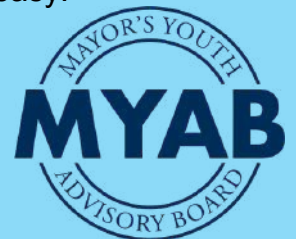

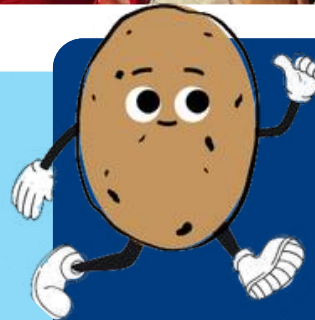


READY, SET... EAT!

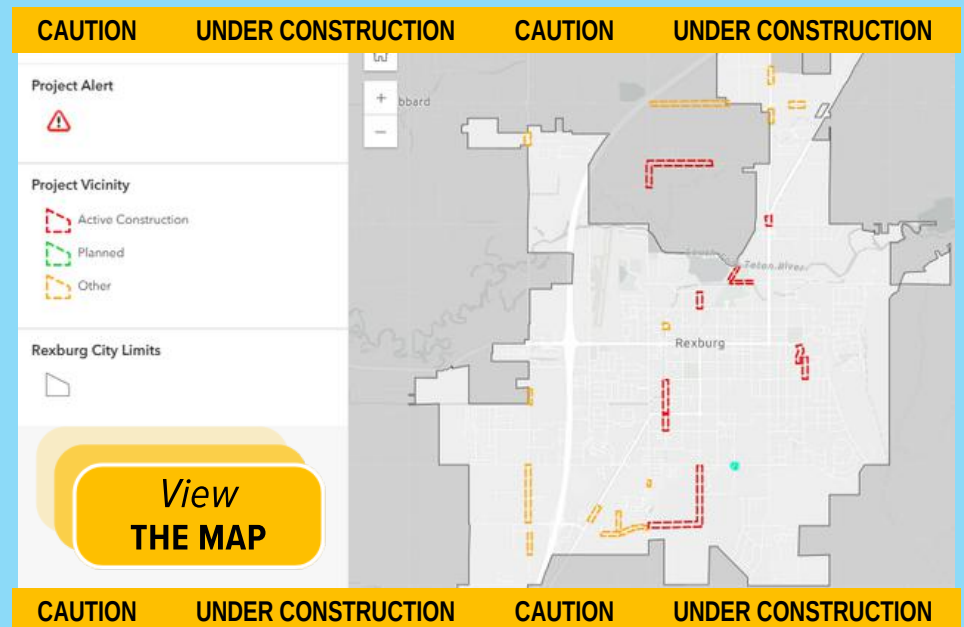

Several road construction projects will continue throughout Rexburg in September. 2nd East will remain under construction with traffic reduced to one lane in each direction. Ash and Birch Streets will experience temporary closures as crews install a new sewer line, and 3rd West between 2nd North and 3rd North will be closed for construction. Crews will also be installing a new traffic signal at 7th South and Center Street.

Adding to the excitement, BYU-Idaho move-in days are September 9–12, which means even more vehicles—and plenty of drivers who may be new to town. Please allow a little extra travel time, be patient, and use caution around construction crews and changing traffic patterns.

PLANNING AHEAD

Rexburg's 5-Year Road Improvement Plan

Wondering when your street may be scheduled for improvements? The City of Rexburg Public Works Department maintains a 5-Year Road Improvement Plan to help residents stay informed about upcoming street projects throughout the community. When road improvements are completed, adjacent infrastructure such as sidewalks, curb and gutter, drainage, landscaping, and water or sewer connections may also need to be brought up to current federal and local standards. These improvements are completed through a Local Improvement District (LID), which allows the City and benefiting property owners to share eligible improvement costs. Property owners may pay their portion after construction or choose to finance the cost through the City.

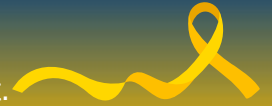
*Going Gold for
