PhilRights was established through a resolution passed during the 7th National Congress of the Philippine Alliance of Human Rights Advocates (PAHRA) and was formally constituted in 1991.

With our formation, the human rights movement in the Philippines found an advocacy partner through our research, information, and education programs, laying the foundation for evidence-based campaigns and advocacies using the rights-based approach.
