Planting & Growing Tips

- Plant each bulb — even the tiniest — **12 to 18 inches apart**.
- In about **three years**, one bulb will multiply into **30+ bulbs**.
- Clumps should be **divided every three years**.
- They bloom **two days after moderate rainfall**, year-round in warm weather.
- Plant in **native soil mixed with good potting soil**.
- They **require irrigation** and **love full sun**.
- **Do not plant in soggy areas** that stay wet for days.
- Deadheading not needed. Often go to seed!

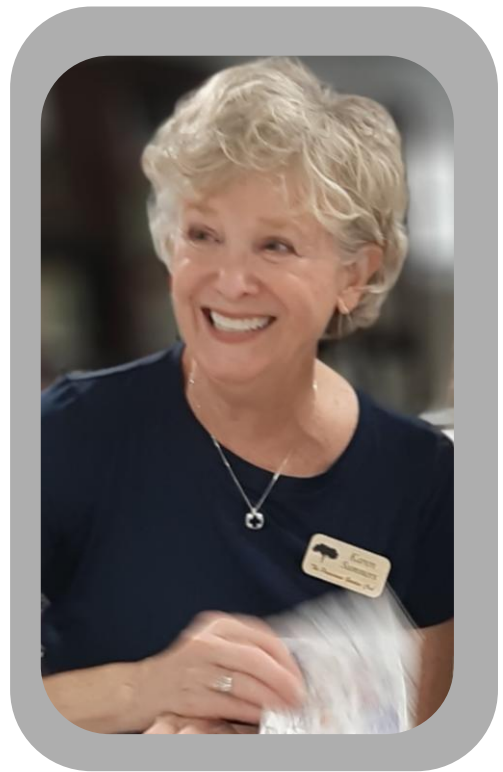

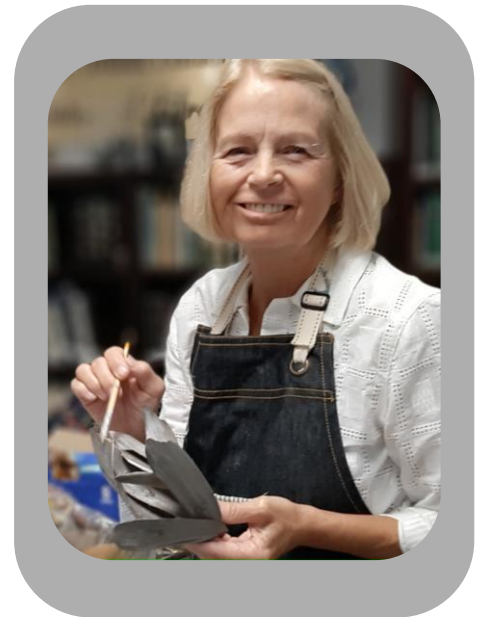
