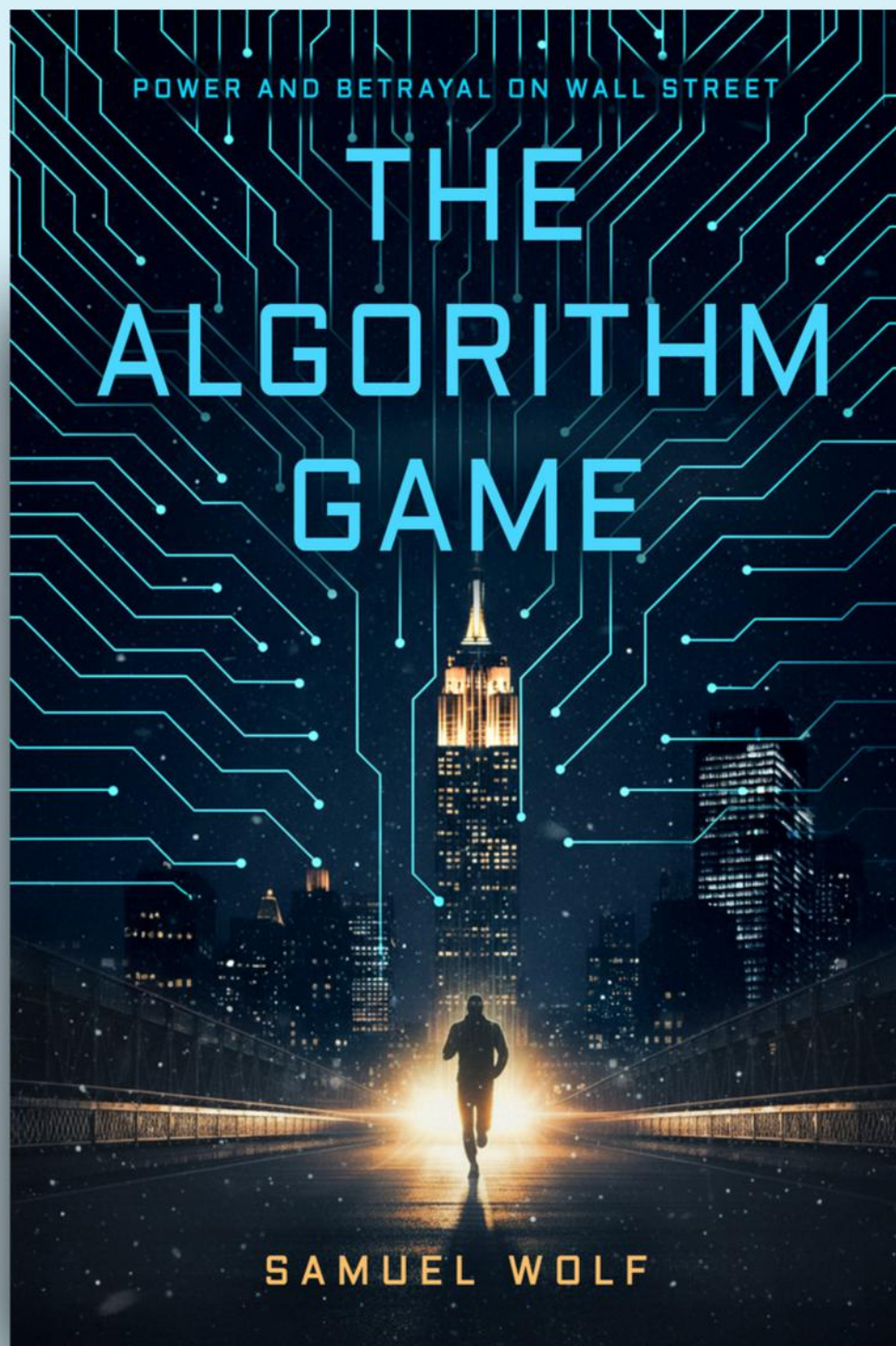

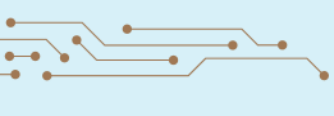
ABOUT THE BOOK

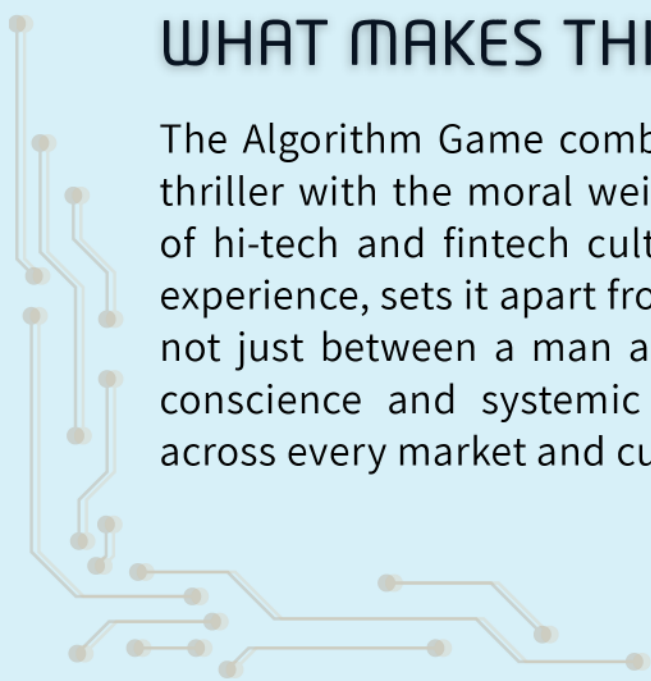
