The vast majority of extra-curricular provision and educational visits are provided voluntarily by teaching and support staff as a commitment to our young people.

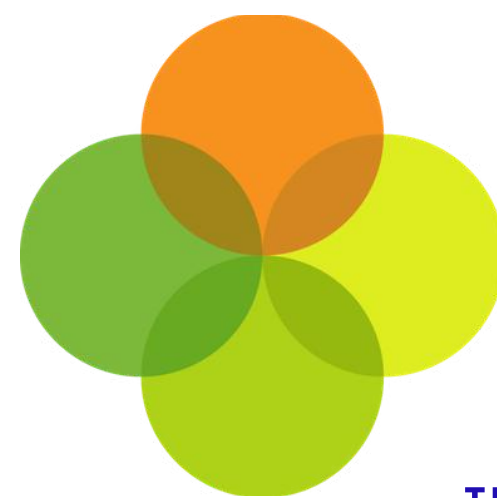
Please encourage your child to embrace the vast array of opportunities available to them and attend at least one activity.
