

Keynote: Donna Andrews



Donna Andrews was born in Yorktown, Virginia, the setting of *Murder with Peacocks* and *Revenge of the Wrought-Iron Flamingos*, and now lives and works in Reston, Virginia. *Probable Caws* (August 2026) and *Jay to the World* (October 2026) are the latest in her Agatha and Anthony winning Meg Langslow series. When not writing fiction, Andrews is a self-confessed nerd, rarely found away from her computer, unless she's messing in the garden.

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Keynote: Alma Katsu



Alma Katsu is the award-winning author of ten novels, her latest being *Incarnate*. She is best known for *The Hunger*, a reimagining of the story of the Donner Party, which was named by NPR as one of the 100 most loved horror stories and won the Western Heritage Award for best novel. Her story *The Wehrwolf* won the 2019 Stoker award for long fiction. She also writes spy thrillers, drawing on her career in intelligence, including *Red Widow* (nominated for the Thriller Writers award for best novel), and *The Invisible Enemy*, coming spring 2027. She has numerous works being developed for television, including *Black Vault* which is in pre-production with AMC Studios. She has a masters degree in fiction from the Johns Hopkins Writing Program and has been a contributing reviewer for *The Washington Post*.

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Traci Hunter Abramson



Traci Hunter Abramson worked for the Central Intelligence Agency for six years and credits the CIA with giving her a wealth of ideas as well as the skills needed to survive her children's teenage years. She has written more than fifty best-selling novels and is a ten-time Whitney Award winner.
