FROM THE BOARD ROOM **Scott Beutler**, President



Dear Members,

As we head into the fall, there is a lot of positive momentum at Inverness Golf Club. Our financial performance continues to improve significantly over last year, membership remains strong, and our latest member survey showed higher ratings across every category compared with Q3 last year. While this summer's weather has certainly presented some challenges, overall, I am pleased with the progress we continue to make.

Through July, our year-to-date operating deficit is approximately \$120,000, compared with \$263,000 at the same point last year. That is an improvement of approximately \$143,000 over last year. We are, however, approximately \$79,000 behind our year-to-date budget.

As of August 20, golf rounds were down 1,557 rounds, including 431 guest rounds. Fewer rounds mean fewer cart and guest fees, as well as less food and beverage activity. We estimate the impact at approximately \$147,000 in lost revenue and \$132,000 in lost operating income. These are estimates, but they provide some perspective on the financial impact the weather has had on Inverness Golf Club this season.

The results of our Q3 member survey were encouraging, with ratings in every category higher than in Q3 last year. The largest increases were in Events & Social, Food & Beverage Quality, Dining Experience, and Value for Dues. Professional Golf Staff, Management, the Golf Course, Communications, Racquets, and Pool also received higher ratings compared with Q3 last year.

Member comments showed areas where we can continue to improve, including menu variety and consistency, service, pace of play, and aspects of our golf and family programming. Thank you to everyone who took part and provided feedback.

It has been several years since we conducted an all-member survey, and much has changed at Inverness Golf Club, both in the member experience and in our financial performance. This fall, we will work with Club Benchmarking to conduct an updated all-member survey. The survey will focus on the member experience, what is most important to our members, and our future capital priorities. These areas are often connected, and your input will help guide our decisions as we continue to improve and invest in Inverness Golf Club.

Membership is still strong across all categories, with 351 member families, and we are pleased to welcome the Figiel family to Inverness Golf Club.

Work on the clubhouse chimneys is underway, and we are planning to complete the clubhouse roof this fall. Both projects are part of our continued effort to maintain and invest in Inverness Golf Club while preserving our financial strength.

Thank you to Charlie, our management team, and our entire staff for all their work this summer. I hope everyone enjoys the fall season at Inverness Golf Club.

September is here and that means it's aerification time. Tee aerification has already been completed. Greens and fairways will soon be underway. Be sure to note the remaining aerification schedule:

Greens	September 8-9
Fairways	beginning September 14

We know aerification can temporarily change playing conditions but the shortterm inconvenience is an important investment in the course.

Aerification relieves compaction, removes thatch, improves air and water exchange, and promotes root growth. The benefits may not always be immediately noticeable but the work we do this fall helps build a stronger, healthier playing surface for next season.

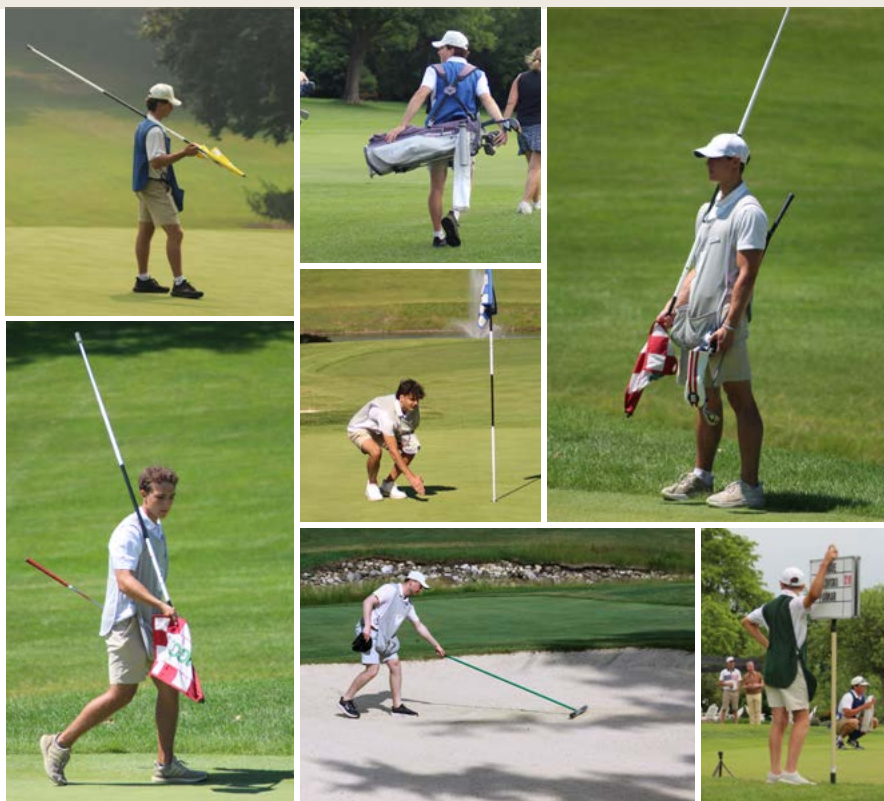
