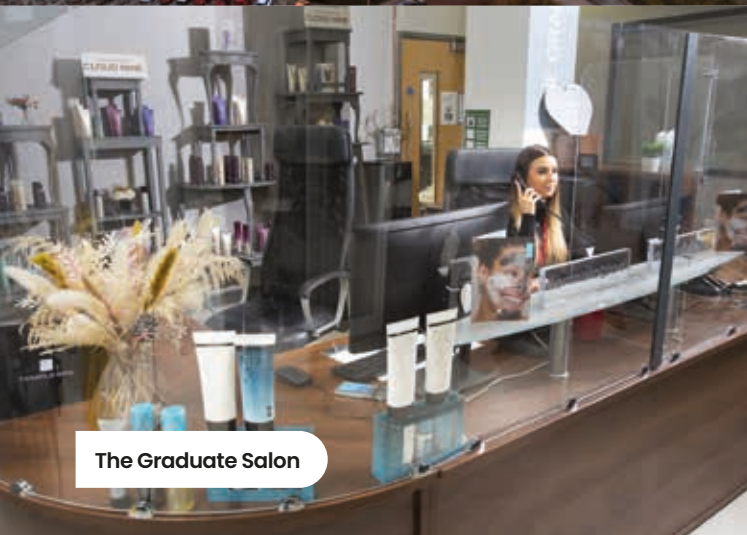

- ↳ **Aged 19 or over at the start date of the course**
- ↳ **Unemployed and in receipt of eligible benefits**
- ↳ **Economically inactive (not currently in employment or actively seeking work)**
- ↳ **Employed and earning below £33,210 (Tees Valley residents) or £25,000 (non-Tees Valley residents), subject to change**
- ↳ **Actively seeking employment**
- ↳ **Undertaking your first full Level 2 or Level 3 qualification**

If you meet any of the above criteria, you will be required to provide evidence at enrolment, such as recent benefit statements or wage slips.

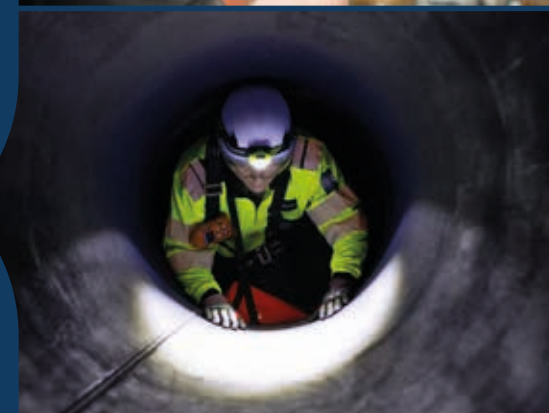

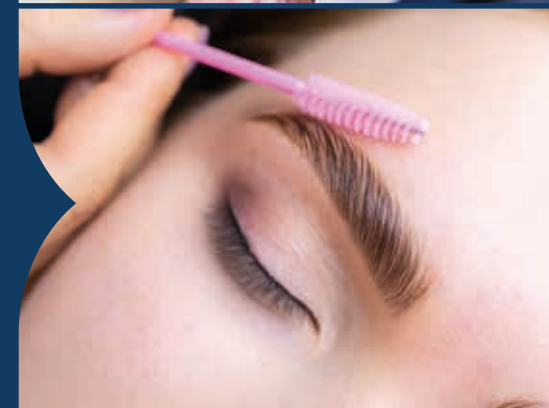
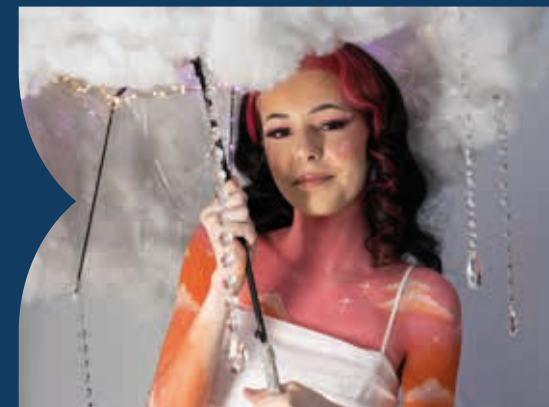
