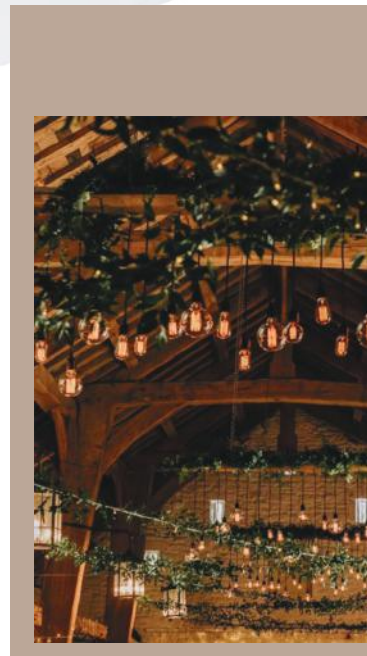
ABOUT US

With a romantic barn festooned in twinkling lights, intimate manicured gardens and the historic house reflected in the pond, East Riddlesden Hall could be the perfect wedding venue for your special day!

East Riddlesden Hall, a National Trust property, is a rustic wedding barn venue located in West Yorkshire. The romantic Airedale Barn, has all the modern touches located under one roof. The underfloor heating and waterfall of fairy lights create the ideal cosy ambience.

The atmospheric barn can seat up to 160 guests for your ceremony and wedding breakfast, or 250 standing for your evening reception, in a setting steeped in history. Alternatively, inside the main house, the 400-year-old Great Hall is perfect for intimate wedding ceremonies and can seat up to 30 guests. The warm stone walls and grand fireplace offer a perfect backdrop to take your vows. Our fantastic wedding team have plenty of experience and would love to listen to your ideas and play a part in making your wedding dreams come true.

As well as the rustic barn, couples also gain exclusive access to the beautifully maintained formal gardens for drinks, canapés and photographs after 4:30pm or all day on Thursdays and Fridays! The surroundings are so picturesque, your photographer will be smitten!



The food and drink will be flowing throughout the day, with a fully stocked bar in the Airedale Barn. Customise your beverage options through the additional pop up bar, available to be stocked with your favourite tipples, in a location of your choice. East Riddlesden Hall are partnered with a selection of Yorkshire's finest caterers, allowing you to select a menu best suited to your day.



The wedding team here at East Riddlesden Hall offer expert advice on planning and delivering your day. Your wedding coordinator will help to run your entire day, acting as your toastmaster, and seeing you through all the formalities. There is also a golf buggy service around East Riddlesden Hall for ease of access and the venue provides professional security on the gates, so you can enjoy your day knowing your guests are well looked after.

Other external costs that you will need to consider when utilising the venue, will be the registrars fee for your wedding ceremony, your catering costs and a public liability insurance policy of £5 million. From then on you can do as much or as little as you'd like with hiring various suppliers and decorating the barn to your chosen style or theme.

THE AIREDALE BARN

The Airedale Barn is a charming, spacious structure built in the 17th Century and was likely used for agricultural purposes as part of the working farm estate. The barn was substantially altered in the nineteenth century and was later used for food storage during the Second World War. Characterised by its traditional stone walls, wooden beams, and numerous windows that flood the interior with natural light. The barn's interior combines rustic charm with modern amenities, creating a warm and inviting atmosphere. The original oak beams and exposed stonework highlight the barn's historical significance and add a touch of authenticity to any occasion held within its walls.



The barn's versatility makes it an ideal venue for a variety of weddings, from a variety of different cultures, guest numbers and budgets. Its generous space can accommodate both intimate and larger gatherings, with flexible seating arrangements to suit different needs. The picturesque setting of East Riddlesden Hall, with its lush gardens and serene surroundings, further enhances the barn's appeal, providing a perfect backdrop for photographs and outdoor activities.

Equipped with modern facilities such as a kitchen space for our external caterers, golf buggy service and audio-visual equipment, the Airedale Barn ensures that guests have a comfortable and seamless experience. The barn also opens up to a charming lawn space, perfect for mingling and outdoor receptions, adding an extra layer of charm to any event.

This beautifully preserved historical building combines rustic elegance with modern convenience, making it an ideal choice for a wide range of events. Its rich history, stunning architecture, and picturesque setting provide a unique and memorable experience for all who visit. The Airedale Barn has garnered hundreds of positive reviews from past couples and guests, reflecting its reputation for quality and satisfaction. We attribute this largely to our ability to offer such a versatile space that can be tailored to suit all. THE GREAT HALL

The Great Hall is an impressive space that was once inhabited by the Murgatroyd family. This beautiful estate was once almost lost forever, but local brothers William and John Brigg stepped into save the East Riddlesden Hall from complete demolition in 1933. They bought it, and presented it to the National Trust in 1934. Today, the rooms are set dressed with items from this period, showing off it's grandeur.

We are licensed to hold ceremonies in The House up to a capacity of 30 making it a great space for a more low-key, intimate ceremony. Our conservation rules mean that only dried flowers are permitted and no naked flames, however the grand fireplace and wooden staircase speak for themselves, eliminating the need to spend extra money on styling.

Tours of The House during your wedding day led by one of our knowledgeable volunteers can be arranged, if requested well in advance. We just ask for a small donation towards the upkeep and maintenance of the collections and interiors of the Hall.

The Manor House itself is a masterpiece of Jacobean architecture, featuring intricate stonework, grand fireplaces, and period furnishings that transport guests back in time. The house's exterior, with its ivy-clad walls and mullioned windows, provides a captivating backdrop for wedding photography, ensuring that every moment is captured with a touch of old-world romance, making it an ideal choice for couples seeking a venue with character and history.

The heart of the manor, The Great Hall, is a magnificent space that impresses with its high ceilings, wooden beams, and large stone fireplace. This grand room creates the perfect excuse to keep guest numbers low for this chapter of the day, creating an unforgettable setting for exchanging vows and celebrating with your closest loved ones. Drinks receptions can then be held in the formal gardens at the rear of the house.

When using The Great Hall, you will still have access to the Airedale Barn for evening celebrations. You can keep your meal small and intimate or invite up to 150 people to join you for your wedding breakfast, before partying the night away with up

Alternatively, Bracken Hall House is an award-winning B&B facing directly onto the beautiful Shipley Glen with Rombalds Moor behind. Whether you want Bracken Hall House to yourself as a luxury holiday cottage, or prefer to book one or more rooms as a guest for bed and breakfast, you are guaranteed a luxurious and relaxing stay. If you have chosen East Riddlesden Hall because of its rich history then Weavers Guest House might be for you. This home has been thoughtfully renovated; celebrating the past but with a nod to modern interior design. Weavers of Haworth offers a stylish and snug home-from-home in the heart of historic Haworth. You can rent out the main guest house, or one of the 19th century Grade II listed cottages.

Moorlands Farm Holidays is a development of three Holiday Homes in East Morton, only a 10 minute drive from East Riddlesden Hall. Nestled on the south side of Ilkley Moor in an elevated position with the most stunning panoramic views.

Cravenwood Cottages are located in the beautiful village of Embsay in the heart of the Yorkshire Dales, the perfect accommodation base to explore the natural beauty and rich history of the local area. Whether you are a newcomer to the Dales or a regular visitor, we are sure you will enjoy everything there is to offer.

RECOMMENDATIONS



When planning a wedding, it can be easy to focus on the big-ticket items like the wedding breakfast, dress, and guest list. However, the little details also play a crucial role in making your wedding day truly special and it allows you as a couple to express your personalities. Details like thoughtful guest favours can significantly enhance the comfort and enjoyment of your guests.



We always ask you make us aware ahead of time of any specific requirements or accessibility needs, happy and comfortable guests are more likely to remember your wedding fondly. Interactive elements such as a photo booth, signature cocktails, or a well-thought-out playlist can create memorable moments for your guests. These touches often become the highlights of their experience.



I DO'S AND I DONT'S

Wedding Planning can sometimes be a little bit stressful so we have included some tips from the team to try and reassure you and help you remember some of the little details you might want to think about.

Don't - worry about fluffing your dress before you walk down the aisle, all of this will be handled by our lovely team. You should still assign someone to re-fluff it once you have walked down the aisle.

Don't - worry about anything once the big day is here, be present, the team will be with you every step of the way.

Don't - feel like you have to hire a toastmaster or coordinator, it is a lovely addition, however one of the benefits of an East Riddlesden wedding is that we have an extensive staff present at every wedding to ensure every step of your day runs accordingly, we have had lots of practice!

Don't - wait until you after the wedding to decide if you want to preserve items such as your bouquet, if you would like to do this book it well before the day, you can then arrange collection from the venue whilst you honeymoon.

Don't - forget to pre book your taxi! A lot of firms offer 'executive taxis' which are a little nicer to take you back to your accommodation. We recommend this between 11:30 pm and 11:45 pm.

Don't - read speeches from your phone. Printing your speeches onto paper or on to cards in your stationary design will leave you with a beautiful keepsake and will look a lot better in the photographs of your speeches.

Don't - leave your photographers without a guide, giving them a short-list of your family and friends photo shots ensures nobody will be missed and will reduce the amount of your drinks reception that is consumed by organising different groups for photos.





Do - build all styling components before dropping them off, we have plenty of room for you to store your things, but we only have so much time on the morning of your wedding.

Do - hold your bouquet at your stomach, not your chest, the photographers will thank you!

Do - carve some time out of your busy day to have a moment to yourselves as a new couple.

Do - make the day your own. From room styling, to order of the day, you can make the day whatever you want it to be. It should fit you as a unique couple.

Do - think about the day from your point of view and from the point of view of the guests when planning.

Do - talk to the caterers about having your cake cut up for you.

Do - take five minutes just to pause and look around together. The day goes by so quickly, so soak in the atmosphere, your guests, and the moment you've been planning for.

Do - buy long burn time candles and/or bring us some replacements, when the lights are lowered in the evening it makes it look so much better if your candles are still burning.

Do - make sure you swap your engagement ring over to your right hand before you walk down the aisle. Then when your wedding ring is placed onto your left hand you can move your engagement ring back over, this looks much smoother during the ceremony and also means you don't have to take your wedding ring off that your partner has just placed on.

Do - nominate a bridesmaid or family member to take your bouquet at the top of the aisle so that you are hands free and ask them to re-fluff your dress so it looks perfect in ceremony pictures.

Do - remember to eat! With all the excitement it's easy to forget, but having regular snacks and staying hydrated will help you keep your energy up all day.

You're always welcome to visit during our open hours, and you can even hire the venue again for future events and milestones. FAQ's

HOW DO WE SECURE OUR WEDDING DATE?

You can secure your wedding date by completing a booking form with a member of the team. You will then receive your wedding contract online which will need to be returned within 28 days of receipt, along with your £1,000 deposit. You can pay your deposit by invoice, cheque or by card.

ARE THERE ANY HIDDEN COSTS?

We will only ask you for our set hire price which is listed on our pricing leaflet. Other external costs you will need to consider will be your registrars fee for your wedding ceremony, your catering costs and a public liability insurance policy. From there you can do as much or as little as you'd like with hiring suppliers and decorating the venue. We do have a couple of optional extras available at the venue so please get in touch with the team to find out more!

DO YOU ALLOW FIREWORKS & FIREPITS?

As we are a site proudly looked after by the National Trust fireworks; fire pits and sparklers are not permitted on site. We do allow the use of smoke bombs as long as we are told well in advance. Candles are allowed inside the Airedale Barn.

ARE YOU DOG FRIENDLY?

Dogs are welcome for your wedding ceremony and drinks reception. We ask that they are picked up before your wedding breakfast and evening party takes place. Assistance dogs are welcome all day.

CAN WE USE EXTERNAL CATERERS?

We ask that you choose from one of our carefully selected catering partners. Your caterer will also provide your evening food for you. We have an on-site icecream bike available for hire. Please note we do not allow other external caterers or icecream suppliers on site. You are welcome to use a separate supplier for your wedding cake and sweet carts.

CAN WE PROVIDE OUR OWN DRINKS?

Depending on the date of your wedding, drinks can be purchased through caterers or the venue. Your caterer can provide you with a drinks package option for your drinks reception, toast drink, and table drinks, or you can provide these drinks and pay your caterer a corkage fee. The venue bar is open alongside your drinks package from after your ceremony until 11:30pm and is not affected by any drink limits. Or you can do all of your drinks in house, providing your wedding is on a date that complies with this.

CAN THE BAR STAY OPEN PAST 11:30PM?

As East Riddlesden Hall is located in a residential area we cannot extend our licence, however the wedding team will be more than happy to discuss how you can make your wedding day timings work for you and your guests!

DO YOU HAVE PARKING AVAILABLE ON SITE?

We have plenty of parking available for you and your wedding guests. Our bar staff and security will be available to help your guests with taxi numbers at the end of the evening.
