Classes take place in the Collins Family Art Barn, a dedicated space designed to support a variety of visual arts experiences. The building includes a clay studio with a separate kiln room for ceramics and 3D work, a drawing classroom for 2D projects, and a fully equipped darkroom for photography. From sculpture to sketching, students develop an understanding of artistic principals with access to professional tools, allowing them to set their own course and discover what inspires them.

WOODSHOP PROGRAM

A separate space is dedicated to our woodshop program, offering students a hands-on introduction to the fundamentals of woodworking. Students learn essential skills such as tool use, techniques, and woodworking terminology. They also explore different types of wood and their unique characteristics. Throughout the term, students create a variety of projects that not only build their confidence but also showcase their growing craftsmanship.
