

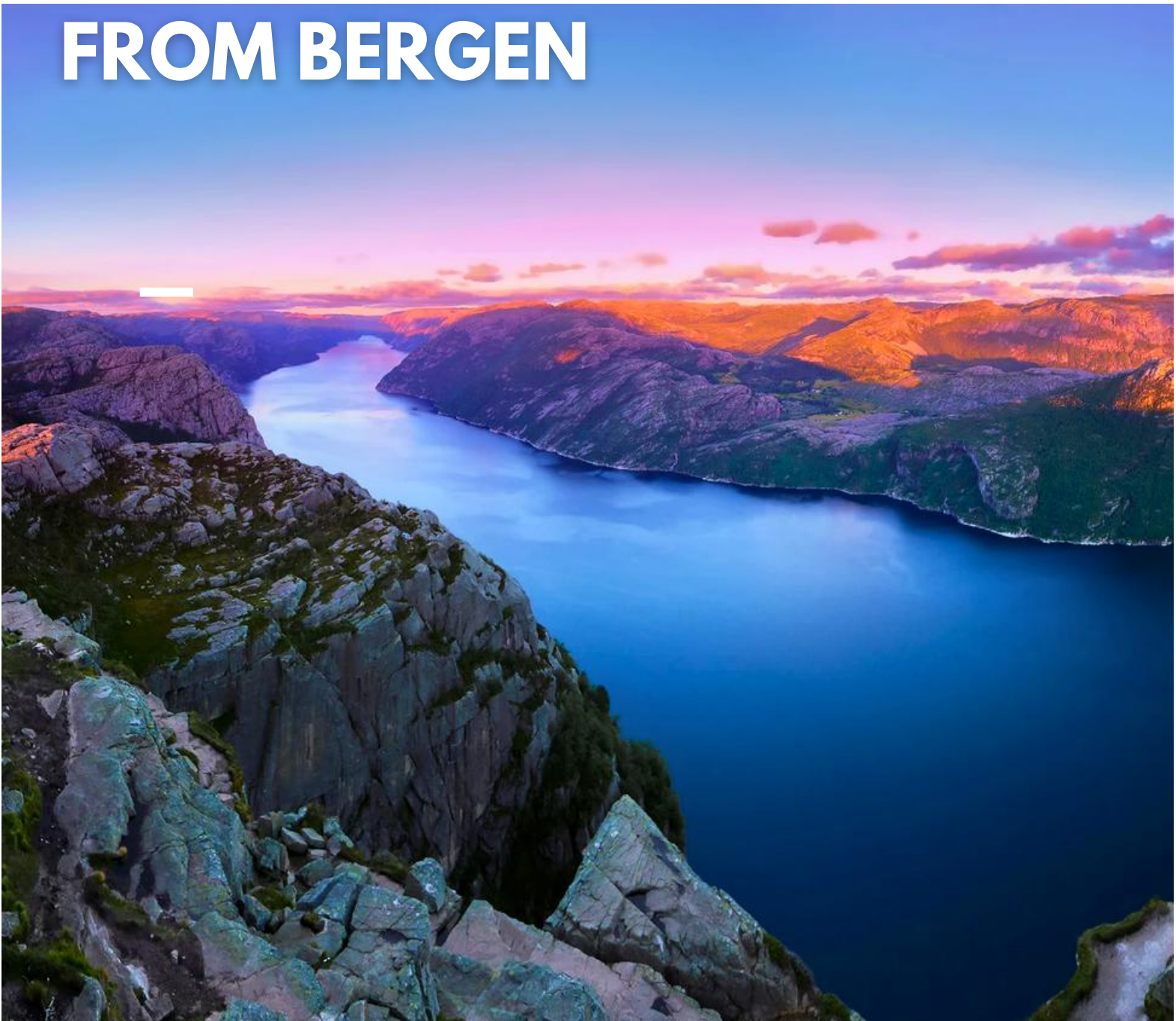

Explore deep into Norway's iconic fjords during the bright spring or the golden fall. Sail on this fjord cruise from Bergen through Norway's iconic Western Fjords, including the Sognefjord, Lysefjord, Hardangerfjord and Nordfjord. Witness Ålesund's Art Nouveau beauty, historic stave churches, and peaceful villages framed by waterfalls and mountains.

Please Note: This is an Limited Collection Premium Signature voyage designed to embrace the beauty of scenic sailing. To ensure the best possible experience, the Captain may adjust the route or the sequence of fjord visits based on weather, sea conditions, and light.

DAY 1

Bergen

Gateway to The Fjords

Bergen, often called the Gateway to the Fjords, is the perfect place to begin your journey. Surrounded by mountains and sea, this historic port dates back to the 11th century and is now Norway's second-largest city. At its heart lies Vågen Bay and the UNESCO-listed Bryggen district, where colorful wooden buildings, cobblestone streets, and boutique shops reflect Bergen's rich maritime heritage.

After boarding, meet your Expedition Team and settle into your comfortable home at sea. Get acquainted with fellow travellers before enjoying your first onboard dinner. In the evening, the ship departs Bergen, sailing south toward the majestic fjords as the city slowly fades into the horizon.





DAY 2

Kvinnheradsfjord

Rosendal & the Heart of Hardanger



Sail into the beautiful Kvinnheradsfjord, a branch of the famous Hardangerfjord, where steep mountains carved by ancient glaciers rise dramatically from the water and waterfalls tumble down toward the sea. Once an important route for farmers and traders, the fjord still reflects the peaceful rhythm of Norway's coastal life.

At its heart lies Rosendal, a charming village surrounded by orchards and the snowy peaks of the Folgefonna Glacier. Visit the historic 17th-century Barony Rosendal and its tranquil gardens, explore local art galleries, or relax with coffee and homemade treats at the garden café. Nearby, the Folgefonna National Park Center shares the fascinating story of the region's glaciers and landscapes.

DAY 3

Stavanger

Stavanger & the Fjord of Light

Today we sail through the dramatic Lysefjord, where towering cliffs rise over 3,000 feet above the sea and the famous Preikestolen (Pulpit Rock) stands high above the water. Later, arrive in Stavanger, a vibrant coastal city where Viking heritage meets modern life. Wander the charming Old Town with its white wooden houses, cafés, galleries, and waterfront restaurants, or browse local shops for Norwegian crafts and wool sweaters.



DAY 4

Hardangerfjord

Queen of the Fjords

Today we sail into the magnificent Hardangerfjord, often called the Queen of the Fjords, stretching deep into Norway's mountain landscapes. Glaciers rise above orchards and villages along the slopes, creating breathtaking scenery. In spring, fruit trees bloom beneath snow-capped peaks, while autumn brings orchards heavy with ripe fruit, inspiring artists and travelers for generations.

At the fjord's inner reach lies Eidfjord, a peaceful village surrounded by towering cliffs and rushing rivers. Here you can visit the Hardangervidda Nature Centre or join an excursion to the spectacular Vøringsfossen waterfall, where powerful cascades plunge into a dramatic mist-filled gorge.



DAY 5

Sognefjord



Nearby stands the UNESCO-listed Urnes Stave Church, Norway's oldest stave church, where intricate wooden carvings blend Viking artistry with early Christian symbolism—an enduring reminder of the region's deep cultural heritage.

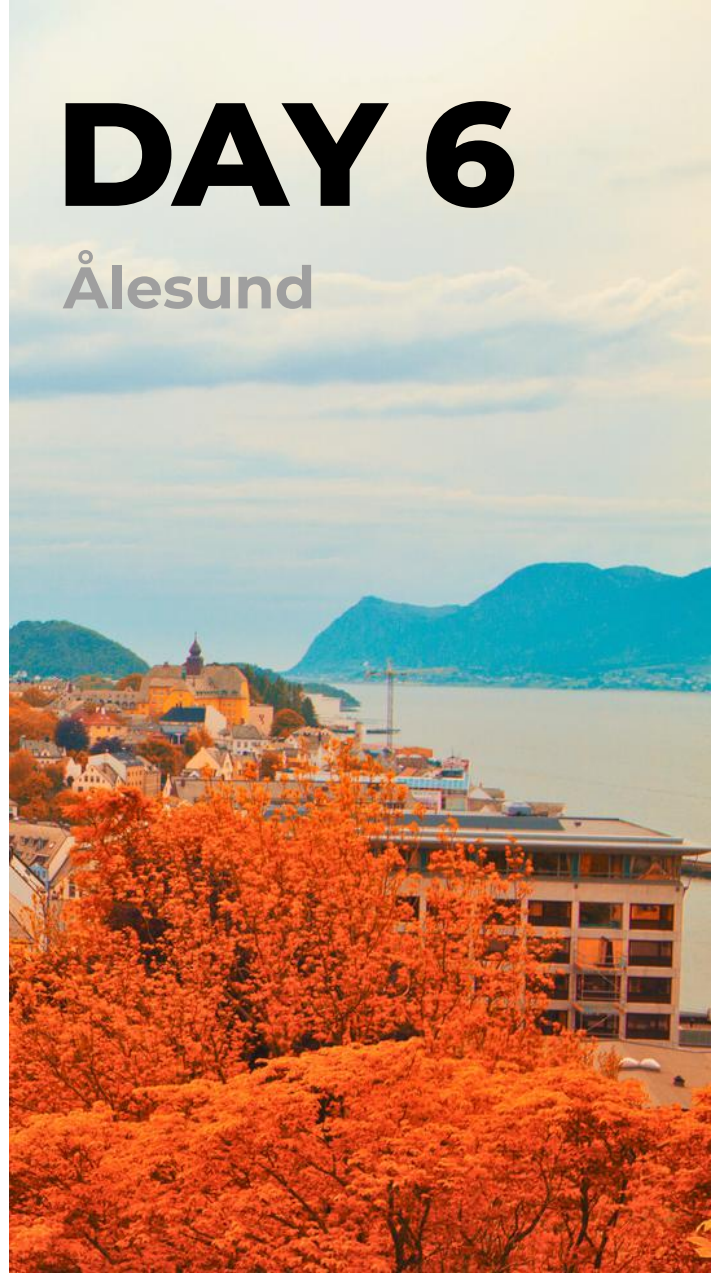
Deep into Norway's Heart

Sail into the majestic Sognefjord, known as the King of the Fjords, stretching more than 120 miles deep into Norway's heart. Towering cliffs and glacier-carved landscapes surround the tranquil village of Skjolden, where waterfalls and snow-capped peaks frame the fjord's dramatic scenery. From here, you may explore the mighty Jostedalsglacier, the largest on mainland Europe, or wander through scenic valleys leading to historic mountain farms.



DAY 6

Ålesund



Art Nouveau by the Sea

Arrive in Ålesund, one of Norway's most beautiful coastal cities, rebuilt in elegant Art Nouveau style after the great fire of 1904. Pastel-colored buildings, ornate towers, and decorative façades line the waterfront, set across a cluster of islands surrounded by mountains and sea.

Stroll along cobbled streets and waterfront cafés, visit the Jugendstilsenteret Museum to learn about the city's design heritage, or climb to Mount Aksla for sweeping views of Ålesund and the surrounding Sunnmøre Alps.

DAY 7

Nordfjord



Glaciers, Valleys & Village Life

The approach to Nordfjord is among the most scenic in Norway. Stretching over 60 miles (100 km) inland, it links the open sea to glacier-carved valleys and mirror-bright lakes. The fjord's sheltered waters once carried Viking ships and trading vessels; today, it reveals a gentler rhythm of life where red boathouses, pastures and forested slopes line the shore. Steep mountains rise abruptly from the water, their tops dusted with snow well into spring, while waterfalls descend in silver threads from high plateaus.

At the fjord's innermost reach lies Olden, a peaceful village framed by the turquoise waters of the Oldeelva River and the mighty Jostedalsbreen Glacier, the largest on mainland Europe. From here, you can take excursions into the valley, visiting glacial lakes and viewpoints where ice, rock and meadow meet. Whether you wander the waterfront or join an excursion inland, Olden captures the stillness and splendor of Norway's inner heart.



DAY 8

Bergen



Closing the Circle

We arrive back in Bergen, the Gateway to the Fjords, where your journey through Norway's magnificent western fjords comes full circle. Take time to explore the UNESCO-listed Bryggen district, wander the lively fish market, visit local museums, or ride the Fløibanen funicular for sweeping views of the city and surrounding mountains.

As you say farewell to the ship, crew, and fellow travellers, reflect on the unforgettable landscapes you've experienced—dramatic fjords, cascading waterfalls, quiet villages, and endless horizons of sea and sky. Though the voyage ends here, the spirit of Norway's coast will stay with you long after you return home.

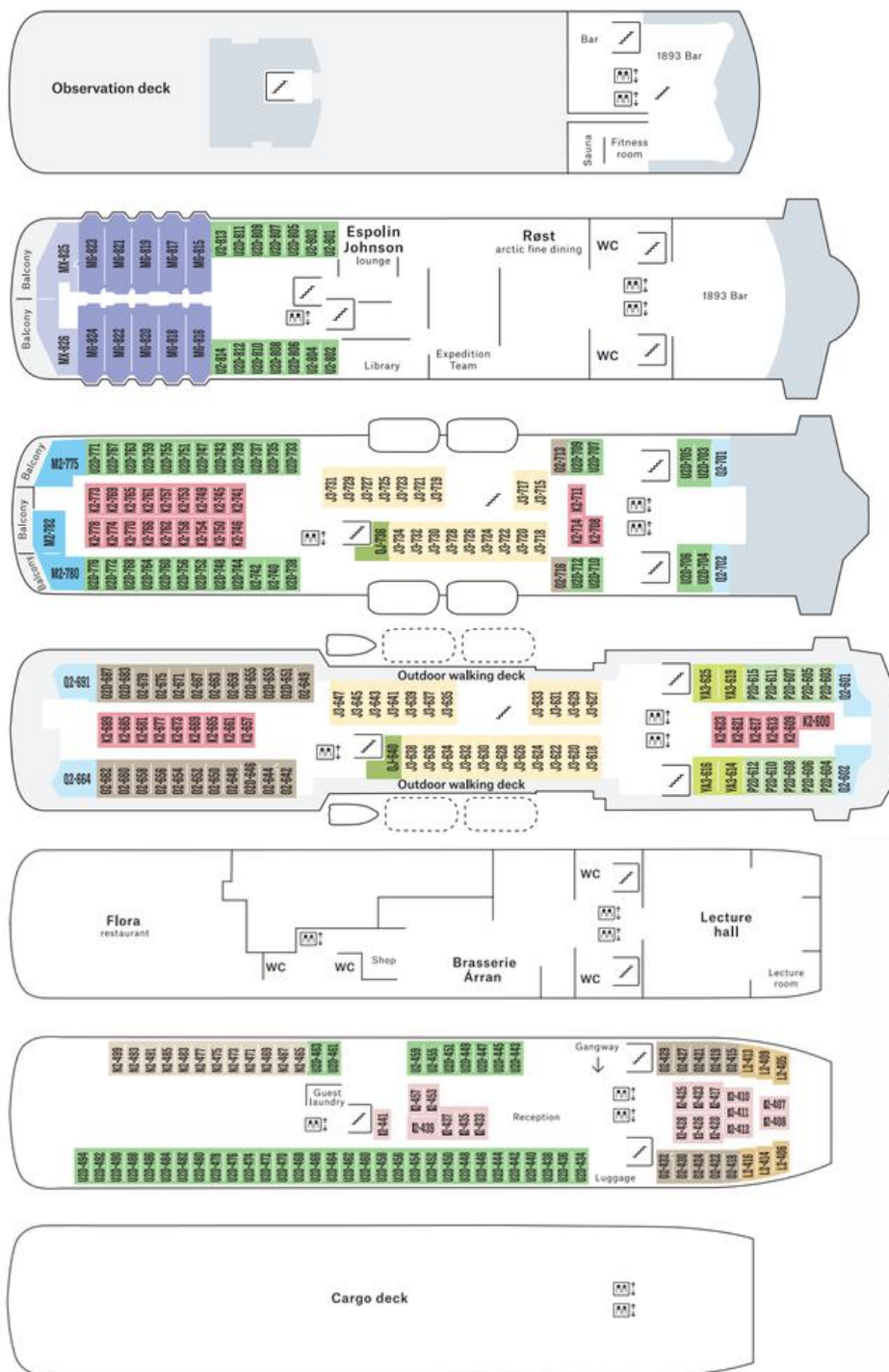
MS TROLLFJORD

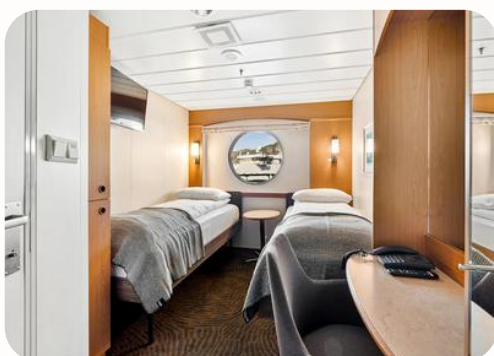

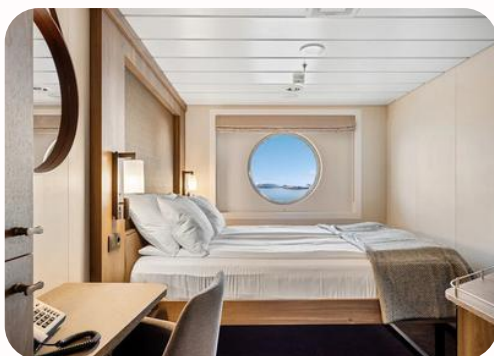
