further evolution: Shahzad Hamid was promoted to First Team manager, while Faizal Ur Rehman took charge of the Reserves, guiding them through the challenges of Division Three.

A significant milestone arrived when, at a pivotal juncture in the club's journey, we transitioned from the limitations of Fulbridge Road to the Focus Centre at Chestnut Avenue, formerly the home of Peterborough Northern Star. This historic venue, steeped in local footballing heritage, provided the foundation upon which our aspirations could flourish further.

The 2022/23 season etched itself into the annals of FC Peterborough's history. Leading the PDFL Premier Division at the winter break, the team's valiant campaign culminated in promotion to Step Six, a monumental achievement. Our debut in the Thurlow Nunn Eastern Counties League in 2023/24 ended in a respectable 11th place finish out of 21, solidifying our presence at this elevated level with unforgettable moments and memories created by those who proudly wore the green shirt.

In the 2024/25 campaign, the club amassed an impressive 70 points, our highest-ever tally at this tier, falling short of playoff qualification by a mere two points. Although the outcome brought disappointment, the season marked a clear trajectory of progress and resilience.

The 2025/26 season was one that will live long in the memory. We had a consistently strong league campaign and were rarely, if ever, out of the playoff

spots. We began with seven games unbeaten and for a long period of the season we had a very healthy gap between ourselves and the team lying in sixth. We duly made the playoffs for the first time and put in a very strong display in the semi final, before dominating the final. We started our season at home vs Stanway Pegasus and ended it by beating the same opposition at home, in front of a huge crowd of 745, to secure Step Five football for the first time.

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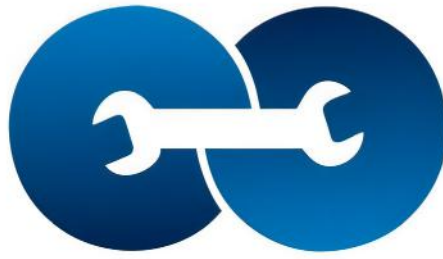


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On this day in IWFC History
