Introduction

A Word From Tera

Friend, I want you to know — this workbook was not born in a boardroom or a perfectly quiet office. It was born in the middle of a season. A season of movement, faith, and fire. A season where God looked at me and said, *"Thirty-three days. Let's see what I can do through you."*

Over the course of this 33-day season, I am challenging youth, leading this community, walking in my calling, and building something that I believe with my whole heart honors God. Through **Hey Young World™** — my heart-space for the next generation — I am pouring into young people who are searching for identity, direction, and purpose. Through the **"What You've Learned" Challenge**, I am inviting our community to share the wisdom God has deposited in them: their testimonies, their turning points, their truth. Because when we tell what God has done, we create a roadmap for someone else still finding their way.

The number 33 has captured my spirit in this season. It is more than a number of days — it is a prophetic marker. It shows up at the most sacred intersections of Scripture: the age of Christ at His resurrection, the years of David's reign over all Israel, the very moment of Noah's covenant promise. When God places a number on your season, pay attention.

This workbook is your companion for the journey. Use it to reflect, to pray, to declare, and to document what God is doing in you and through you. You are

not walking these 33 days alone. We are walking together — as a community, as a covenant people, as *Peaceful As A Dove*.

I love you. God loves you more. Now let's go.

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Section One

What Does 33 Mean in God's Terms?

While 33 is not explicitly defined as a symbol in Scripture the way 7 represents completion or 12 represents divine government, its recurring presence at *pivotal biblical moments* speaks powerfully to the believer with eyes to see. The Spirit of God does not waste numbers any more than He wastes seasons. Here is what His Word reveals about the significance of 33 — and why it matters for your life right now.



1.1 Jesus — The Ultimate 33

The Age of Sacrifice and Completion

Jesus was approximately 33 years old when He was crucified, buried, and resurrected. His public ministry began around the age of 30 and culminated — in the most glorious act of sacrificial love and redemption the world has ever known — at age 33. Every step of those three years was intentional, anointed, and moving toward one divine destination. In God's terms, **33 represents the completion of divine purpose, sacrificial love, and resurrection power.**

Whatever God has been building in you, trust that He is moving it toward its appointed moment of completion.

"For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life."

— John 3:16 (KJV)

1.2 King David — 33 Years of Covenant Leadership

Reign, Stability & Kingdom Building

After ruling in Hebron for seven years, David was established as king over all Israel and Judah — and he reigned in Jerusalem for **33 years**. His kingship did not come easily; it came after seasons of wilderness, warfare, and waiting. Yet when God placed him in position, David reigned with a heart after God and built a kingdom that pointed toward the eternal reign of Christ. In God's terms, **33 represents covenant leadership, the establishment of God's kingdom**

on earth, and walking in your appointed purpose even after seasons of preparation and warfare.

"And he reigned over all Israel and Judah thirty and three years." — 2 Samuel 5:5 (KJV)

✍ Reflection: "In what area of your life is God establishing you as a leader right now?"



1.3 Noah — The 33rd Covenant Promise

God's Faithfulness & the Rainbow Promise

Bible scholars have observed that the 33rd time Noah's name appears in Scripture falls in Genesis 9:11–16, where God establishes His eternal covenant — sealed with the rainbow — never to destroy the earth again by flood. After the storm. After the devastation. After the long wait in the ark. After everything — God made a promise. And He sealed it with color and light in the sky. In God's terms, **33 is the number of God keeping His word, even after the worst storms of your life.**

"I establish My covenant with you: Never again will all life be cut off by the waters of a flood; never again will there be a flood to destroy the earth."

— Genesis 9:11 (NIV)

✍ *Reflection: "What covenant promise from God are you standing on right now?"*



1.4 Jacob's 33 Descendants

Growth, Legacy & Covenant Multiplication

In Genesis 46:15, we find that Jacob had **33 descendants through Leah**. From one faithful man and one faithful woman, God multiplied a covenant family into a nation. This is the mathematics of the Kingdom: one act of obedience, one season of faithfulness, one generation willing to say yes to God — and watch what He multiplies through them. In God's terms, **33 represents the legacy you are building, the seeds you are planting, and the generations your obedience in this very season will bless.**

"These are the sons of Leah...all the souls of his sons and his daughters were thirty and three."

— Genesis 46:15 (KJV)

1.5 The 33 Miracles of Jesus

Divine Power & Compassion in Action

Many Bible scholars and theologians have counted approximately **33 recorded miracles** performed by Jesus across the four Gospels — healings, deliverances, resurrections, and signs of provision. Each one was not a performance. It was a demonstration: God meeting human need with divine power through a willing, obedient vessel. Jesus saw the sick and healed. He saw the hungry and fed. He saw the dead and called them forth. In God's terms, **33 represents the miraculous — what God can still do in and through a life fully surrendered to Him.**

"Jesus of Nazareth, a man approved of God among you by miracles and wonders and signs, which God did by him in the midst of you..."

— Acts 2:22 (KJV)

 **Reflection: "What miracle are you believing God for in your life right now?"**

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Section Two

How God Is Using Your 33

The number 33 is not merely a historical footnote in Scripture — it is a prophetic marker in the lives of believers who are walking in purpose *right*

now. As Peaceful As A Dove Ministries launches the **33-Day "What You've Learned" Challenge**, we believe this season carries the fingerprints of heaven. This is a season of covenant fulfillment, divine completion, and kingdom building in our community — one testimony, one young person, one declaration at a time.

Use the timeline below to identify your focus and write your personal declaration for each week of this 33-day journey. Come back to these declarations daily. Speak them. Believe them. Watch God move.

A 5-Day Devotional Journey

Use this 5-day devotional at any point during your 33-day season to slow down, return to the Word, and stay grounded in what God is doing. These are not just readings — they are anchors. Return to them as often as you need.



Day 1 — Completion Is Coming

"...being confident of this, that He who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus."

— Philippians 1:6 (NIV)

Devotion: God does not start things He does not intend to finish. Every promise He has spoken over your life, every seed He has planted in your spirit, every gift He has placed in your hands — He is committed to bringing it to full bloom. This season of 33 days is not random. It is not coincidence. It is God completing something in you and through you that He designed before the foundation of the world. Your job is not to force it — your job is to trust it. Stay faithful. Stay present. Let Him finish what He started.

Prayer

Lord, I surrender this season to You. I confess that I have sometimes doubted whether what You started in me would ever be finished. But today I choose to believe Your Word over my circumstances. You are faithful. You are committed. Complete in me everything that glorifies You. I trust Your timeline, I trust Your process, and I trust Your hands. In

Jesus' name, Amen.

 **Reflection:** *"What good work has God started in your life that you need to trust Him to complete?"*

Day 2 — You Are Anointed to Lead

"David was thirty years old when he began to reign, and he reigned forty years. In Hebron he reigned over Judah seven years and six months: and in Jerusalem he reigned thirty and three years over all Israel and Judah."

— 2 Samuel 5:4–5 (KJV)

Devotion: David did not walk out of the field and straight onto the throne. There was a wilderness. There was Saul. There was Hebron before Jerusalem. The preparation *was* the process, and the process *was* the anointing. Like David, you may have spent years in the background — serving quietly, being faithful in small things, being tested in hidden places. But God has been shaping you all along. He is now calling you to lead — in your home, in your community, in your ministry — not because you are perfect, but because you are His.

Prayer

Father, I receive the mantle of leadership You have placed on my life. I

ask for courage where I feel timid, wisdom where I feel uncertain, and servant-heartedness in every room You place me in. Let me lead with love, with integrity, and with my eyes fixed on You. I am not leading for my glory — I am leading for Yours. Use me, God. In Jesus' name, Amen.

 **Reflection:** *"Where is God calling you to step into greater leadership?"*

Day 3 — After the Storm, the Covenant

"I have set My rainbow in the clouds, and it will be the sign of the covenant between Me and the earth."

— Genesis 9:13 (NIV)

Devotion: After every storm in your life — the seasons that nearly broke you, the nights you could not stop crying, the moments you wondered if God was even there — He placed a rainbow. Not as decoration. As a covenant. A declaration that He is still God, He still keeps His word, and you are still covered. You are not forgotten. You have not been abandoned. The same God who made a promise to Noah in the middle of the wreckage of the old world is making promises over your life right now. The storm did not have the last word — His covenant does.

 **Prayer**

God, I thank You for every storm You brought me through. I know now that the rain was not punishment — it was preparation. And the rainbow was not just beautiful — it was Your voice reminding me of who You are. I declare today that I trust You with every storm that is still ahead. Your covenant is my covering. Thank You, Father. In Jesus' name, Amen.

✍️ Reflection: "What storm has God brought you through that proved His faithfulness?"

Day 4 — Your Obedience Multiplies

"These are the sons of Leah, which she bare unto Jacob...all the souls of his sons and his daughters were thirty and three."

— Genesis 46:15 (KJV, paraphrased)

Devotion: Jacob could not have known that his faithfulness would produce 33 souls — an entire lineage carrying the covenant of God forward through the centuries. Your faithfulness in this season is not just for you. It is seed for a generation that has not yet been born. The youth you reach through Hey Young World™, the community you build, the declarations you make, the seeds of wisdom you plant through the "What You've Learned" Challenge — all of it is multiplied in God's economy far beyond what your eyes can see. Be faithful in this moment. The multiplication is already in motion.

Prayer

Lord, let my obedience in this season be a seed that blesses generations I will never meet. I plant what I have — my time, my gifts, my heart, my yes — and I trust You to multiply it beyond anything I could imagine. Let the young people I pour into carry Your light forward. Let the community I build outlast my efforts. Let my name be forgotten, if need be — but let Your Kingdom be advanced. In Jesus' name, Amen.

 **Reflection:** *"What seeds are you planting right now that will bless future generations?"*

Day 5 — Believe for the Miracle

"Jesus of Nazareth, a man approved of God among you by miracles and wonders and signs, which God did by him in the midst of you, as ye yourselves also know."

— Acts 2:22 (KJV)

Devotion: You serve the God of 33 miracles recorded in the Gospels alone — and that is just what the writers could fit on a page. John himself said the world could not contain the books that could be written about what Jesus did (John 21:25). That same Jesus is alive. That same power is available. Whatever you are believing God for in this season — for your ministry, for your family, for the youth in your community, for your finances, for your healing — He is still in the miracle-working business. Stop apologizing for your big faith. Bring your need, bring your scripture, and bring your expectation.

Prayer

God of miracles, I come before You with bold faith. I will not shrink back from asking You for the impossible, because I know that nothing is impossible with You. I bring You my specific need — the miracle I have been carrying in my heart — and I lay it at Your feet with full expectation. You are the God who still moves. You are the God who still heals, still provides, still makes ways in the wilderness. I believe. Help my unbelief. In the mighty name of Jesus, Amen.

 **Reflection:** *"Write out your miracle request and the scripture you are standing on:"*

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Section Four

My 33-Day Declaration

This declaration is your covenant with yourself and your God for this season. **Speak it aloud — every single day** of your 33-day journey. Speak it when you feel strong. Speak it especially when you do not. The Word of God in your mouth is a weapon, a compass, and a promise.



I declare that this is a season of completion, covenant, and divine purpose. Like Jesus, I walk in sacrificial love and resurrection power. Like David, I lead with faithfulness and strength. Like Noah, I trust in God's promises through every storm. Like Jacob's descendants, my obedience will multiply into generations.

I believe for miracles. I am walking out my 33 days with intentionality, faith, and fire.

I will let my light shine before others. I will not shrink back. I will not minimize my calling or apologize for the gift God placed inside of me. I

am called. I am equipped. I am anointed for this moment.

I am *Peaceful As A Dove* — and I go in peace to change the world for God's glory.
