the Concert:

Studio C's annual end of year concert is the culmination of a year's worth of hard work from the students, teachers, and larger dance community, showcased in a performance for our family and friends to see! A celebration of dance, music, and performing arts, the concert is a highlight in everyone's dance calendar and a memory that is treasured for many years to come.

Whilst Studio C is a growing dance school in a small town, we have ALWAYS taken great pride in being able to provide our dancers with the same calibre of performance opportunities as any other established dance school. Since moving to a full-sized theatre in 2022, we are incredibly proud to have now performed to multiple audiences of over 500+ people and celebrated a milestone sold out performance in 2025!



Act 2 students 2025

Our performance will be presented in two Acts with a 20-minute interval. Each student will be showcased on stage along with their class, in full costume with professional lighting, to perform their class routine/s and a big finale dance at the end of their Act. Students only performing in Act 1 will then be collected from the foyer and LOVE watching their friends perform as they experience the magic from the audience during Act 2. It's incredibly encouraging and rewarding for Act 2 performers to then also experience a full/supportive audience when it's their turn to shine!

This year both Acts of our performance will feature all of Studio C's classes and students as they interpret the studio-wide theme - 'ICONIC'! From the youngest Tinies students to our adults in Senior classes, we cannot wait to explore Iconic Artists & Iconic Songs throughout music history!

Attendance is strongly recommended and encouraged for all Mini - Senior students, however this is **a required rehearsal day for students in two or more routines (and ALL Middle Jazz students for their combined routine!)**.

PLEASE NOTE: No Tiny Tumblers or Tiny Tiptoes classes will be rehearsing on this day and do not need to attend. Tinies students are most welcome to come along and watch the rehearsal but **MUST** please be supervised by a parent/guardian.

WHAT TO BRING:

- Correct Dance Shoes per class
- Snacks (Lunch if staying all day)
- Water Bottle

WHAT TO WEAR:

- Studio C Uniform
- Hair Tied Back & Neat

Great chance to practise Concert hair!

WHY WE'RE EXCITED FOR A HALL REHEARSAL

With only one practice in the actual theatre and a limited timeslot for each group to rehearse, this Hall Rehearsal provides some amazing opportunities for:

- Practising in a larger space! The theatre's stage is HUGE, so this is a great stepping stone to get used to this and adapt routines to a larger area.
- Understanding the flow of the show and which order the routines are performed in. For those in multiple dances (and anyone with quick costume changes!) this helps gauge how much time they have between routines.
- Watching each other and enjoying the show! Many students won't get to watch the performance in its entirety on the day, so this is a wonderful moment to inspire and encourage each other.
- Learning the Finale routines! These are whole-studio dances during their bows that may be practised separately in class time but are SUPER helpful to run altogether.

the Dress Rehearsal:

WHAT IS A DRESS REHEARSAL?

It's a rehearsal that replicates the atmosphere of the show as closely as possible, so those performing can get a feel for what it will be like on the day. These usually take place at the show's venue with costumes and makeup, and class groups will rehearse in the order that the show will run. It is imperative that those performing attend any dress rehearsal a show may require, making the actual performance less intimidating and stressful for all involved.

Unlike other studios, we only have **ONE DRESS REHEARSAL** so please ensure your child is present. If they are performing, attendance is crucial and therefore not optional. For students new to performing or using a professional theatre, the stage and backstage areas will be a new environment to get used to. In particular, the entry and exit points to the stage can be disorienting and need to be correctly identified and adequately rehearsed prior to performing- especially for routines that require students to leave the stage multiple times. Even if your dancer has performed in this theatre previously, each show and routine will bring different safety aspects to be aware of so dress rehearsals will always be a top priority for attendance.

WHAT HAPPENS IF MY DANCER IS UNABLE TO ATTEND THE DRESS REHEARSAL?

For the performance to run smoothly and for the safety of everyone involved, your dancer unfortunately won't be able to perform in the concert if they are unable to attend the Dress Rehearsal.

Missing the rehearsal also has a huge effect on their class group as a whole, which is why it's so important to show up for your 'team'. Creating a flow-on effect not often fully realized by those without prior on or offstage experience, missing the Dress Rehearsal can have serious repercussions that affect SO many different people and aspects of the entire performance.

We therefore ask that families of performers place both the Dress Rehearsal and performance dates at a high level of importance in their calendars, diaries, planners, phones, and brain space to allow this to go as smoothly as possible for ALL involved.

8 -12 months of hard work culminate into one weekend for our dancers and teachers, so we truly hope that everyone can understand the importance of prioritising attendance at the Dress Rehearsal.

If for whatever reason your dancer is unexpectedly unable to attend the Dress Rehearsal (illness/injury etc) please let us know as soon as possible.

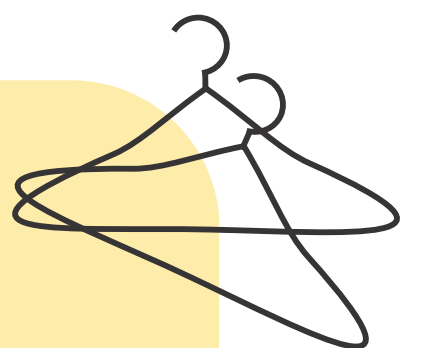
WHAT HAPPENS AT THE DRESS REHEARSAL?

Students are required at **FOUNDERS THEATRE IN MOUNT HELEN**, as per the Dress Rehearsal schedule. Arrival must please be prompt to help the day run smoothly, Act 1 students are welcome to arrive 5-10mins early (Doors open from 9am). *Full schedule details - page 6 & 7.*

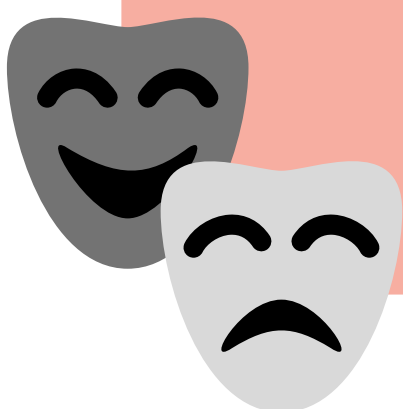


All students, parent helpers and backstage crew must sign-in upon arrival and head straight to their dressing rooms (listed as you sign-in).

Each student will then have at least 25mins to change into their first costume, stretch, warm up and rehearse before they are required on stage. **Hair and Makeup must please be done prior to arrival!**



Each routine in the show has been allocated 5-15 minutes of rehearsal time on the stage. ALL students are required to also rehearse either the Act 1 or Act 2 Finale (bows with the entire studio). *Please see full schedule for details - page 6 & 7.*



Once their costumes are put back on their hangers/tubs/bags, students may sign-out and go home! If your student does multiple classes, they will then get into their next costume and do it all again!

WHAT HAPPENS AT THE PERFORMANCE?



Unlike the dress rehearsal, ALL STUDENTS are required to arrive at **FOUNDERS THEATRE IN MOUNT HELEN** strictly between **11:45am - 12:30pm**. Your arrival time please be prompt to help eliminate any unnecessary pre-show stress your student may be feeling.

This will allow an hour for students to get ready (again, hair & makeup must please be done prior to arrival) before the show starts at 1:30PM.



During this time, all students will participate in a full studio warm up and stretch, getting them in the right headspace before the concert. Teachers will also use this time for last minute reminders/practices.

After dropping your students off, we encourage you to take the remaining time before the show to go and enjoy lunch/a coffee/run errands in Ballarat or surrounding areas, as we won't be ready to open our foyer and auditorium to the audience just yet!



The doors to the theatre will be open to the audience from 1:15pm, giving everyone 15 minutes to arrive, buy a keepsake program and find their seats. We cannot wait to hear you cheering for our dancers and hope you enjoy the performance! At the end of the show, please wait in the foyer to collect your child/ren, and don't forget to sign them out!

for the Parents:

Our highly experienced team are organising and planning the performance weekend very particularly to ensure everyone has enough time to rehearse and feel confident about their performance - this also includes organising everyone backstage doing all the behind-the-scenes work. Please keep in mind that an event like this has MANY layers and is very much a team effort. With over 170 performers and 38 dances/items, patience, manners, and positive attitudes really do make the world of difference during this busy weekend!



Whilst we always try our hardest to stick to the schedule, please be mindful that the dress rehearsal may run late. This could be due to any number of unpredictable reasons, which is why we really need everyone to do their part and arrive on time, ready to go (each year has been an improvement on the one prior, thanks to everyone's combined efforts - go team!)

Completing hair and makeup before arriving at the venue is essential as we unfortunately cannot allow adults backstage unless they are previously organised volunteers (*details on page 20*). Our Team will be busy running the rehearsal and backstage parent helpers may not have time either, so dropping your dancer/s off and hoping someone else can do it is not an option! Tutorial videos can be found pinned on our private Facebook group or posted on our website's Parent Portal and we strongly encourage doing practise runs with your students at home to avoid any extra stress on the day. (*Please refer to Hair and Makeup Requirements on pages 14 - 18*).

Concerts and performing will be a new thing for many of our families and it IS a big deal, especially as Studio C takes pride on the standard of show we produce.

If you have any questions, PLEASE ask us now!

It's totally normal for parents and guardians to feel nervous or a bit overwhelmed about the concert too. Let's all work together to minimise stress where we can by **being prepared ahead of time, communicating, and staying positive** to best support our students!

We promise there is no such thing as a stupid question, and you can bet we've heard it all before! HOWEVER,

We've put a lot of time and care into the information sent to families explaining the concert and all its finer details. Please ensure you're taking the time to read through it all... it's there for your benefit and will answer hopefully all the questions you may have! *(If you've made it this far through the information, we are extremely grateful!)*

If you are still unsure of something on the day, please check the signs we will have in the theatre or ask a parent helper - teachers will be very busy on the day and may not know specific details for your child off the top of their head, so it would be wonderful if the time is taken to check your received info first just in case.

If this ISN'T your first concert with us, this is a fantastic opportunity to help newer parents through the process. If this IS your first concert, please don't hesitate to ask for help. Post on our 'Studio C Members' Facebook group and let our community help provide answers and reassurance. Don't forget to chat to your dancer about the concert also, you may be surprised at how much they know about the process already!

Unsure how your little one will go on the day?

You're more than welcome to stay throughout the weekend to help them feel extra supported and oftentimes this helps reassure the parents too! Come on board as a Superstar and get an all-access pass backstage, plus FREE or discounted prime seating for the performance (details on pages 20 & 21).

All performance tights should be clean and run/hole/ladder free! If you're purchasing a new pair for the concert, please triple check you're getting the correct colour for our studio (as above).

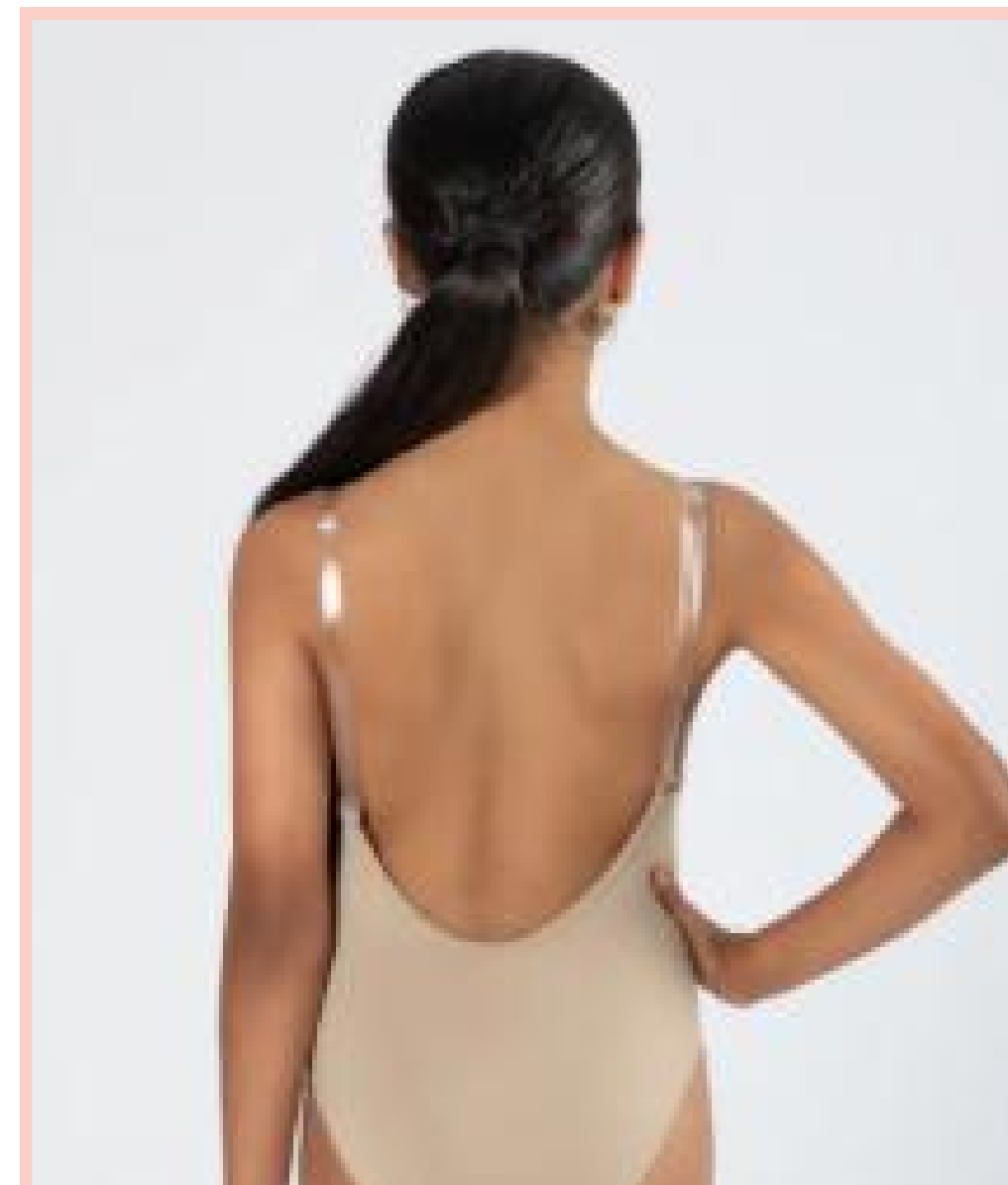
Regular (footed) vs Convertible tights: Regular tights are standard, footed tights and are perfect for dancers in one dance or if they have plenty of time to change costume. Convertible tights are designed with a hole in the foot for dancers to quickly stretch them over their feet, allowing them to dance with bare feet whilst still having tights on (typically necessary for Acrobatics and Contemporary styles). Students in multiple classes may benefit from convertible tights to assist in costume changes etc. please discuss with your teacher to determine whether this is an option for you!

PERFORMANCE UNDERGARMENTS:

Please make sure that only **skin toned** underwear is worn so it will not be visible under costumes.

We encourage girls of all ages to wear a **dance body stocking** for modesty/privacy and ease of changing when in multiple classes. These are skin toned leotards designed with a lower back and straps that provide a seamless look underneath costumes.

All crop-top or bra straps must be skin toned or clear, and we encourage relevant students to invest in a specific dance bra that will be flattering/invisible underneath costumes.

PLEASE NOTE: Stores like Kmart & Big W advertise their dance attire to be 'dance school approved' but are not actually in line with most uniform policies in Australia. These items are the wrong colours, style, poor quality, and are quite unflattering; **students wearing incorrect tights at the Theatre may be allocated a correct pair that will be charged to your account.**

All costumes will be tried on and fitted throughout Terms 3 & 4, with enough time left to make any alterations. They'll then be transported to the theatre, ready to be worn at the dress rehearsal. Costumes can be incredibly difficult to clean so we have three important reminders for all parent/guardians and performers:

PLEASE DO NOT TAKE COSTUMES HOME unless asked specifically to do so by a **teacher** for quick repairs/washing etc. (If you are able to help with costumes should we need it, please let us know!)

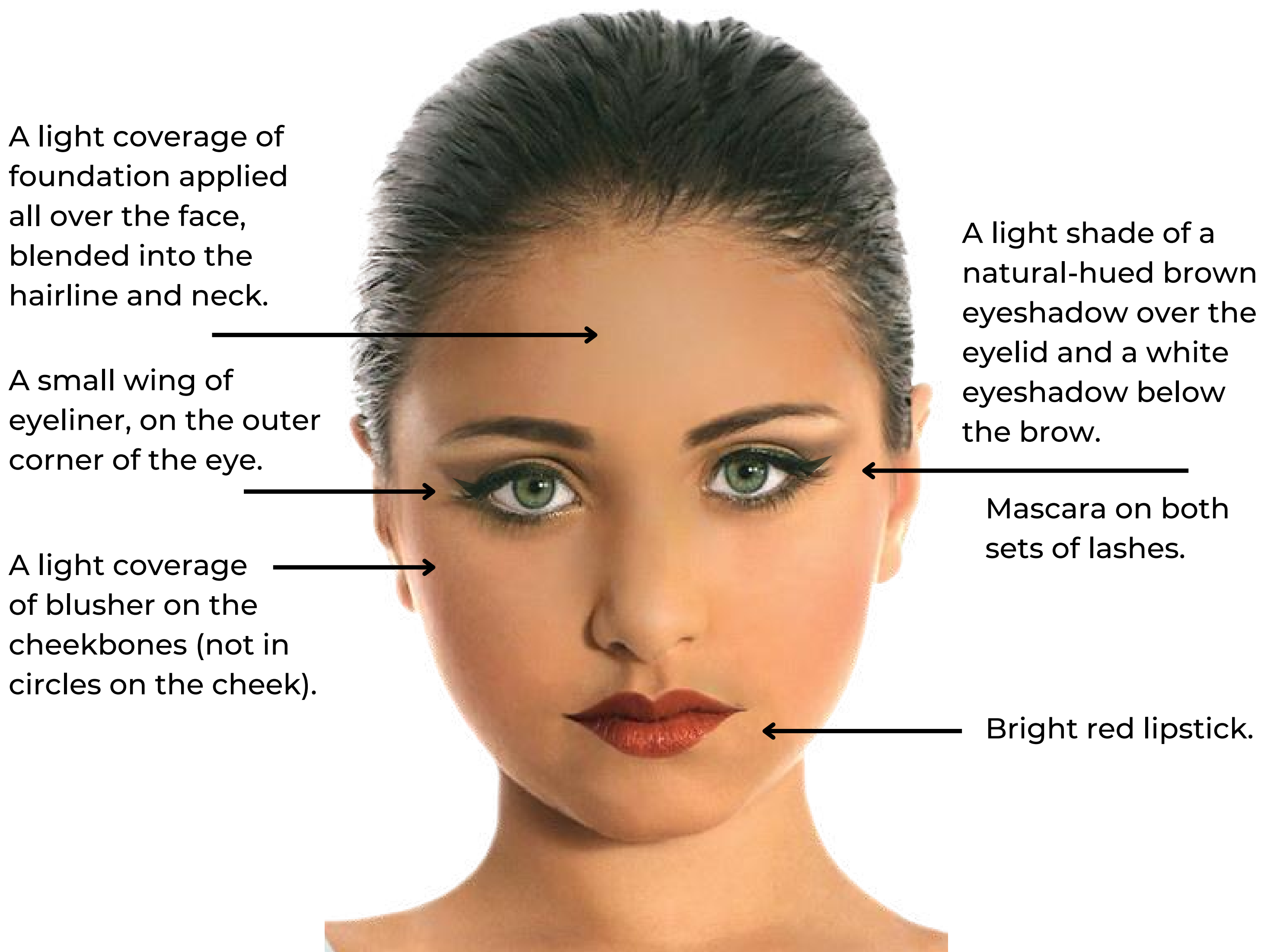
PLEASE DO NOT EAT FOOD WHILST IN YOUR COSTUME! Bringing a towel/art smock/dressing gown to avoid any mess is a great idea. Clean snacks are also a really good idea... for example, maybe an apple rather than Twisties! **STRICTLY NO NUTS PLEASE!**

PLEASE LEAVE LIPSTICK APPLICATION FOR THE THEATRE! Particularly for younger students, this may be left for Superstar Helpers to apply closer to stage time.

Makeup Requirements:

ALL performers ARE REQUIRED to wear makeup on stage, otherwise the stage lights will make their faces impossible for the audience to see! From the audience, professionally lit performers look extremely washed out or blurred, so we add makeup to bring definition back to their faces and make them recognisable again.

WHAT YOU NEED AND HOW TO APPLY:



A light coverage of foundation applied all over the face, blended into the hairline and neck.

A small wing of eyeliner, on the outer corner of the eye.

A light coverage of blusher on the cheekbones (not in circles on the cheek).

A light shade of a natural-hued brown eyeshadow over the eyelid and a white eyeshadow below the brow.

Mascara on both sets of lashes.

Bright red lipstick.

ALL BOYS:

- A light coverage of foundation applied all over the face, blended into the hairline and neck.
- A light shade of a natural-hued brown eyeshadow over the eyelid and a white eyeshadow below the brow.
- A light coverage of a natural-hued eyeshadow over the cheekbones.
- Mascara.
- A natural-hued lipstick, lightly applied.

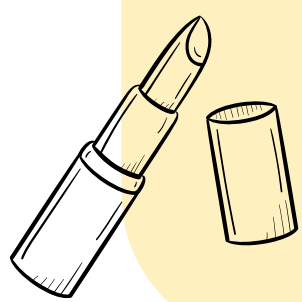
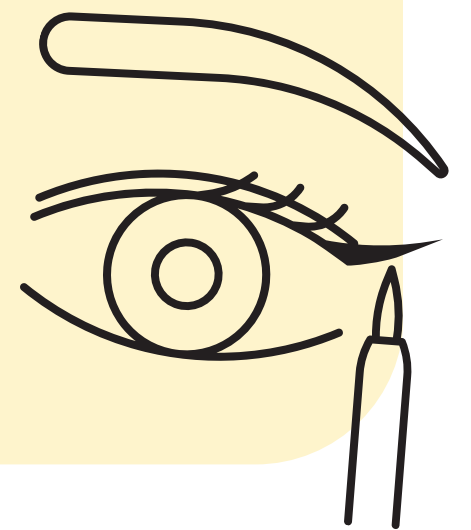
Helpful Tips and FAQ's

We get it. Stage makeup application can seem daunting, especially if you're not one to wear makeup yourself, so we've compiled a list of helpful tips and tricks to get you through! Plus, we've provided our own tutorial AND YouTube has SO many to help you... YOU'VE GOT THIS!!



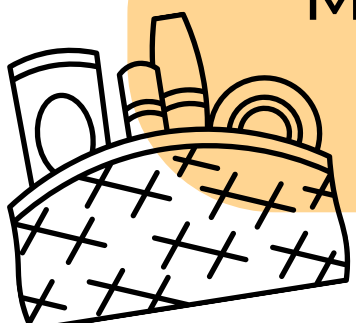
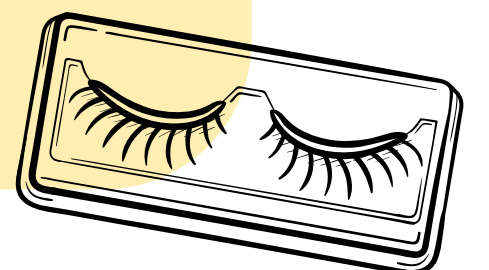
New to eyeshadow? Holding the brush handle closer to the applicator gives you more precision and pressure, meaning more intense colour! Try holding the brush handle further away from its applicator to achieve a lighter coverage and build on more product as necessary!

Panicking over eyeliner? FEAR NOT! We've specifically only asked for a small wing to achieve definition rather than fully lining the eyelid. Use pencil, gel, or liquid liner to draw a 1cm line on an angle from the outer corner of the top lash line. Use the tail of the eyebrow as a guide for the angle!



Can't I just use pink lipstick? Nope! Standard performance makeup is red and it's far easier to all appear in unison than navigating a thousand different shades of pink. It's a great idea to apply ALL other makeup before arriving and leave the lipstick until after the costume is on at the theatre.

Does my child require False Eyelashes? Parents/Guardians may decide this at their own discretion; however, we recommend these for dancers 10yrs+



Makeup products cannot be shared between students for hygiene & safety. Please bring all products to the theatre for touch ups and any fixes!

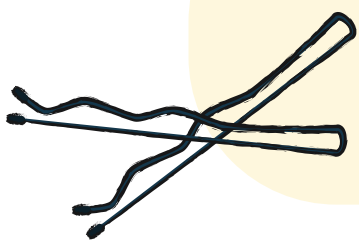
Hair Requirements:

Performance-ready Hair (& Makeup!) are required for both the Dress Rehearsal and Show days. Keep an eye out for video tutorials and demonstration days on 'Studio C Ballan Members'. If you are still in need of assistance, please ask your child's teacher as soon as possible to help avoid stress in the weeks prior! Example pictures on page 18.

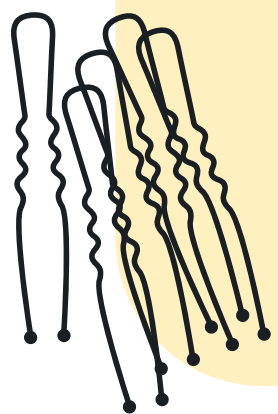
Helpful Tips and FAQ's



Please ensure all visible hair products are the same colour as the hair!
Hair ties, bobby pins, bun pins AND nets should all appear invisible.

Dancer's hair too short or have a fringe? No need to panic!

To achieve a slick style with short hair OR to hide a fringe, a comb and hair gel are your new best friends! Practise the styles during the term to get the hang of it and if you're still struggling, chat to one of our teachers!

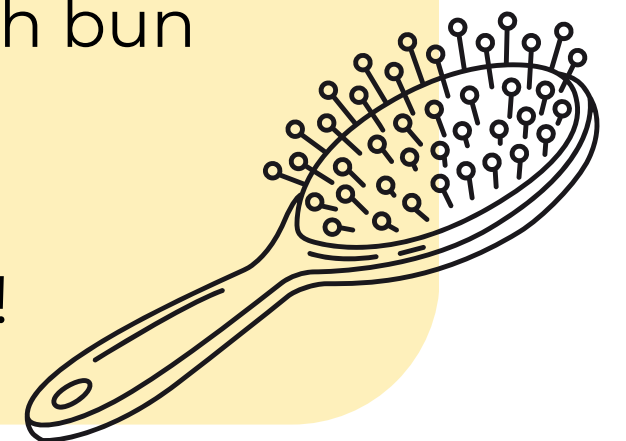


If you're struggling to do a bun, check you're using the right pins!

BUN PINS (also known as French pins) are a necessity for a correct, neat and pain free bun. Nearly ALL students will require bun pins this year - watch our tutorials and search YouTube if you're unsure of how to best use them!

My dancer is in multiple classes and has different hair styles listed. Help!

Any major changes will happen during interval as some dancers switch bun styles. Faster changes are typically only in and out of a bun to/from a ponytail. All changes will be done by either our backstage crew or our Superstar Parent Helpers - we would greatly appreciate help with this!



Can I do my dancer's hair and makeup at the theatre?

Unless you can volunteer to be a Superstar Parent Helper, parents or guardians are NOT permitted backstage, which is why we are asking dancers to please arrive as performance-ready as possible.

Please don't wait until the last minute to purchase new tights, shoes, hair products or makeup! Be prepared, practise getting your dancer ready, try and enjoy the process and help relieve stress on the day.

The concert weekend is simply not possible without enough adult supervision for the number of students we have, so we are on the hunt for a team of Superstars to help backstage throughout the weekend - It's easier than you'd think and a tonne of fun!

- Enjoy front row seats at the Dress Rehearsal!
- FREE reserved, prime seating for your child/s performance items
OR the opportunity to stand in the wings
and watch your child perform RIGHT THERE!
- A unique experience to share with your child,
creating memories for a lifetime!
- Endless photo opportunities of your child backstage!

WHAT DOES BEING A STUDIO C SUPERSTAR MEAN?

The main task is watching over an allocated group of around 10 - 12 students, who will spend most of their time watching the show on the projector backstage! We try and allocate at least 2 Superstars per group to help share the load, but the more the merrier! You don't need any previous experience, and we'll equip you with anything and everything you may need, but you're there to encourage the dancers, answer any basic questions they may have, facilitate bathroom trips and help them into their costumes (which we'll provide full instructions for).

Our aim is to hold a meeting to prep our team of Superstars ahead of time and answer any questions they may have so everyone feels prepared ahead of the performance weekend. **PLEASE NOTE:** All Studio C Superstars must have a valid Working with Children's Check. These are super easy and FREE to apply for as a volunteer!

Sound like something you could help with? Let us know your availability across the weekend! We're hoping to have enough volunteers to be able to offer tag-teaming on either day, so it truly is a team effort.

Supervising children not quite your speed? We're also looking for volunteers to help usher audience members and run the kiosk if this is more your calling.

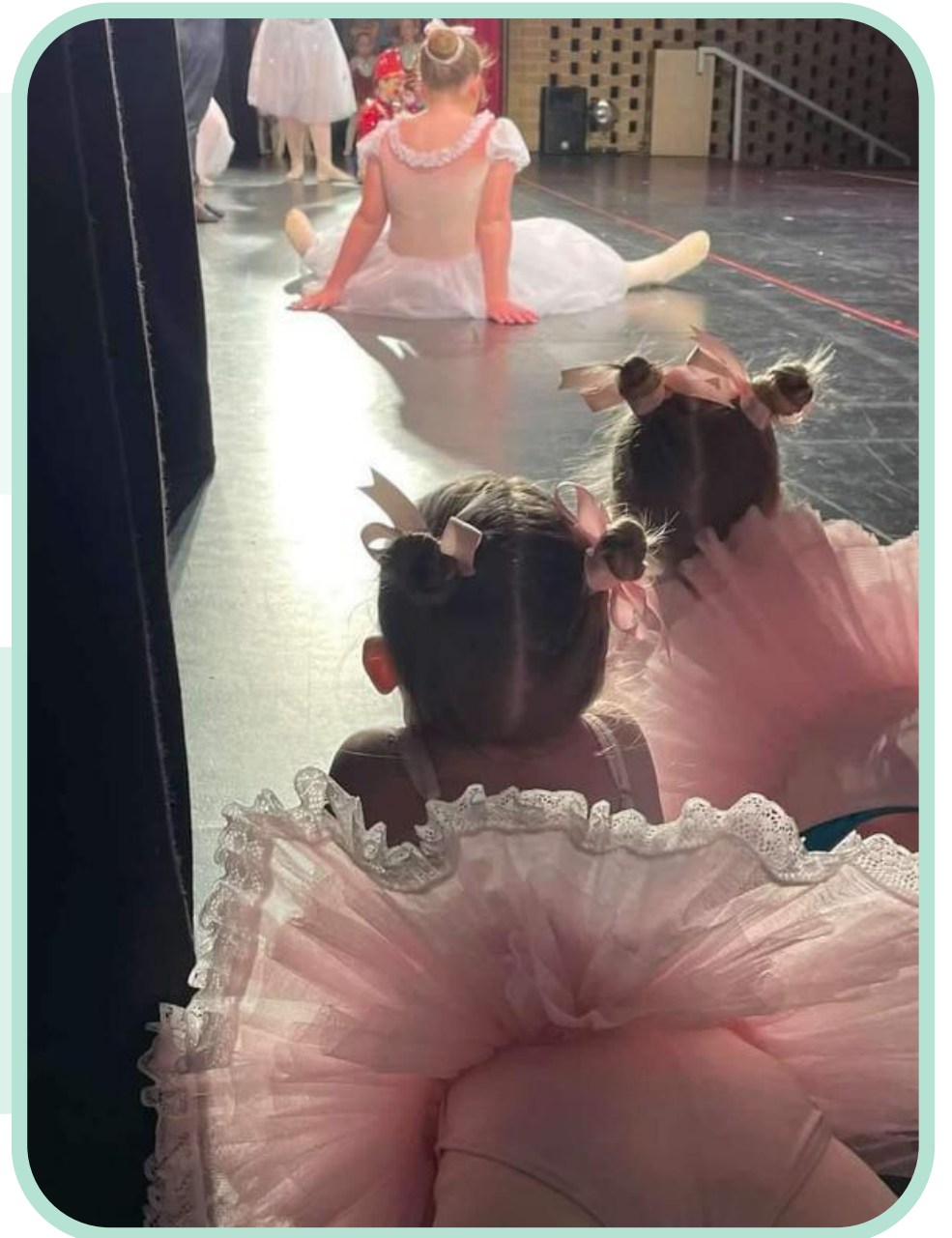

AT THE DRESS REHEARSAL:

Superstars only need to arrive 5 - 10 mins before their group are scheduled to at the dress rehearsal and can leave as soon as their group is done!

Most kids know how to get in and out of their costumes anyway, so we just need extra eyes on them to ensure their safety while our teachers run the rehearsal as a whole.



While waiting for their turn, class groups and Superstars may quietly watch the rehearsals happen on stage from the audience. When it's your group's turn, you're more than welcome to join us side stage to get close to the action!

AT THE PERFORMANCE:



Superstars won't need to purchase a ticket, as we will reserve front row balcony seating for you to watch your child on stage from the audience, or you're more than welcome to stand side stage and watch from the centre of all the magic!

If your class group is **only in Act 1**, we will provide a code for a discounted ticket to watch Act 2 from the audience! If your class group is **in Act 2**, we will need help to watch over them throughout the performance, so it's a great idea to buddy up and tag-team!

Tickets will be available to purchase online from Sunday the 1st of November via the QR code below or through the TryBooking website (search 'Studio C Performing Arts 2026 Concert'). Last year we were very lucky to perform to a sell-out audience so be sure to book quickly to avoid disappointment! If you absolutely cannot stay to watch both Acts, please keep this in mind when choosing seats. *Ticket sales will be open to the public one month in advance; all ticket sales are final, please read the IMPORTANT TICKETING INFO on page 23 prior to purchasing.*

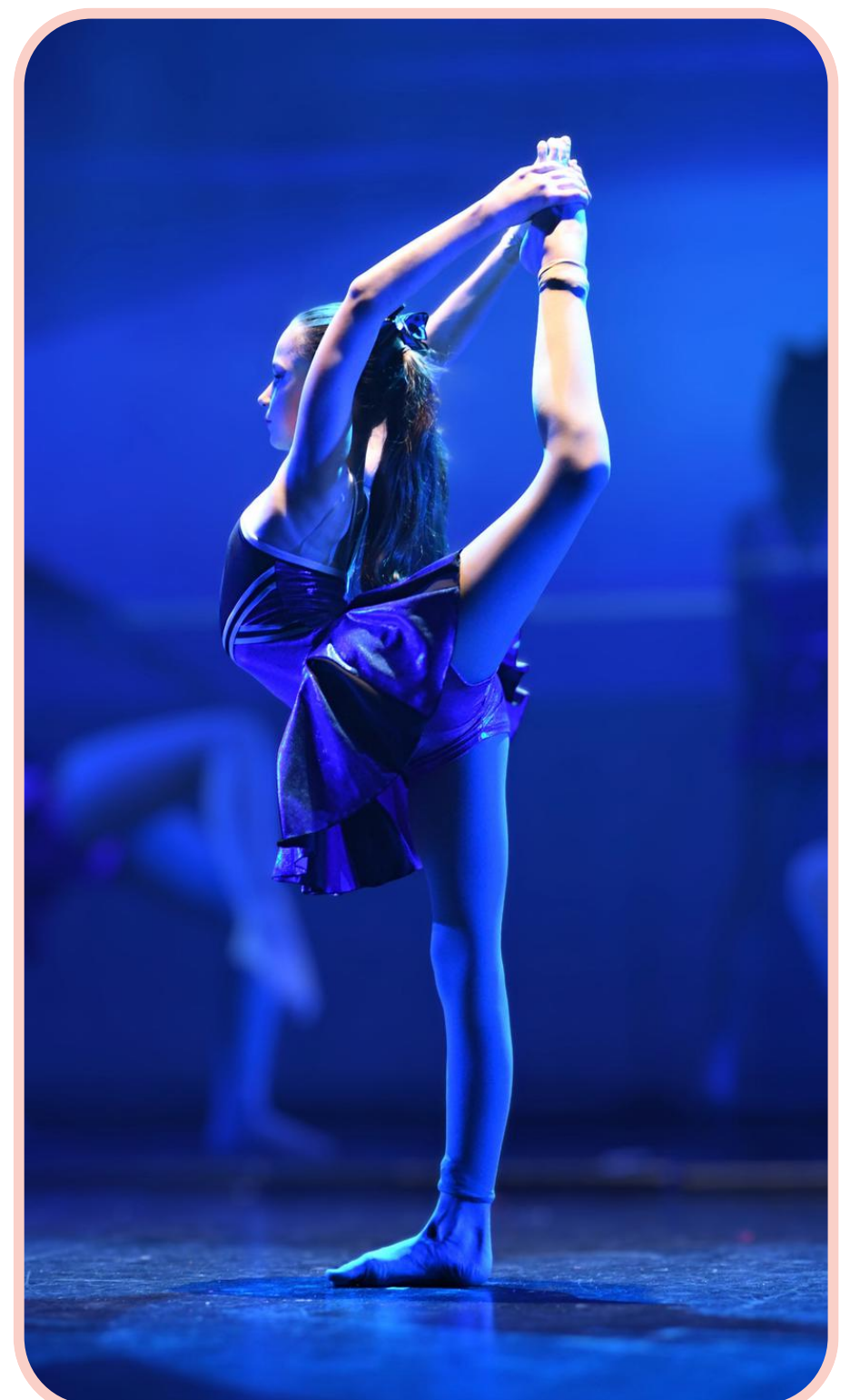
PROFESSIONAL PHOTOGRAPHY & VIDEO RECORDING:

Our professionally filmed performance DVDs are keepsakes for life that your dancers will re-watch for years to come! These will be available for pre-order ONLY during Term 4 and will hopefully be available by December. *Keep an eye out for updates!*

Professional photography of our performers will be taken DURING the Dress Rehearsal with our dancers on stage in full costume, hair, and makeup. (This is part of the reason why we stress appearance for **just** a rehearsal!) We cannot guarantee every dancer will be photographed but are hosting a specific Photo-Day for those specifically wanting to pay for photos of their dancer in costume. Stay tuned for these details early Term 4!

STRICTLY NO AUDIENCE PHOTOS/VIDEOS DURING THE PERFORMANCE.

Same as the Movie Theatre, this is standard Theatre etiquette. *Please respect our performers and those around you; it's incredibly distracting and can be seen from both on and off stage.*



IMPORTANT TICKETING INFO:

IF YOUR STUDENT IS ONLY IN ACT 1, we are strongly encouraging you to stay and watch what will be a truly fantastic Act 2! Students across the entire show have been working incredibly hard on their routines and deserve the same number of audience members and support for when they perform.

If you absolutely must leave at interval, please take this into consideration when purchasing your tickets as we are likely to sell out the theatre again this year and would hate for there to be empty seats for half of the show.

TO WATCH FROM THE AUDIENCE IN ACT 2 a discounted ticket will be available to secure your student's seat for when they are collected during the performance's interval. All students must be collected from outside the Green Room by an adult and must please be signed out so we know they are safe! *Signs will be up to direct you for student collections points; all Tinies students will have a separate area for this. Belongings may stay neatly backstage until the end of the show however if you can put anything you don't need in your car at interval, that would be a massive help and would eliminate the need to try and find everything afterwards!*

IF YOU'RE A STUDIO C SUPERSTAR, please be extra careful to check which Act your allocated group is performing in before you purchase yourself a ticket. Superstars helping groups in Act 2 will be required to stay backstage during the entire show and won't need a ticket for their reserved seating to watch their group's routine; Superstars helping groups in Act 1 will be given a code for a discounted ticket price to watch from the audience from Act 2. *Details will be sent to Superstars upon enquiry!*

ALL STUDENTS IN ACT 2 ONLY MUST STAY BACKSTAGE FOR THE ENTIRE PERFORMANCE. DO NOT PURCHASE THEM A TICKET!

This is a non-negotiable standard performance practise for safety and to ensure the performance runs as smoothly as possible.

Students may use Act 1 to continue getting ready, stretching, and quietly practising however ALL STUDENTS MUST ARRIVE BY 12:30PM.

FAQ's:

A list of the questions we hear a million times during concert season, answered here to help save time and for you to refer to throughout the coming months! Teacher's will still answer if asked these questions anyway, but we might just point you back to this Concert Handbook first:

HOW LONG WILL THE PERFORMANCE GO FOR?

Our current estimate is that the performance will run for around 2 and a half hours, including the 20-minute interval. We always try our best to produce a well-oiled show, though many different factors can slightly change the outcome so please keep this in mind. Finding audience seats quickly upon arrival and during intermission greatly helps to keep start-times on track!

HOW DO I CONTACT THE STUDIO C TEAM DURING PERFORMANCE WEEKEND?

Send us a message through our Facebook page for quick updates or info to be shared with our teachers! *We may not have a chance to respond but appreciate messages coming through.* Our Studio emails will be checked periodically outside of rehearsal/performance times, but ALL questions are best asked BEFORE the weekend.

WHAT TIME IS MY CHILD NEEDED AND WHEN WILL THEY BE DONE?

Double and triple check our Dress Rehearsal and performance schedules on pages 6, 7 & 9 and put the details in your phone for quick reference or - *even better* - screenshot the emailed version of the schedules! Printed copies will also be on the walls at the theatre so unless we're running late and you're looking for an update, you're much better off checking these for the times you're after. *Our teachers don't know your dancer's specific schedule off the top of their head and may be just as fast as you at finding the answer!*

WHAT IS THE EARLIEST TIME WE CAN ARRIVE?

At the dress rehearsal, the earliest time any student or Superstar Parent Helper can arrive is 9:00am. At the performance, the earliest time any student or Superstar Parent Helper can arrive is 11:45am. Times listed on the schedules for both days are LATEST arrival times. *Please take travel time into account!*

HOW WILL I KNOW IF MY CHILD IS READY TO BE COLLECTED?

Once your child is finished at the dress rehearsal, their dressing room's allocated Superstar Parent Helper will escort them to the foyer and wait with them until they're collected. *A parent/guardian must be sighted by one of our team before your child will be allowed to leave the building and must be signed out for safety.*

WHAT SHOULD I DO IF I'M RUNNING LATE TO GET TO THE THEATRE?

Whether you're running late to arrive with your child or running late to pick them up, we would greatly appreciate a quick message to our Facebook Page. We may not respond but knowing your whereabouts and not having to chase anyone down is a massive help!

WHAT IF I CAN'T GET MY CHILD TO THE THEATRE?

Carpooling is an excellent option, please let us know ASAP if you need assistance!

WHAT IF WE'VE GOT OTHER COMMITMENTS ON THAT WEEKEND?

While we do our best to stay on schedule, there are many moving parts to a production of this size so it's best to be prepared that the Dress Rehearsal may run late. Important dates are communicated with families as early as February in the hopes that this exciting weekend can be prioritised and hopefully avoid any major clashes.

The Dress Rehearsal happens so that your child can have the best, most positive experience at the performance as possible. That is one of the biggest reasons that we stress its importance and why it is mandatory for all performers.

FINAL AND INCREDIBLY IMPORTANT REMINDERS: (for parents, students, backstage helpers, AND teachers)

Everyone will be trying their best to ensure the entire weekend runs smoothly and there are so many working parts -
Keep calm, stay positive, and remember your manners always.



Performer's Checklist:

✓	WHAT TO PACK:
	Makeup - Whilst most of the makeup will be applied at home, it's important to bring all products for any possible touch ups as we can't share make up between students! <i>PLEASE REFER TO MAKEUP REQUIREMENTS ON PAGE 14.</i>
	Hair Supplies - Brush, comb, hair ties, bobby pins, BUN PINS AND BUN NET (essential for most students!!) all in the same colour as your hair. <i>PLEASE REFER TO HAIR REQUIREMENTS ON PAGE 16.</i>
	Hairspray and/or hair gel
	Labelled water bottle
	Clean snacks, clean lunch (for those rehearsing all day) NO NUTS - (We do not have access to fridges or microwaves)
	Towel/Dressing Gown/Art Smock - to protect your costume whilst eating
	Personal Costume requirements; tights, shoes etc. <i>PLEASE REFER TO COSTUME REQUIREMENTS ON PAGE 12.</i>
	Boredom Buster Activity: There won't be too much waiting around but maybe pack an iPad, book, or colouring-in activity particularly to keep the younger ones occupied.

✓	MAKE SURE I:
	TAKE OFF ALL JEWELLERY - this includes earrings! If they absolutely can't be taken out, then please use Band-Aids to cover the jewellery. All jewellery is best left at home for safe keeping!
	REMOVE ANY NAILPOLISH - including acrylics/gels!
	REMOVE ANY TEMPORARY TATTOOS, COVER ANY REAL TATTOOS
	LABEL AND NAME ALL MY BELONGINGS - We may not see you again until next year! Please ensure everything is labelled correctly so nothing gets lost.

It is a fantastic idea to arrive already wearing your correct undergarments, tights, and shoes with Ugg boots/slides and a dressing gown for ease of changing straight into your costumes! A dress that easily slips on off is also a great option.
