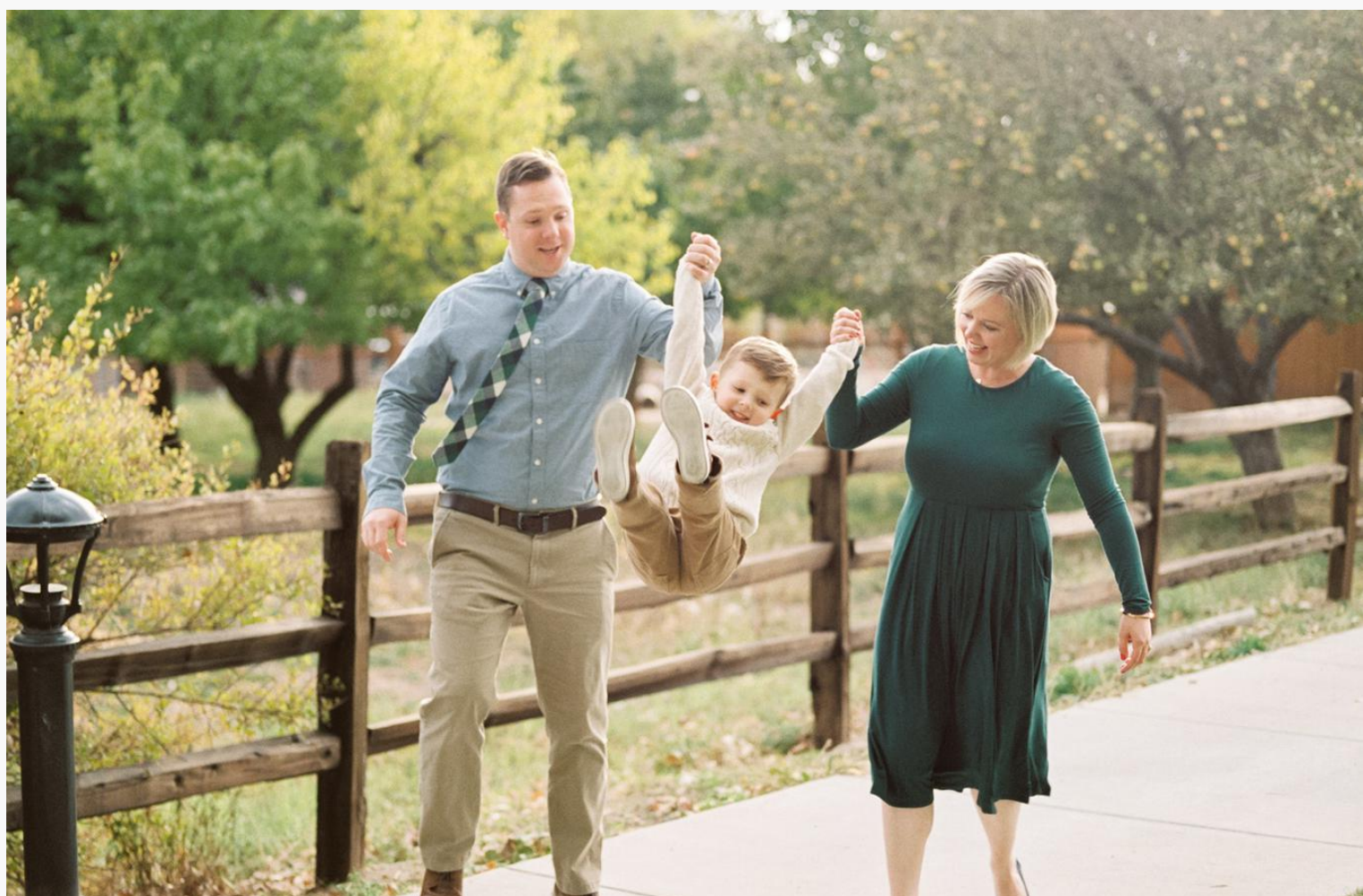
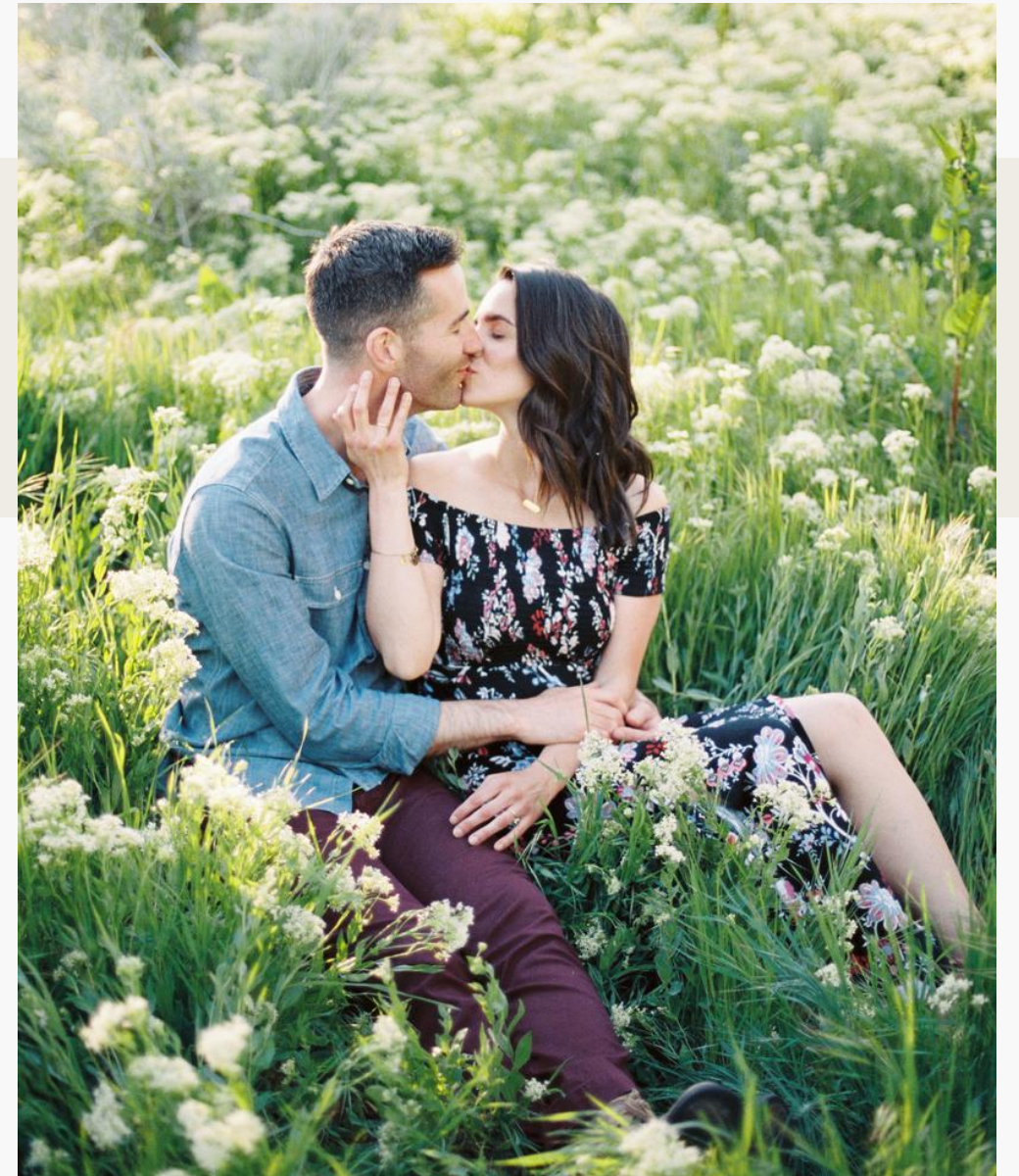
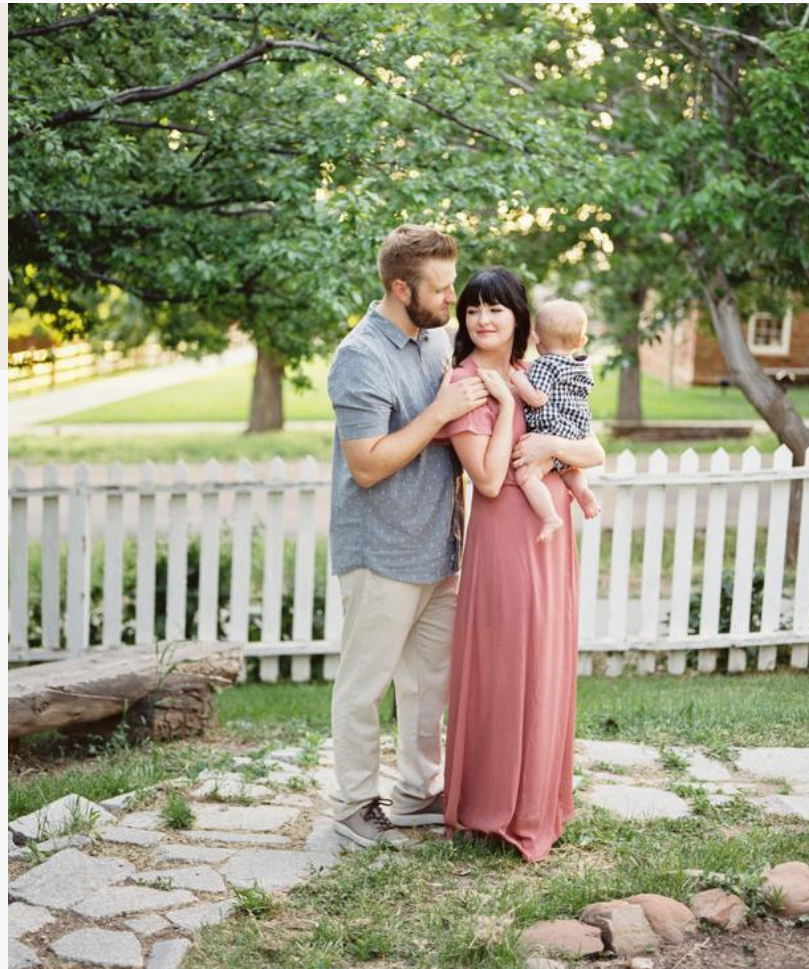

- Heritage style buildings, apple orchard, horse pasture & green fields



SALT LAKE VALLEY

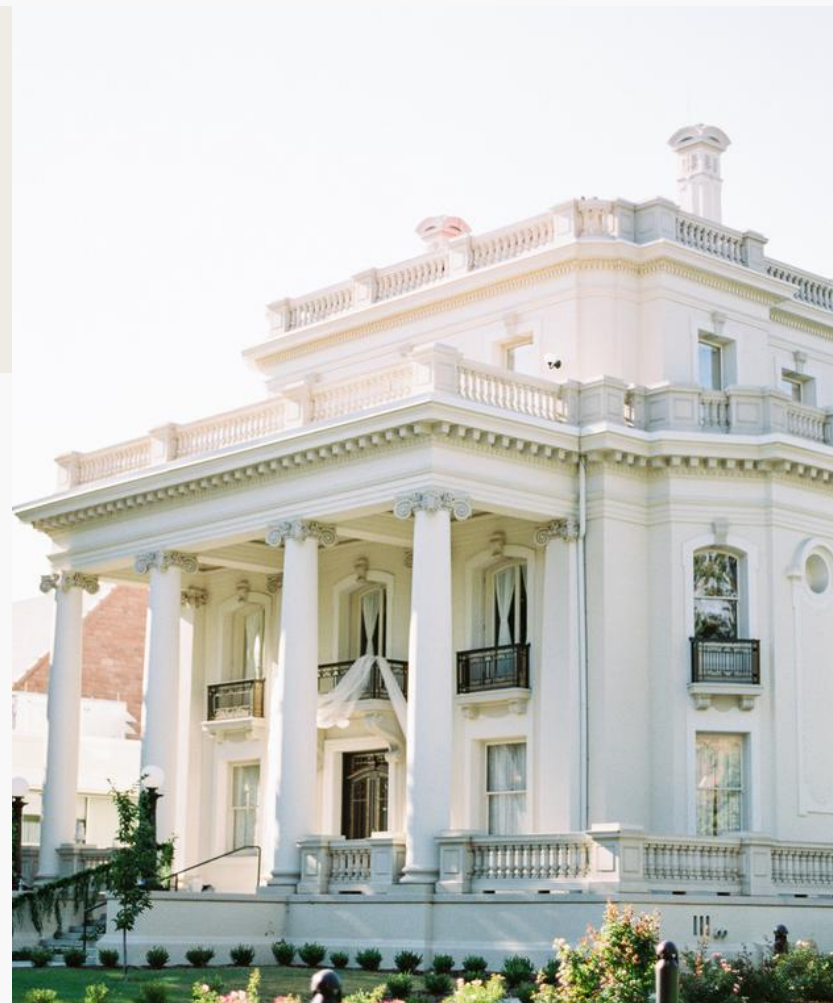
GARDEN PARK WARD

- Hidden spot in East SL
- Enclosed garden with unique architecture and old trees
- Only open Tues, Wed, Saturdays



THOMAS S. MONSON BUILDING

- Downtown SLC
- Free to shoot outdoors
- European/Charleston charm & architecture
- Appointment required



SALT LAKE VALLEY

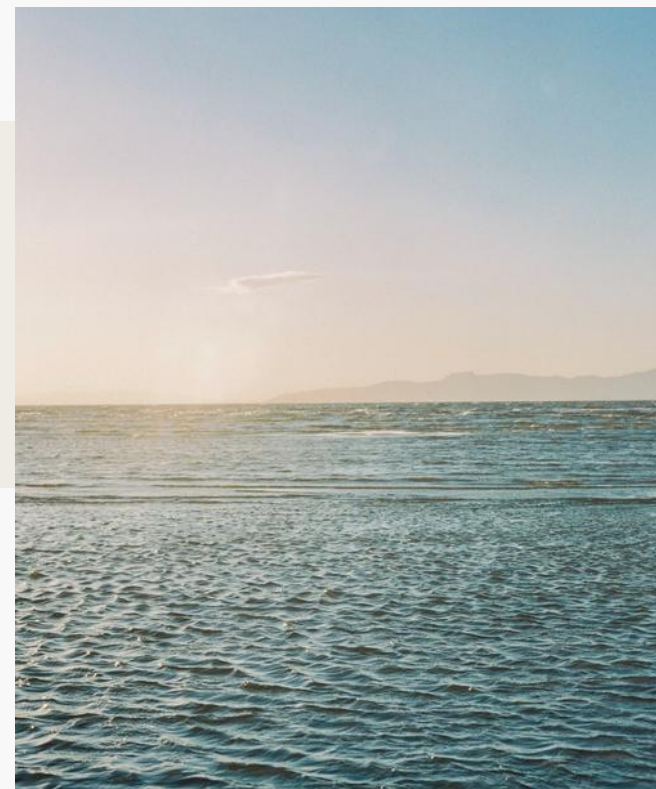
JORDAN PINES CAMPGROUND

- Big Cottonwood Canyon
- Mountain views with pine & aspen trees
- Great in winter, fall or summer



SALTAIR BEACH GREAT SALT LAKE

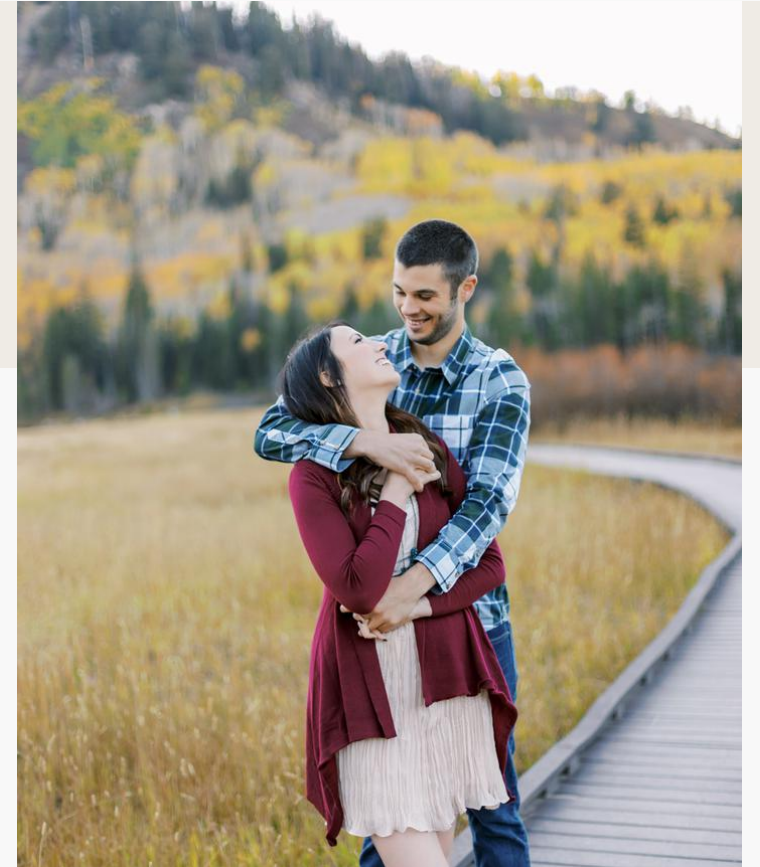
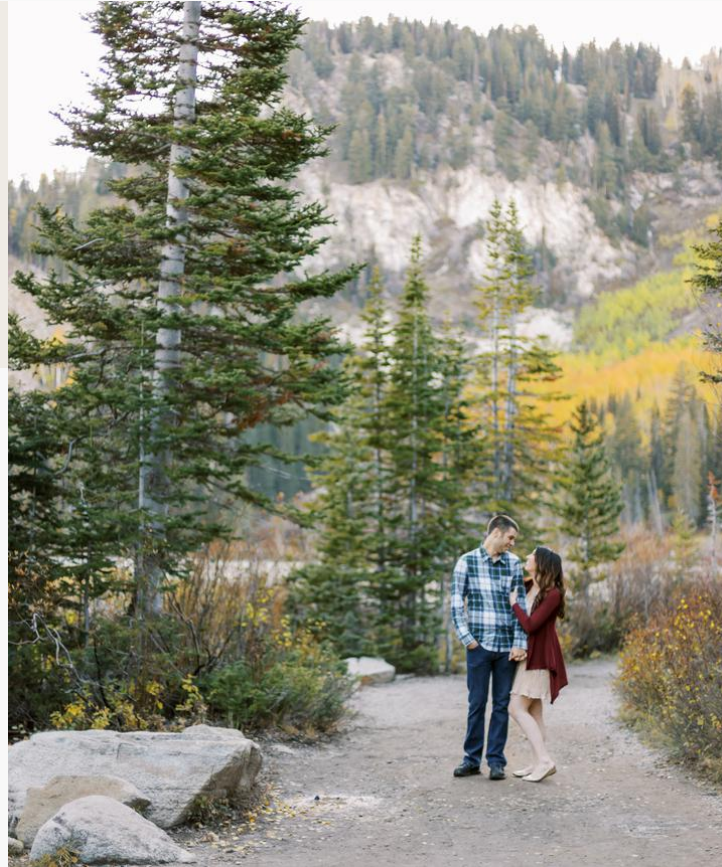
- Rocks & sandy scapes
- Can be windy
- Lakeside sunsets with mountains in the background
- Excellent alternative to the Bonneville Salt Flats



SALT LAKE VALLEY

SILVER LAKE

- Beautiful lake with 360° view of mountains
- Pine & aspen trees
- Boardwalk on the lake's edge



ALBION BASIN

- Step into *The Sound of Music* with these rolling hills of wildflowers set in a bowl of gorgeous mountains
- Permit sometimes required by DWR
- Best time: July & August
- Popular spot with sparse parking

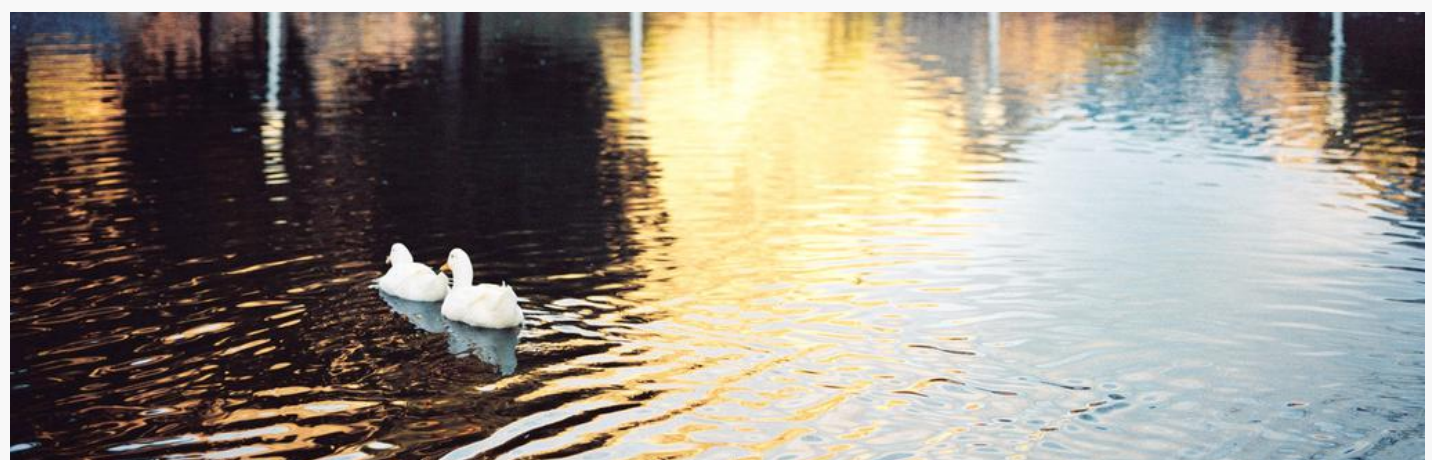
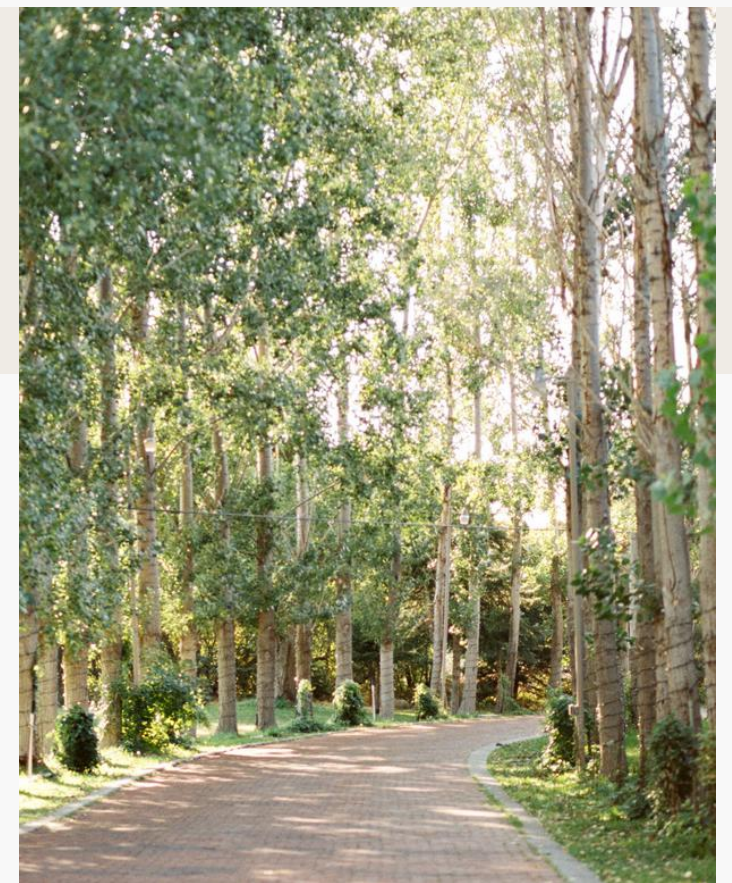
CACTUS & TROPICALS

- Draper, UT Location
- Indoor plant shop with rich textures and background elements
- \$100/hr photo fee



LA CAILLE RESTAURANT

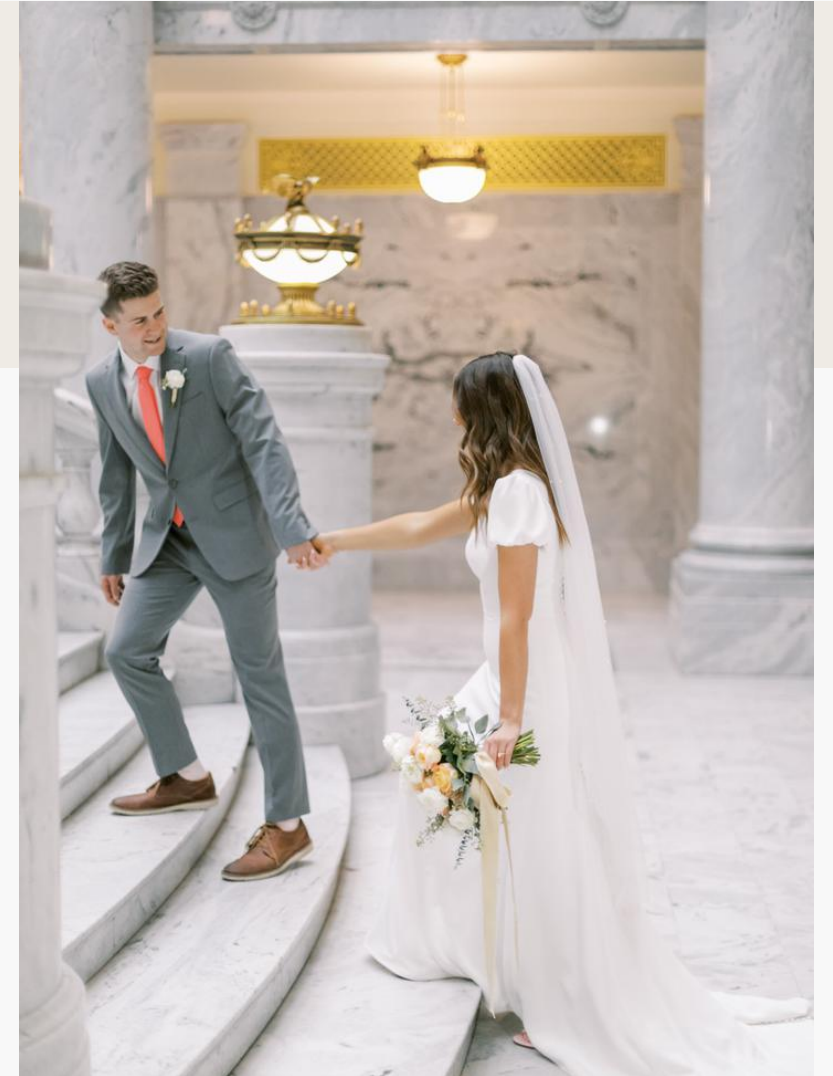
- French restaurant with stunning grounds
- Pond with swans and peacocks
- Greenhouse, gazebo, rivers, vineyards, aspen-lined red brick road & more
- French Chateaux facade
- \$30/hr with 2 hour minimum

UTAH STATE CAPITOL

- Free to photograph
- Beautiful white architecture
- Open to public as long as no events are ongoing



MEMORY GROVE

- Beautiful spring-fall
- Downtown SL near the Capitol
- Bridges, ponds, trees, and memorials



DAVIS COUNTY

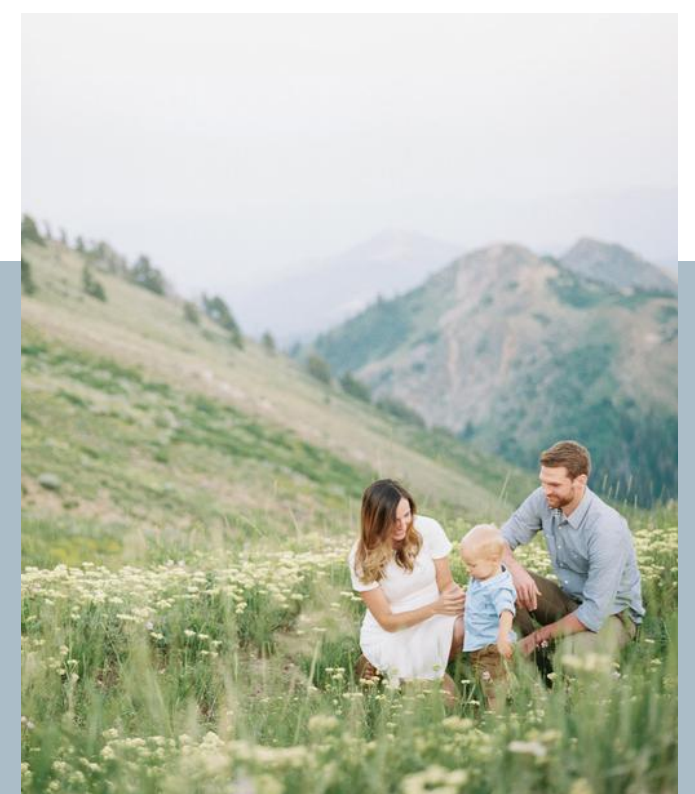
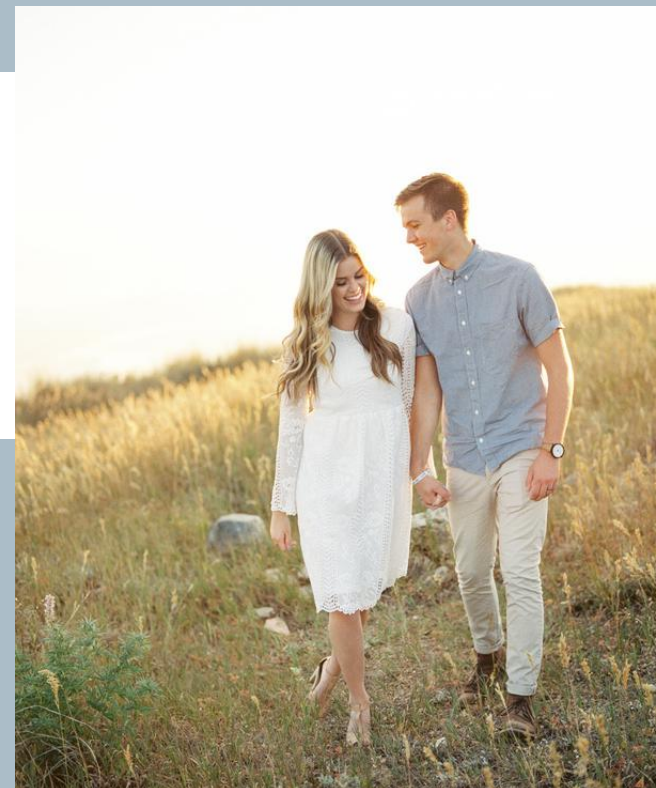
BOUNTIFUL POND

- Green olive trees perfect for golden hour photos
- Small lake with little traffic
- Lush landscape from April-October



FARMINGTON CANYON

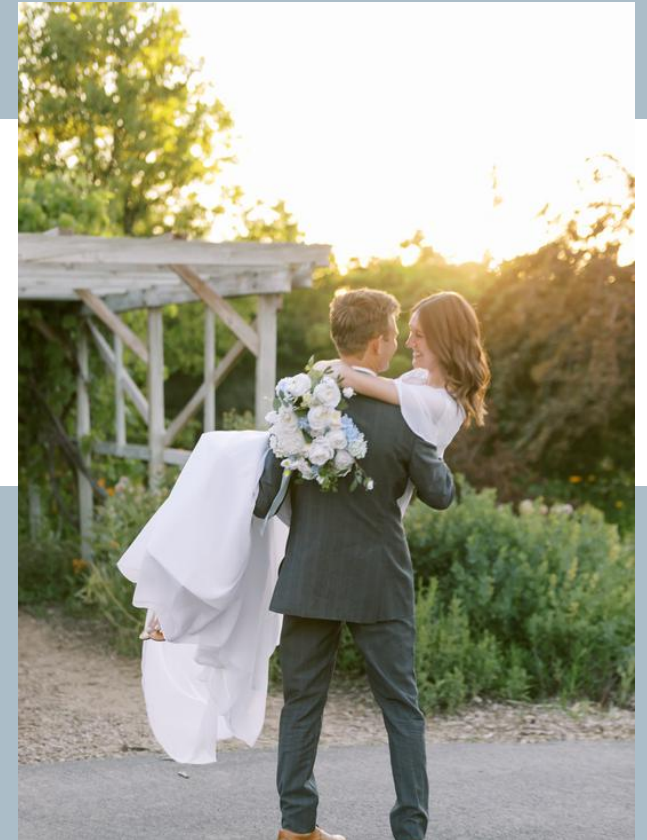
- Mountain & valley views
- Pines, aspens, & fields
- Not accessible during winter
- 4-wheel drive vehicle required



DAVIS COUNTY

OGDEN BOTANICAL GARDENS

- Lush manicured gardens
- Open to the public
- Walking trails & pergolas
- Rose garden



TRAVERSE MOUNTAIN

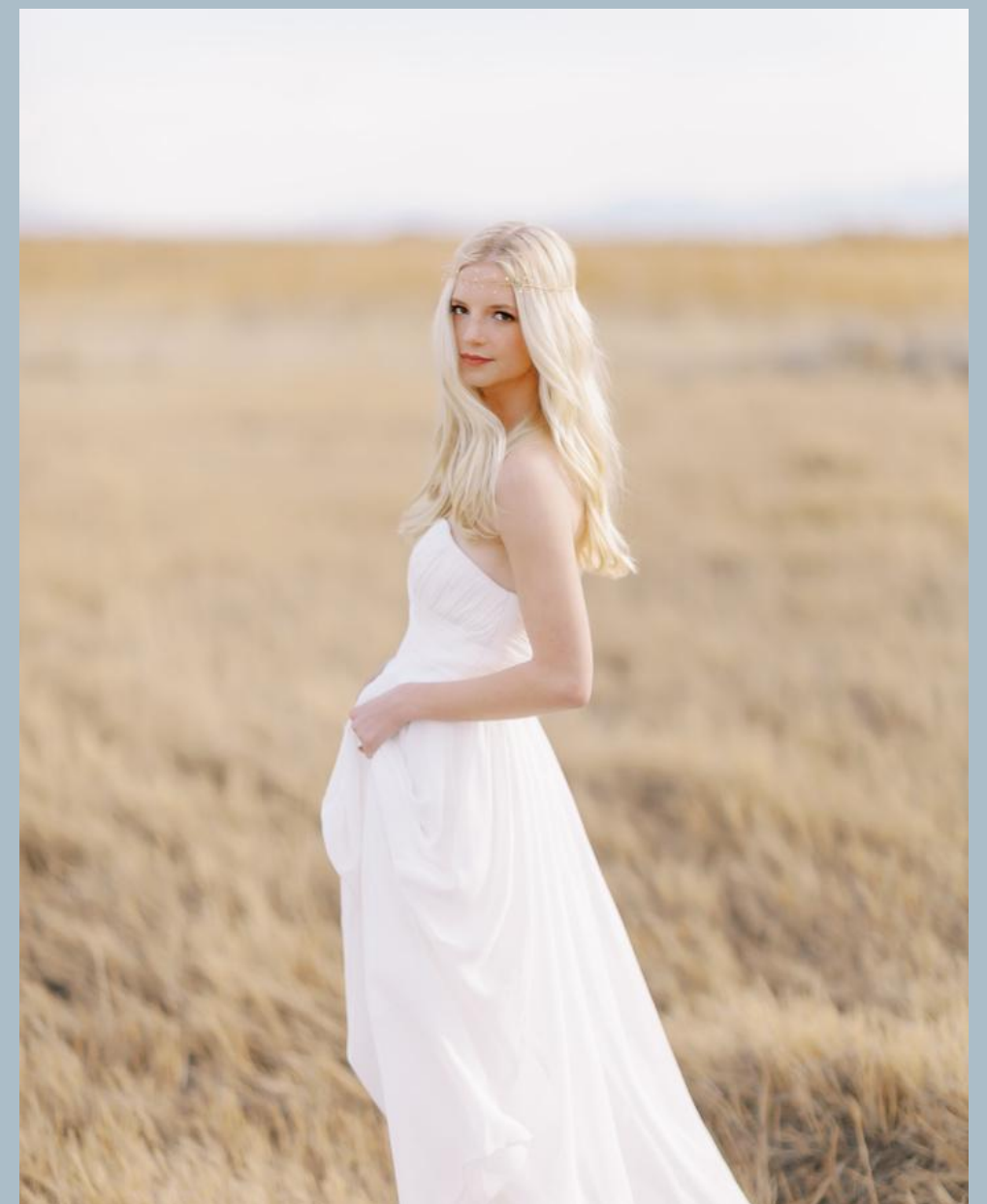
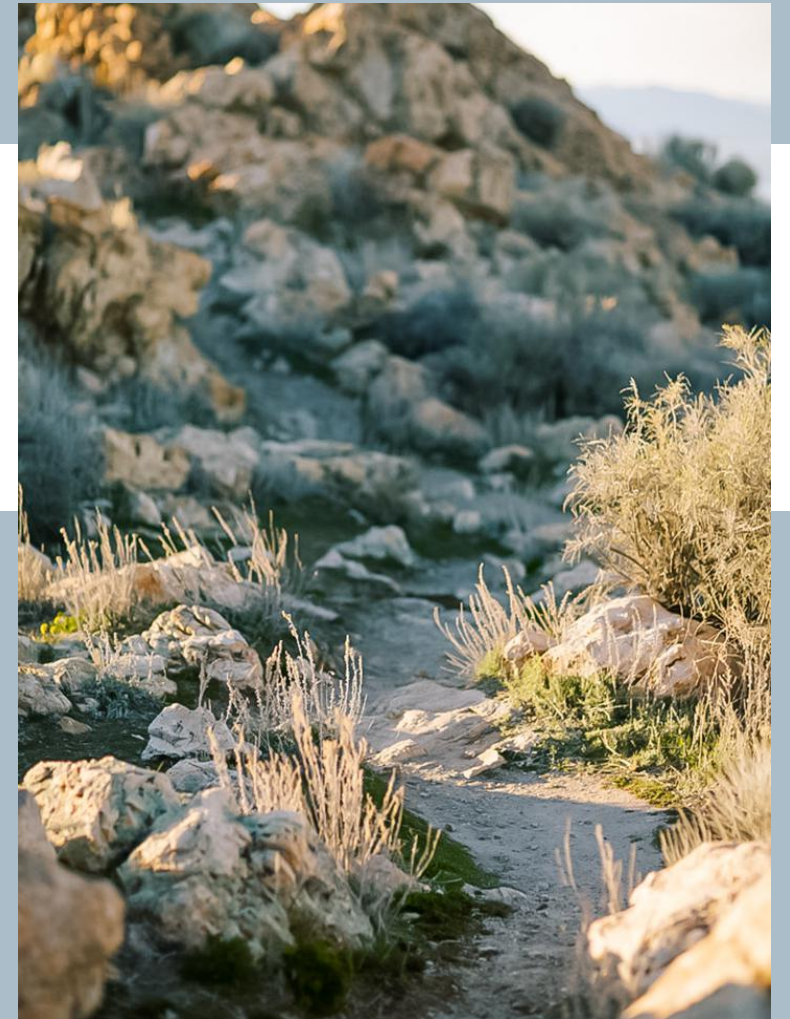
- Miles of mountain views with scrub oak, creating lovely green in the summer and fall foliage September-November
- View of Utah Lake in the distance



DAVIS COUNTY

ANTELOPE ISLAND

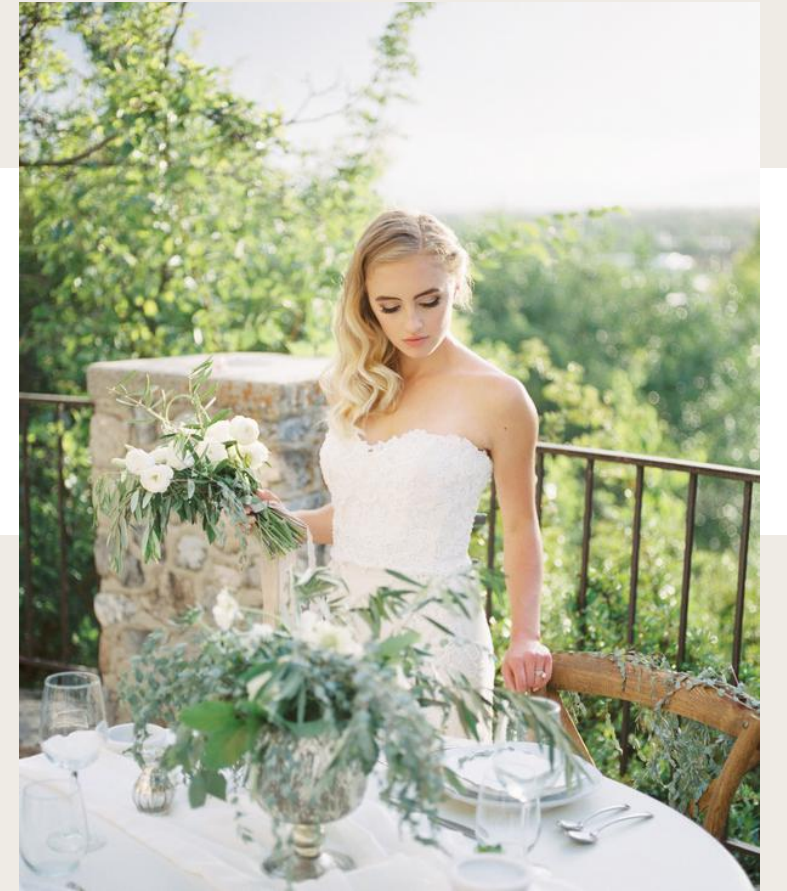
- Desert, beach, and rolling hills of Scotland all in one place
- Windy!
- \$10 entrance fee
- Unique wildlife such as bison and antelope
- Not recommended between May-October because of large spiders



UTAH COUNTY

PROVO CASTLE

- Outdoor amphitheater with old-European style stone walls & wooden doors
- Fee may be required



UTAH LAKE

- Sand & rocky beaches
- Gorgeous lakeside sunsets
- Unique trees and grasses



UTAH COUNTY

THANKSGIVING POINT

- Butterfly Biosphere
- White archways
- Charming gardens & arbors
- \$50/hr photo pass required plus admission (additional admission for biosphere)



KYHV PEAK ROAD

- Mountain views with open fields and aspens
- Beautiful from spring-fall, roads closed during winter
- Provo Canyon

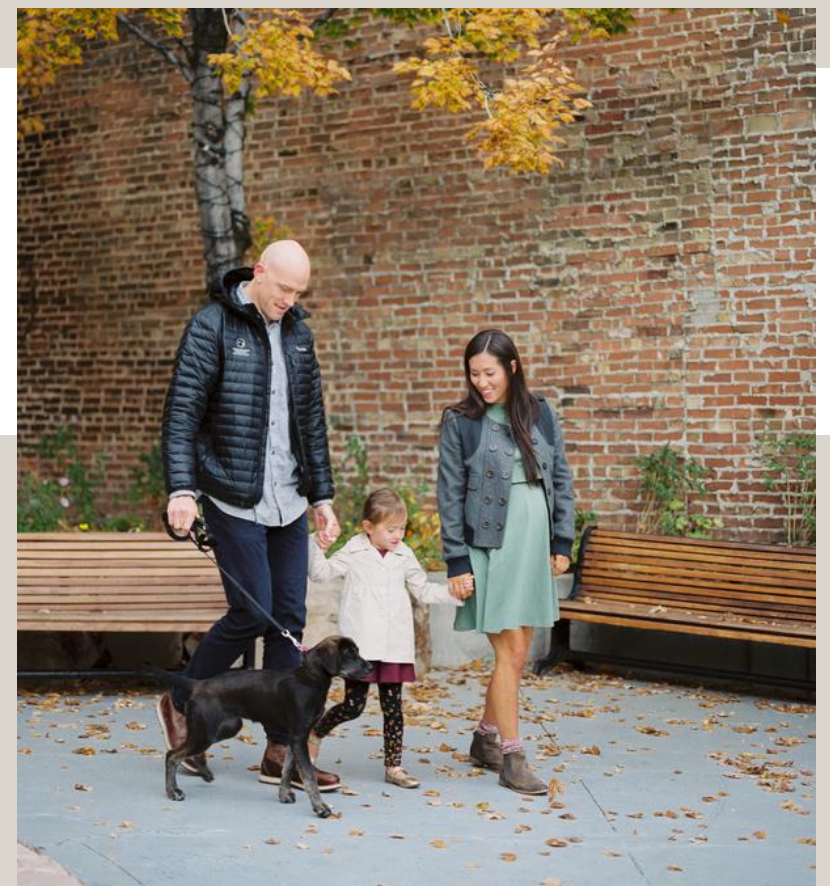

SUMMIT COUNTY

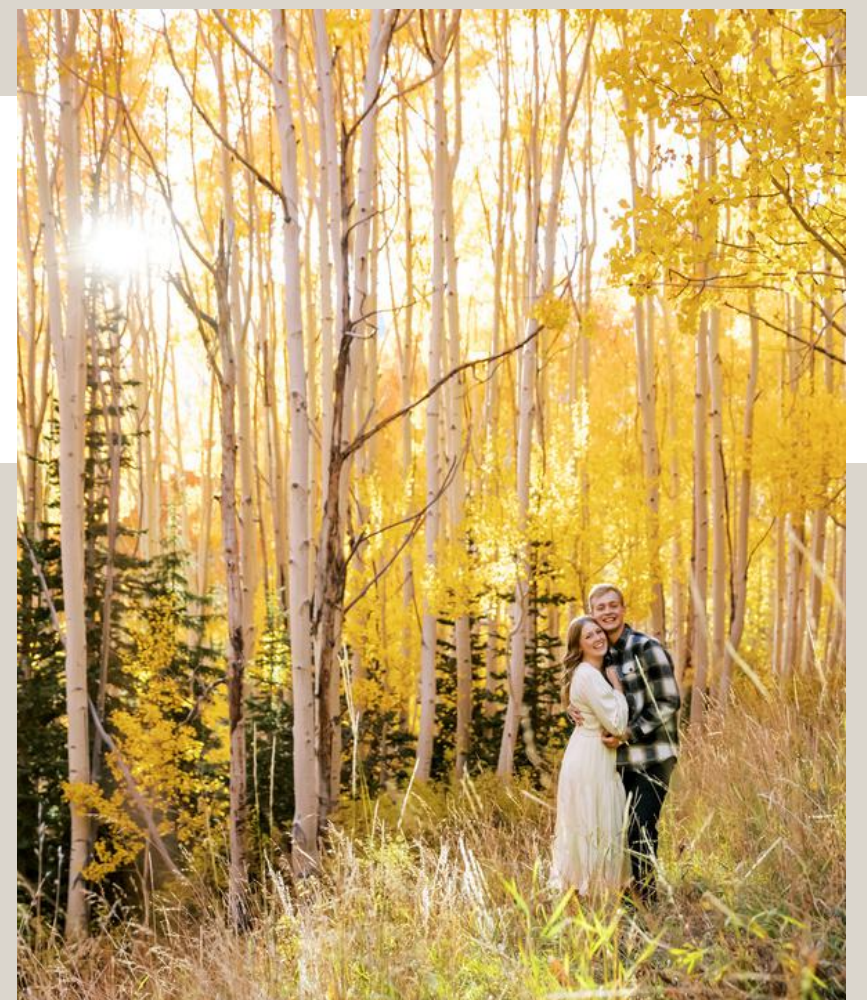
HISTORIC MAIN ST PARK CITY

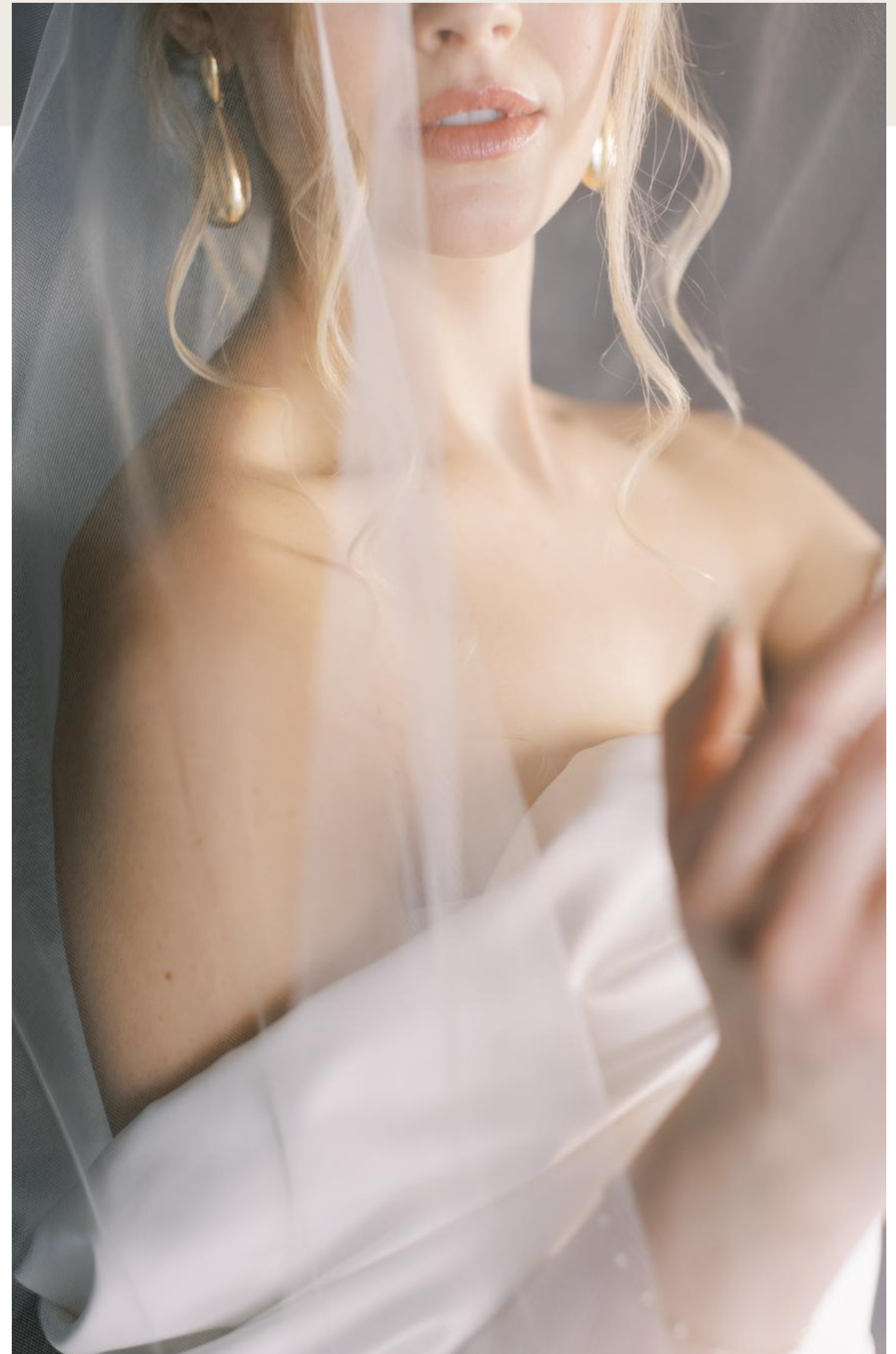

RENT A STUDIO

Studio sessions are great during the winter months when it's too cold, wet, or dark.

There's lots of studios we could choose depending on your style!



RENT AN AIRBNB

Want an indoor location that fits your vibe and that you don't have to furnish or clean? Rent an AirBnB for the afternoon!



When you think about what backdrop will look best for your shoot specifically, take into account the location & the season.

The location will often dictate what the best colors and outfits are going to be, because the landscape is bringing its own vibe, colors, textures, & theme.

With four distinctive seasons here in Utah, locations can look vastly different depending on the time of year. Set realistic expectations for your session, and lean into the current season when it comes to choosing your outfits and colors.

Finding your vibe.

Whether you're looking for a relaxed & intimate session or something a bit more formal, your location is a huge part of telling your story. Personally, I love cozy in-home engagement sessions with jeans, snuggly blankets, and bare feet. But that look would feel so out of place shooting at the Utah Capitol or walking around in the snowy mountains. Just like a cocktail dress & tuxedo would look awkward in a diner or at home on the couch. Pair sensible outfits with the location of your choice for the most natural and cohesive photos.
