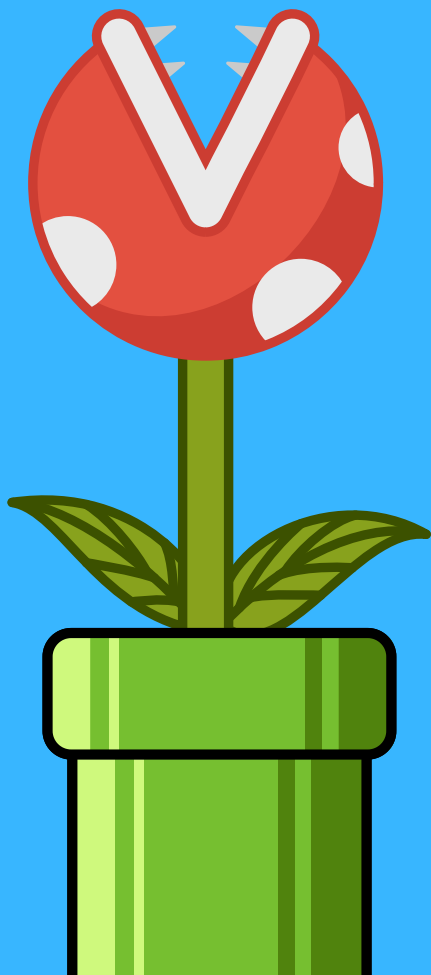
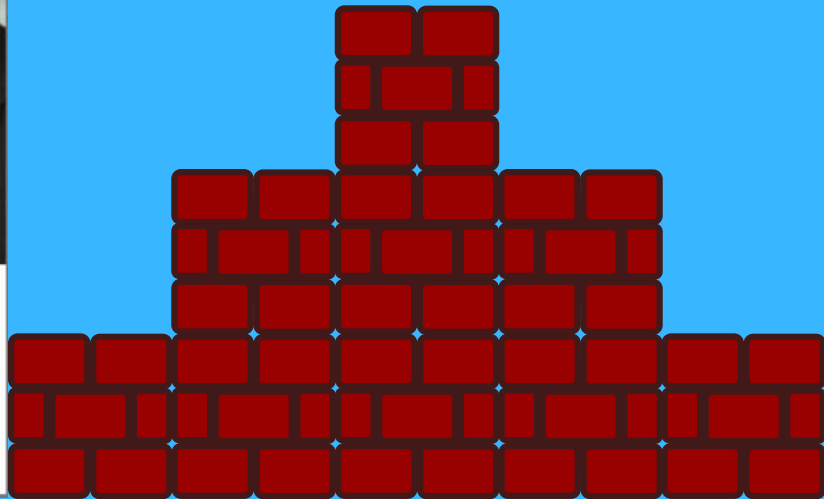
BURNIDGE FAMILY STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

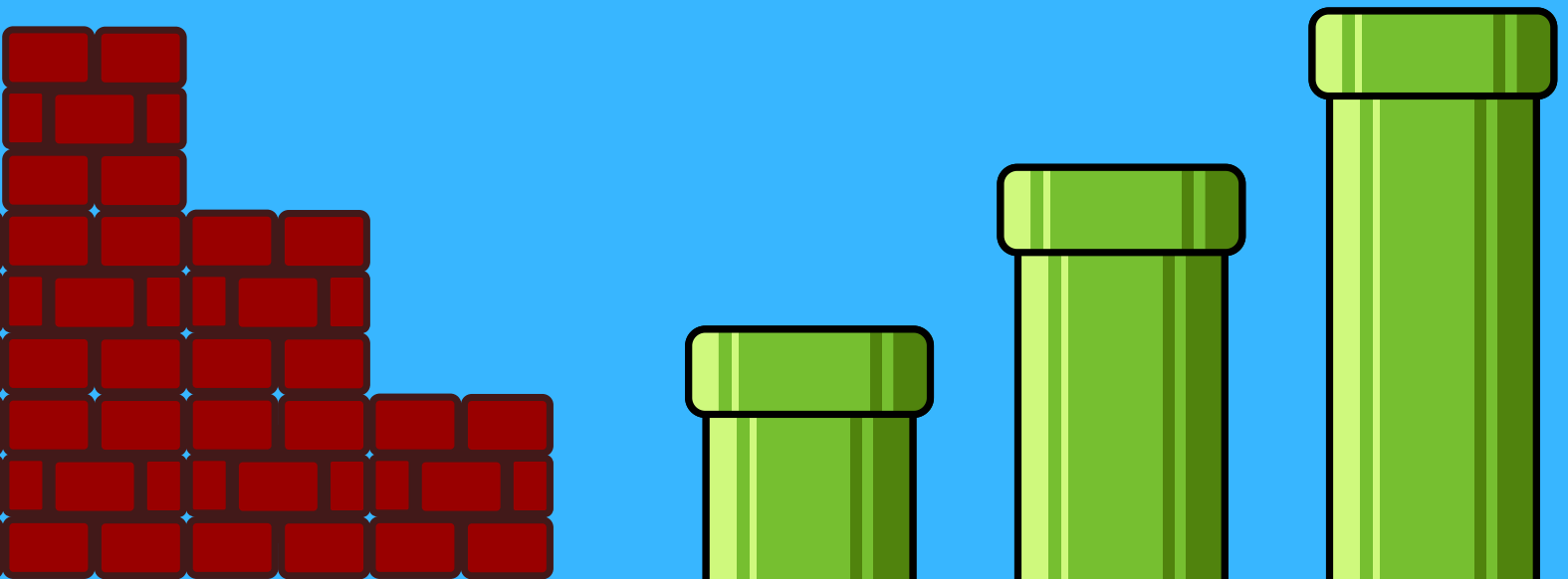
DENTON HOUSING AUTHORITY

The Denton Housing Authority was established in 1970 to address the housing needs of low-income families in the city of Denton. This agency is a vital part of our Denton community, touching lives and making a difference for so many people, including our Denton ISD students. As Chief Executive Officer, Sherri McDade and the DHS staff, along with their Board of Commissioners, are committed to helping their families beyond housing, to live fully in the community. Believing that education holds the key to students' future success after high school, the DHA Board of Commissioners, working with their builders and community developers, has committed \$60,000 for student scholarships thru the Foundation. This funding will gift 12 students with generous \$5000 scholarships to attend college, trade school or vocational training after graduation.
