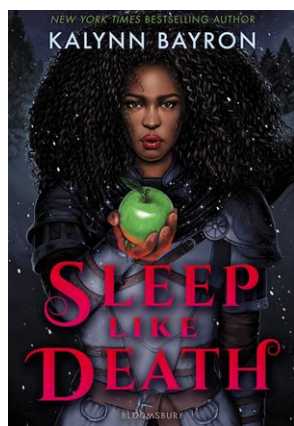

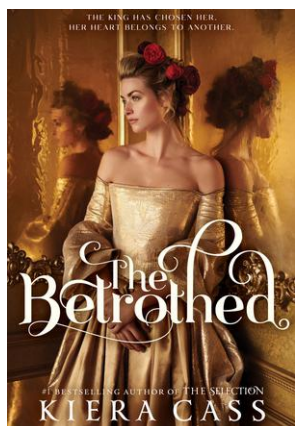
Azar, Keira

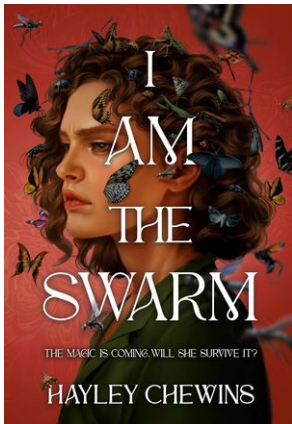
Cass, Keira

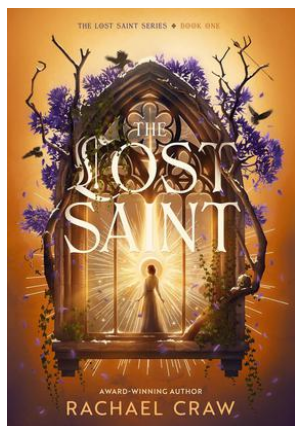
Chewins, Hayley

So Let Them Burn

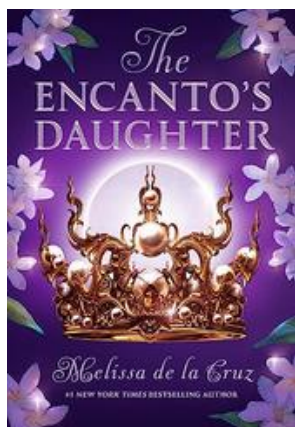

The Encanto's Daughter

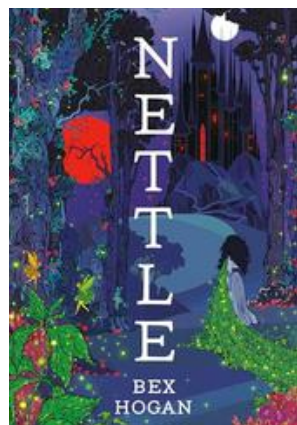

Unraveller

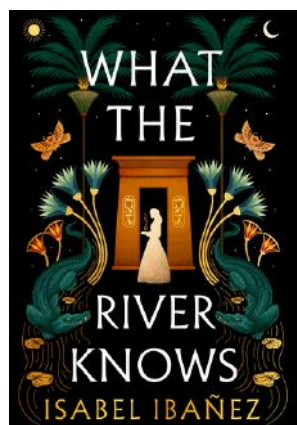

Lady's Knight

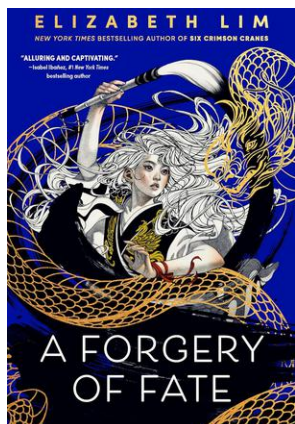

A Forgery of Fate

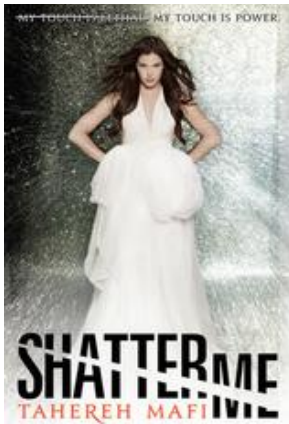

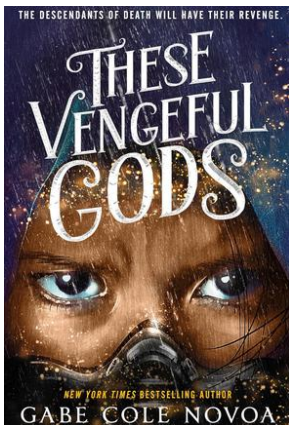
Mafi, Tahereh

The Floating World

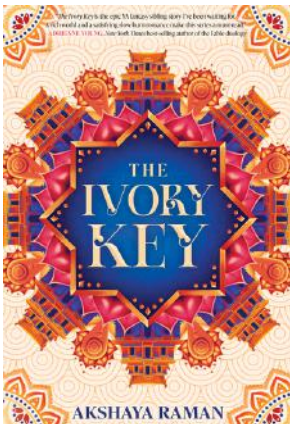

The Sun and the Star

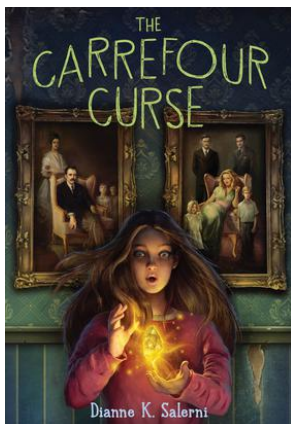

A Girl Walks Into the Forest

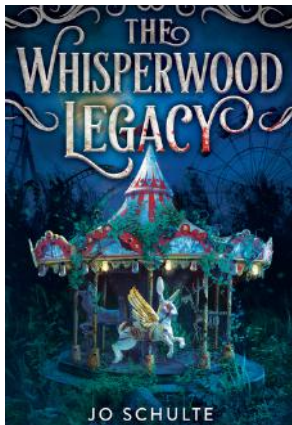

The Whisperwood Legacy

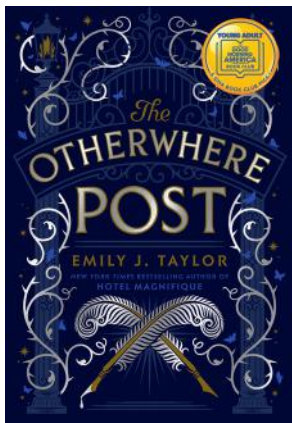

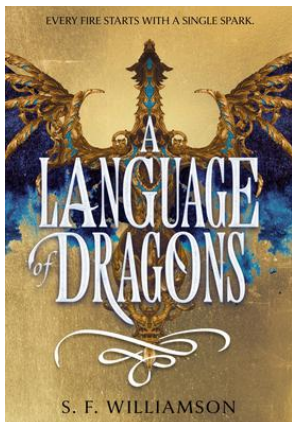
Thomson, Pari
