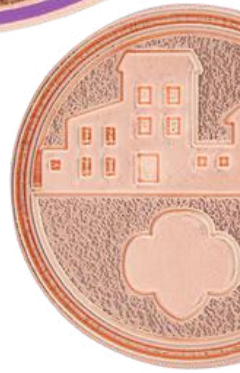
Junior Pearls
