FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 11, 2026
STARTING AT 8PM

The City of Marshfield will host the sixth annual 'Marshfield Remembers' memorial at Patriot Park located at 1490 N. Elm St., on September 11, 2026 in remembrance of the tragic events of September 11, 2001.

A memorial display made of 2,977 individual flags is placed in Patriot Park each year to represent the lives lost 25 years ago. In addition, a light tribute will begin at 8:00 P.M. with two towers of light shining in the night sky to be followed by the playing of Taps at 9:15 P.M.

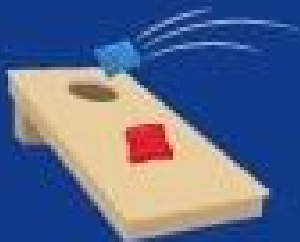
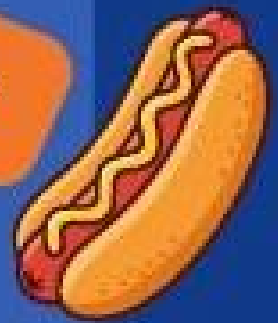
