Mobile App Guide

Step 1: Download & Open App

Available on the Apple and Android app stores.

Note: If you already have the app from the 2025 MVC, you do not need to re-download it.

Step 2: Log In

Use the email and password you set up during registration, or request a verification code via email to log in.

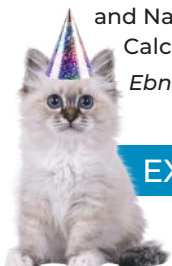

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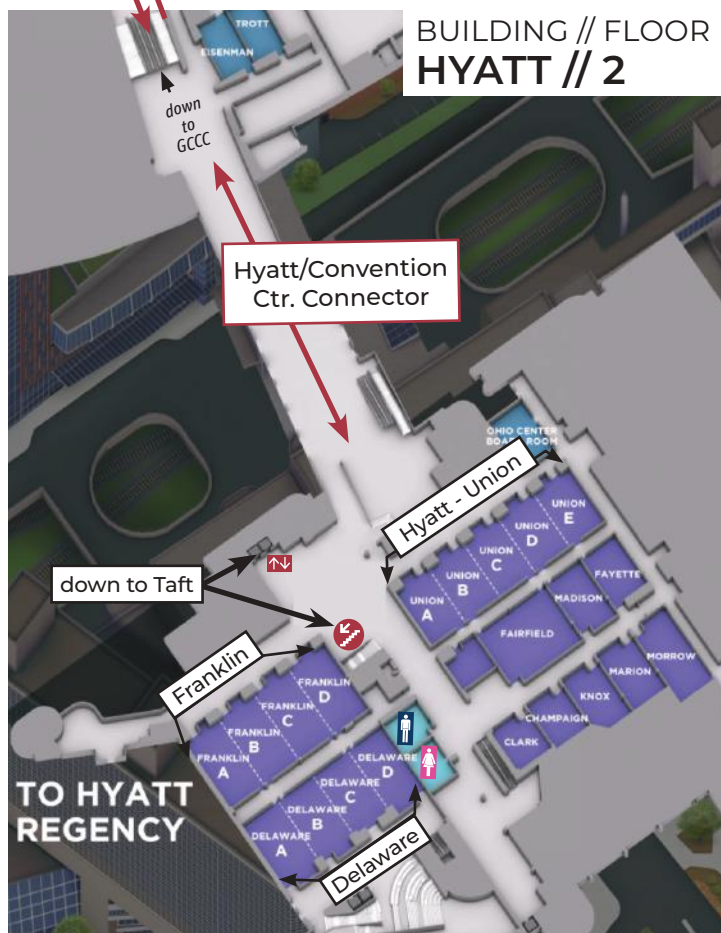
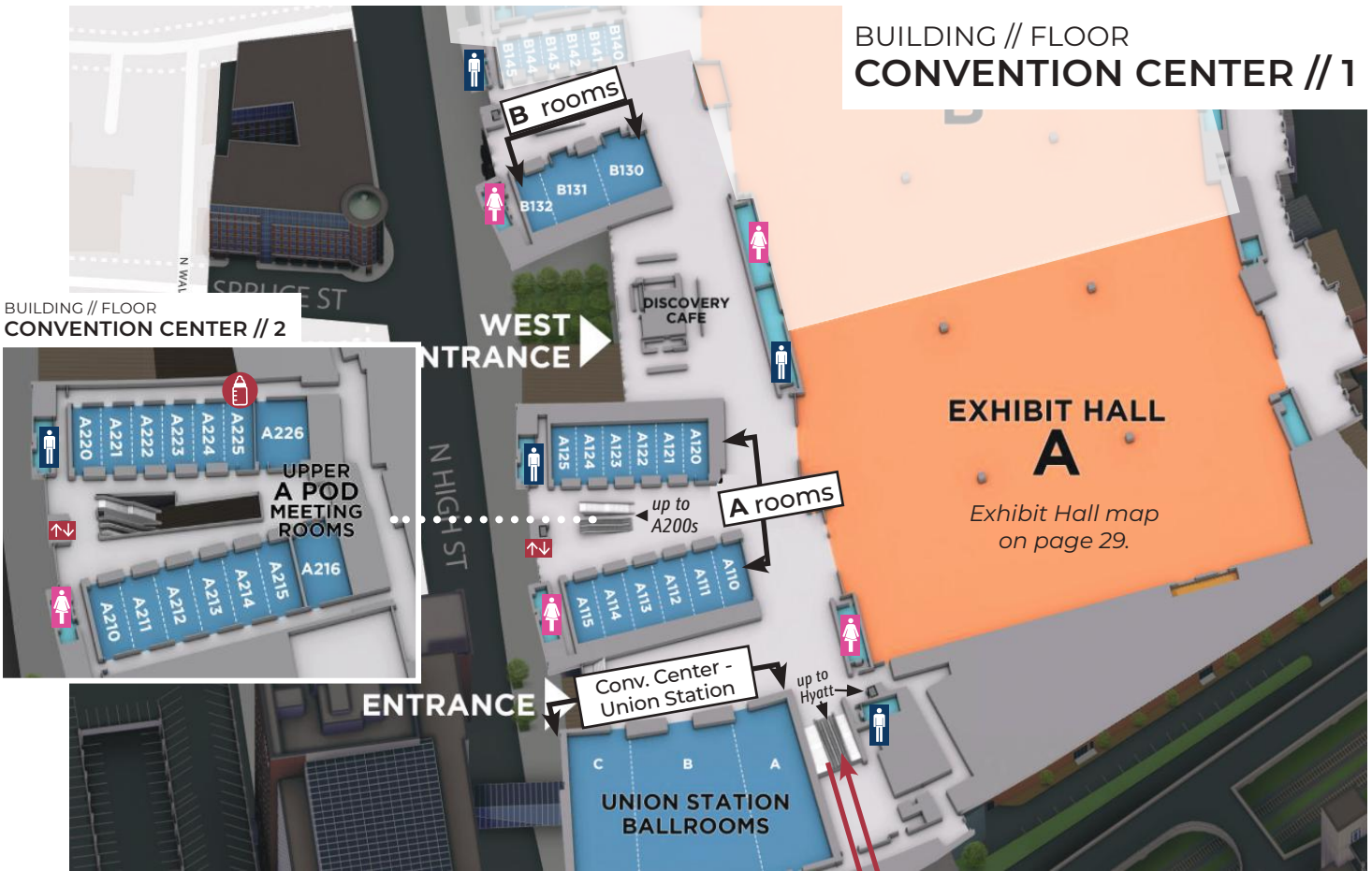

LOCATING SESSION ROOMS: The locations for all sessions are listed in the red bar at the top of the session grids.

- **Convention Center A Rooms:** Across the concourse from Exhibit Hall A. A200s are on the second floor.
 - A225 (Nursing Mothers Room) — Go up the escalator and turn right. A225 is near the end of the corridor on the left.
- **Convention Center B Rooms:** Head north on the main concourse (turn right out of the Exhibit Hall). The session rooms are past the Discovery Cafe on the left, across from Exhibit Hall B.
- **Convention Center Union Station:** Before the triple escalator, across the concourse from Exhibit Hall A.
- **Hyatt, 2nd Floor:** Head south on the main concourse (turn left out of the Exhibit Hall), up the triple escalator, and across the Hyatt/Convention Center connector.
 - Union — First hallway on left
 - Franklin — First hallway on right
 - Delaware — Pass the restrooms, then turn right
- **Hyatt, 1st Floor (Taft):** Head south on the main concourse (turn left out of the Exhibit Hall), up the triple escalator, and across the Hyatt/Convention Center connector.
 - **Stairs:** Immediately after the first hallway on the right. At the bottom, turn right. At the first hallway, turn left. Taft A will be on the left.
 - **Elevator:** At the end of the connector, take a hard right; the elevator is in the alcove. On the first floor, take the first right. Taft A will be on the left.

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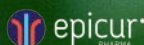


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
