FOWLER PARK

This park is home to two lakes including one that is ideal for fishing. For nature lovers, the park boasts scenic trails, picnic shelters, a covered bridge, and a historical pioneer village featuring a working gristmill. You can swim at the beach, fish, or launch a boat to explore.

Terre Haute is a true outdoor lover's paradise, boasting the most parks per capita of any city in Indiana. With an abundance of parks and green spaces, there are endless opportunities to immerse yourself in nature, whether you're seeking adventure or just a peaceful escape.

Deming Park, the city's premier park, offers something for everyone, including scenic walking trails, picnic areas, and inclusive playgrounds that welcome children of all abilities. It's the perfect place to spend the

day with a miniature train ride and swimming pool for added fun.

For those looking to explore waterways and enjoy some outdoor recreation, **Hawthorn Park** and **Fowler Park** offer kayaking and hiking opportunities, as well as beautiful lakefront views. Whether you're paddling along the water or hiking the surrounding trails, these parks are ideal for a day of exploration and relaxation.

For a peaceful retreat, visit the historic **Dobbs Park Nature Center**, where you can enjoy the tranquility of

Fairbanks Park offers scenic riverfront views and trails perfect for walking, biking, and jogging. Situated along the Wabash River, the park is ideal for those who want to enjoy a peaceful atmosphere while taking in the beautiful, natural views of the river.

If you're a birdwatcher or nature enthusiast, don't miss the **Wabashiki**

Fish and Wildlife Wetlands. With an extensive trail system, perfect for a peaceful walk through nature and opportunities to see a variety of wildlife, including eagles, this area is a hidden gem for outdoor adventurers.

The wetland habitat provides a unique environment for photography, utilizing the kayak launch or the new Dewey Point Lookout.

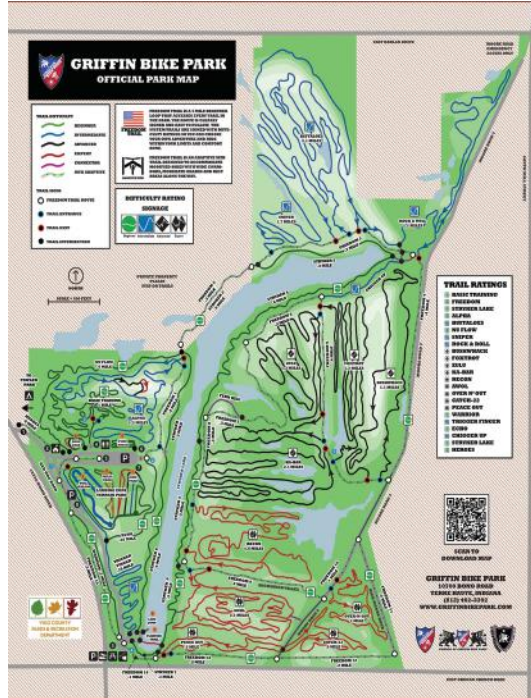

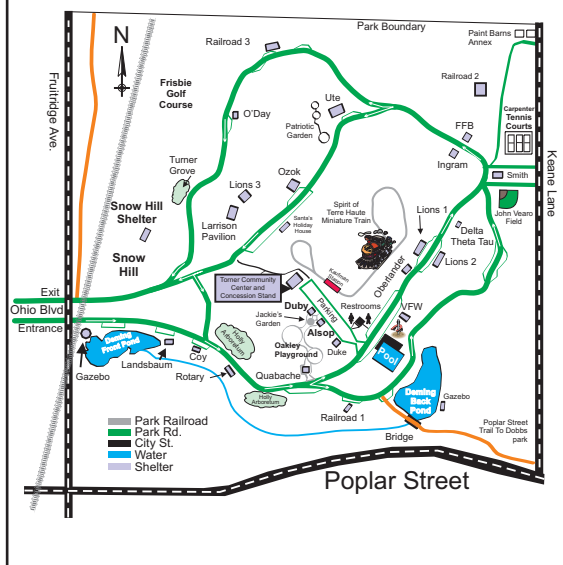

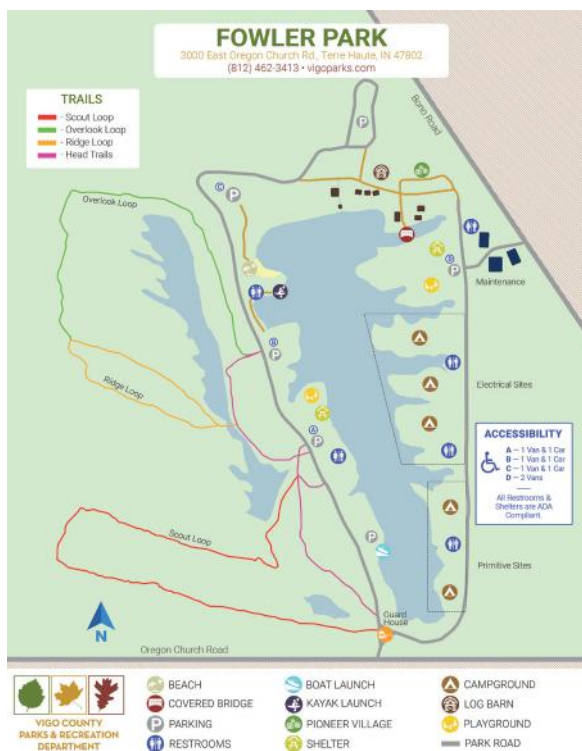

Mark's Par Three—a private course open to the public—offers a unique, welcoming atmosphere focused on finesse and fun.

For those seeking a different kind of target sport, Coal Creek Sporting Clays invites visitors to test their aim in a scenic setting with a course designed to challenge and entertain all skill levels. Top Guns, a premier indoor facility, offers state-of-the-art ranges and training, making it a go-to destination for firearm enthusiasts.

Pickleball players can enjoy two premier locations: Brittlebank Park and the Terre Haute Tennis and Pickleball Center. Both offer well-maintained courts, convenient amenities, and a welcoming atmosphere for players of all ages and skill levels—whether you’re after a friendly match or serious competition.

The LaVern Gibson Championship Cross Country Course hosts NCAA national championships, while Griffin Bike Park offers world-class mountain biking trails and competitions. Catch exciting college action at facilities across three local campuses, including Hulman Center for basketball and major events. The Vigo County School Corporation Aquatic Center hosts year-round competitions. For motor sports fans, the Hulman Mini-Speedway provides an adrenaline-fueled experience with youth and amateur racing.

LAVERN GIBSON CHAMPIONSHIP CROSS COUNTRY COURSE

Just a few miles east of the city of Terre Haute, this Championship Cross Country Course is the centerpiece of the Wabash Valley Family Sports Center, where champions and Olympic gold medalists are made.

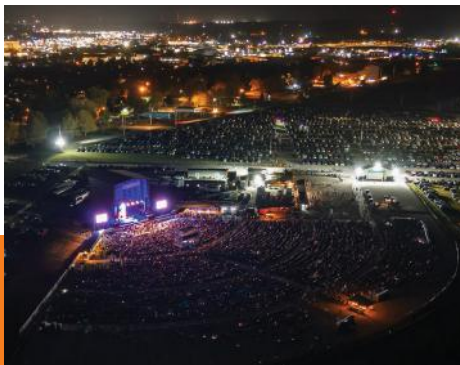

2. Take a Bird Walk

This spot offers a great photo opportunity as you imagine Larry Bird walking this very path on his way to becoming Terre Haute's hometown hero at the Hulman Center.

3. Snap a Selfie with Larry Legend

At the main South Entrance of the Hulman Center you will find the Larry Legend statue and historic marker. This 15-foot bronze sculpture immortalizes Bird in his iconic pose, capturing his larger-than-life presence on the basketball court.

4. Relax at the Copper Bar

This local hotspot is brimming with basketball memorabilia including a treasure trove of artifacts celebrating

Bird's time with the Boston Celtics and his days as a Sycamore. And, yes, Larry has been here... a few times!

5. Check Out the Throwback Mural, Outside the Copper Bar

His mural, featuring the iconic Sports Illustrated cover of Larry Bird in his Indiana State University No. 33 jersey from the legendary 1979 NCAA season, is a fitting tribute to the basketball icon. Plus, take a selfie with a life-sized Larry Bird at the Terminal mural next door.

6. Bonus: Catch a game at Hulman Center

While you're in town, be sure to check out the game schedule for Indiana State University's men's and women's basketball at the Hulman Center - where Larry found his fame - to catch exciting Division I action up close and see Larry's #33 retired jersey hanging on the wall.
